If the office is not open and you would like to make a payment please use our door slot and be sure to push your payment all the way through.

## Bulk Trash

Bulk trash pickup will take place on Friday, October 30th. Sign-up forms are available at the Town Office and online at [trappemd.net](http://trappemd.net). Forms must be received by the Town Office no later than Tuesday, October 27th.

### Fees

Basic - Up to 3 cubic yards (about a pickup truck load): \$10.00

Tires up to 15" without the rim: \$3.00 each

Tires up to 15" on the rim: \$6.00 each

Tires over 15" without the rim: \$4.25 each

Tires over 15" on the rim: \$8.50 each

*Light truck and passenger car tires only - 4 tire limit*

### Rules

Cardboard boxes must be broken down and bundled; Leaves must be dry and in tied bags or covered containers (no more than 8 per household); Sticks, tree limbs, boards, and posts must be bundled, no more than 3' long, and no more than 60 lbs; No more than one hot water heater, refrigerator, freezer, stove, or sofa per household (freon gas must be removed); Gas engines must have oil and gas removed; Antifreeze, asbestos, concrete, brick or masonry rubble, contractor's waste, dead animals, demolition debris, explosives and ammunition, hazardous materials, propane tanks, motor oil, filled paint cans, soil, dirt, and tree stumps are prohibited
