- Maintain the highest standards of business integrity by abiding by all civil laws, rules and regulations applicable to our operations and carrying them out in a professional manner.
- Maintain all necessary insurance and legal permits for both health and vending required by the OFTA and each jurisdiction in which I/we operate.
- Maintain the professional appearance of my equipment. I will do my best to keep my truck, trailer, cart and the area around it clean and presentable at all times, ideally leaving the location cleaner than when I arrived.
- Cooperate in every reasonable way with fellow members and the OFTA in advancing the interests of the Association and the food truck industry in my community.
- Maintain a fair, professional and courteous relationship with event coordinators, competitors, vendors, associates, our employees, and the public in all of our dealings.
- Be friendly, professional and respectful to regulatory and law enforcement officials.
- Handle any disputes or concerns in a courteous manner, refraining from disparaging other OFTA members, business owners or officials publicly or via social media.
- Honor our commitments to events, parties, etc., understanding that a no show/no call to an OFTA referred event without a valid reason (ie. medical emergency, mechanical breakdown, accident) may result in disciplinary action by the OFTA.
- Refrain from sharing OFTA proprietary information or leads with non-members without the express consent of the OFTA Board Of Directors or its officers.
- Support the OFTA by taking an active role in its meetings, committees, and events, as well as adhering to its policies and upholding this Code of Conduct.
