Research----Wright square

Laid in 1733. It is located on Bull Street between State and York Streets. It was renamed to honor James Wright, Georgia's last Royal Governor.

The square has also been referred to as **Post Office Square, Court house Square and Hanging Square**, as from its earliest days to the present, it has held a courthouse on the site.



The central monument honors William Washington Gordon, the founder of the Central of Georgia Railroad, and the boulder in the southeast corner memorializes Tomochichi, the leader of the Yamacraws, a friend of General Oglethorpe and ally of the English.





Story

The ghost of Tomo-Chi-Chi allegedly still resides in Wright Square. If you visit his monument on the southeast corner of the square, and run around it three times while saying "Tomo-Chi-Chi," his ghost might actually appear.

Alice Riley was the first woman to be hanged in Georgia, and She was then trafficked throughout the Colony of Georgia. William Wise, a plantation owner, was an especially sadistic master who subjected Riley to physical and sexual abuse. Riley, along with her suspected lover and fellow indentured Richard White, allegedly, drowned William Wise in a large bucket of water. Riley and White fled to the Isle of Hope, yet were apprehended and relocated to Wright Square. She was later executed on January 19, 1735.
