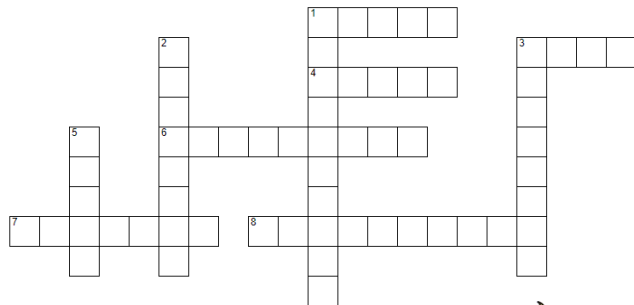
We hope to host an event this Fall if the virus allows.

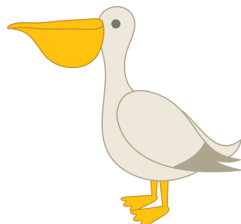
