- March 21, 2023 by 4:00 PM - Candidate application deadline
- April 11, 2023 - Primary Election (if seven [7] or more people file to run for office)
- May 2, 2023 - Absentee ballot request deadline
- May 9, 2023 - General Election



The General Election will take place in the Council Meeting Room at the Town Office. Polls will be open from 9:00 AM until 6:00 PM.
