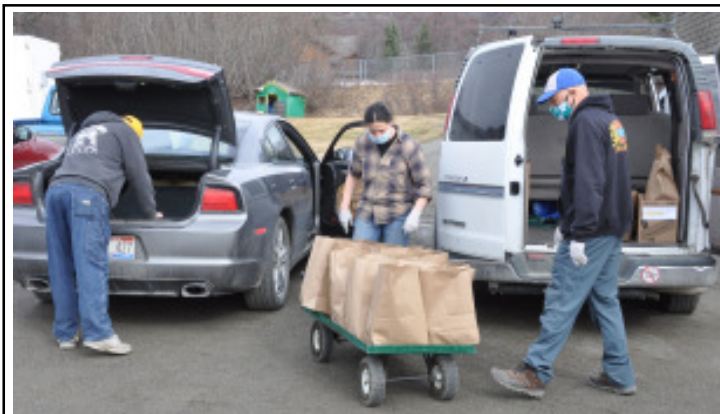
## A Special Thanks...

The COVID-19 challenges are manifest in the increasing need for home delivery of emergency food boxes. Many organizations from the State of Alaska to the Independent Living Center, from the school system to The Center have all requested food delivery for home-bound residents.

An extra special thanks to the three volunteer drivers who drop

off nearly 40 food boxes each Monday. In addition to the non-perishable items, each delivery consists of a dozen eggs and a bag of produce. Senior Boxes are also included, where appropriate.

While we understand that home-delivered boxes are a compromise to shopping and choosing exactly what you would prefer, clients appreciate receiving weekly deliveries directly to their doorstep.
