Winter Storm Preparedness: A Message from Delmarva Power

Being prepared is a responsibility we take very seriously, and we encourage others to do the same. Please help us spread the word in your community about the steps that can be taken to prepare for a winter storm. (1) Assemble an emergency storm kit; (2) Prepare a plan for what to do during a power outage or winter storm; (3) Confirm we have your current phone number in the "My Alerts and Notifications" section of our website: [Delmarva.com/MyAccount](https://delmarva.com/MyAccount); (4) Visit [Delmarva.com/mobileapp](https://delmarva.com/mobileapp) to download our app, which has many resources to keep you informed during a storm; (5) More tips, resources and safety information are available at [Delmarva.com/StormPrep](https://delmarva.com/StormPrep).

Customers are asked to immediately report a downed wire or service issue by calling 1-800-898-8042, visiting [Delmarva.com](https://delmarva.com), or through the mobile app. Delmarva Power customers can also text "Out" to "67972". Customers must first text "Add Outage" to "67972" to sign up for this service.
