Water & Sewer Rates

On May 3rd, after a public hearing, the Town Council adopted the following rates for water & sewer, to take effect on July 1, 2023:

Monthly

- Basic Water Service (BWS) \$20.00 • (per connection)
- Basic Sewer Service (BSS) \$57.00 (per connection)
- Out-of-Town Basic Water Service (BWS*) - \$40.00 (per connection)
 - Out-of-Town Basic Sewer Service
 - (BSS*) \$114.00 (per connection)

- Water Usage (WATR) \$4.70 (per 1,000 gallons)
- Sewer Usage (SEWR) \$10.98 (per 1,000 gallons)

Miscellaneous

- Turn Off/On \$50.00
- New Account \$50.00
- Close Account \$50.00
- Off-Cycle Reading \$50.00
