## Public Hearing - June 5, 2024

The Town Council will hold a public hearing on the following proposed ordinances prior to the regular meeting on June 5th:

**Ordinance 2-2024** An Ordinance of the Town of Trappe adopting a general budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2024 and ending June 30, 2025, and establishing a tax rate of \$.33 per \$100 of assessed real property value and a tax rate of \$.75 per \$100 on all commercial or business personal property and public utilities; and establishing an annual fee of \$182.00 per residential household for trash collection services, and also adopting an enterprise budget for the Town's water and sewer operations

**Ordinance 3-2024** An Ordinance of the Town of Trappe to amend Section 14 of the Trappe Town Code, Table 1 titled "Fees and Charges" to increase the water and sewer monthly fees
