Ordinance 1-2023 – An Ordinance of the Town of Trappe adopting a General Budget for the Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2023 and ending June 30, 2024, and establishing a tax rate of \$.33 per \$100 of assessed real property value and a tax rate of \$.75 per \$100 on all commercial or business personal property and public utilities; and establishing an annual fee of \$182.00 per residential household for trash collection services, and also adopting an Enterprise Budget for the Town's water and sewer operations.

Ordinance 2-2023 – An Ordinance of the Town of Trappe to amend Section 14 of the Trappe Town Code titled "Water and Sewer", Section 14.6 to require the property owner to pay all expenses associated with extending and connecting water and sewer to a property, and Table 1 titled "Fees and Charges" to increase the water and sewer connection and capacity charges, increase the monthly water and sewer fees and increase other fees and charges.
