Sticks and Tree Limbs

Must be tied in bundles not more than three feet long and not more than sixty pounds Boards, Posts, etc.

> Shall not be longer than three feet or more than sixty pounds Refrigerators, Freezers, and Air Conditioners

Must have freon gas removed (no more than one per residence)

Gas-Driven Equipment

Must have oil and gas removed

Metal Items

Must be separated from other debris and yard waste
