Rental units are inspected biennially. Inspections and repairs must be completed by June 30, 2019.

Also, grass clippings should not be left on the sidewalks and roads.

## Do you have a few Spring projects planned?

The Town requires permits for sheds, fences, swimming pools, decks and porches, and large dumpsters/storage containers.

A permit is also required if you plan to make structural alterations as part of a renovation.
