Water and Sewer News

Reminder - The new water and sewer usage rates go into effect on July 1st. This is a 7% increase on actual gallons used.



Please remember to keep meter pit areas free of obstructions including shrubs and flowers.

Time for a Trim

Please trim low tree limbs and unruly shrubs away from sidewalks so that they remain clear for pedestri-

Also, remember to keep shrubs trimmed back from roadways so that residents and visitors can drive through our town safely. Fire hydrants should remain accessible.



Grass should not exceed a height of 6".
