

Water Bill Reminders

Bills are due on the 28th of each month. A 2% late fee will be added to any balance carried after the due date.

Bills may be paid by credit/debit card (plus processing fee), cash, check, or money order. To pay your bill online, go to trappend.authoritypay.com and create an account. To sign up for automatic payments, contact the Town Office.

Delinquent notices are sent to account holders who have a balance that is 10 days past due. The past due amount is due 10 days after the notice is issued.

If the past due amount is not paid by the date listed on the notice, service will be disconnected. The account holder must pay the past due amount, \$50 turn off fee, and \$50 turn on fee prior to having service reconnected.
