PUBLISHED INVITATION TO BIDDERS

The Town of Trappe, Maryland (the “Town”) is requesting proposals for a contractor to dredge clean to remove and dispose of sludge and contaminated materials in one of the Trappe Wastewater Treatment Plant sludge holding pond. The Town received a grant in the amount of \$500,000 from the Mid Shore Regional Council for this project. The Town is seeking proposals to remove the greatest quantity of sludge from the holding pond as possible with the grant funds received.

Submittals will be received no later than 2:00 p.m. on Tuesday, February 28, 2023 by mail to Lyndsey Ryan, Booth, Cropper & Marriner, PC, 130 N. Washington Street, Easton, MD 21601, or by email to lryan@bbcmlaw.com.

Before submitting proposals, prospective proposers **must visit the site** and acquaint themselves with the sludge holding pond at the Trappe Wastewater Treatment Plant, all governing laws, ordinances, etc. and otherwise familiarize themselves with all matters which may affect the performance of the work. **The site visit will occur at 10:00 am on Wednesday, February 8, 2023.**
