
What are we solving?

Make an Al based reading app that is more human focused and personal while being less robotic.

The possibility of **limiting doom scrolling** with an alternative app to engage with.



Al Possibilities

- 1. Environment-aware reading: Provide reading suggestions related to the user's location, weather or time, mood and other factors.
- 2. Recommend short stories based on the length of time and place, echoing the surrounding environment and enhancing the immersion of the reading.
- 3. Save reading progress: Meet the needs of users to read in a short period of time, save the progress when users leave reading, and provide corresponding content recall support when they continue reading next time.
- 4. Provide background music or ambient sounds that match the reading content to help users concentrate and immersive themselves in the story.

- 5. Provide interesting chapter names to capture the reader's attention.
- 6. To help readers who have questions or need to review remember details, ai prompts summarize important stories and names.
- 7. According to different kinds of books, change the structure level to help readers with different needs
- 8. Provide virtual guide: to provide customized guide services according to users' reading habits and preferences.
- 9 .AI can generate character voices for audio books, that immersive yourself into the story and allow the reader to play along.
