Holiday Safety and Crime Prevention

The holiday months are prime-time for theft. Here are some tips to protect your packages and gifts.

Avoid Porch Theft

- Network with neighbors
- Have packages delivered to work
- Leave specific drop-off instructions
- Use a smart lock
- Install security cameras

Avoid Package Theft

- Get a PO Box
- Set up tracking notifications
- Require a signature on delivery
- Use a package locker

If you become a victim of porch pirates...

- Check-in with the delivery company
- Know exactly what's in the missing box
- If you see the thief, make note of their physical description, vehicle, and license plate
- Call 9-1-1
- Provide a copy of security footage to police - ask your neighbors if their cameras caught the thief

Attention Hunters



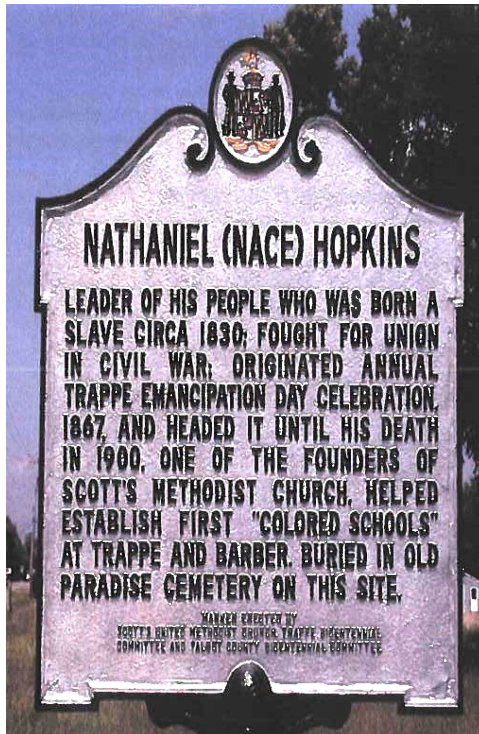

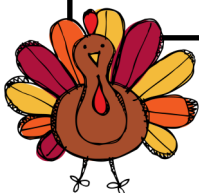
