# Inspired by Le Corbusier

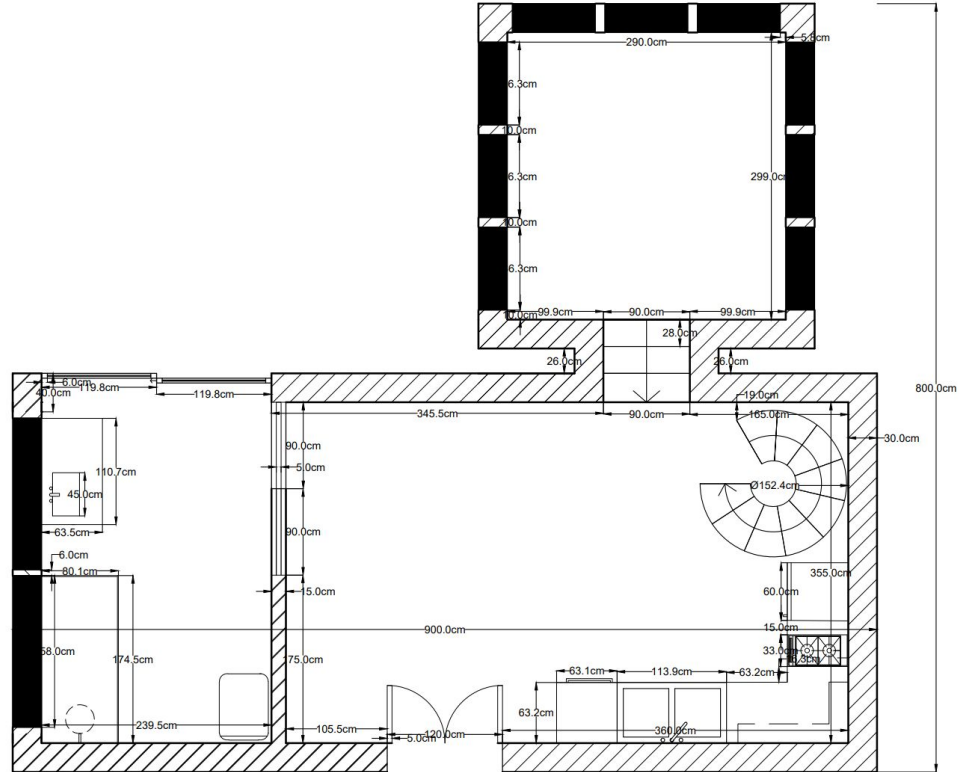

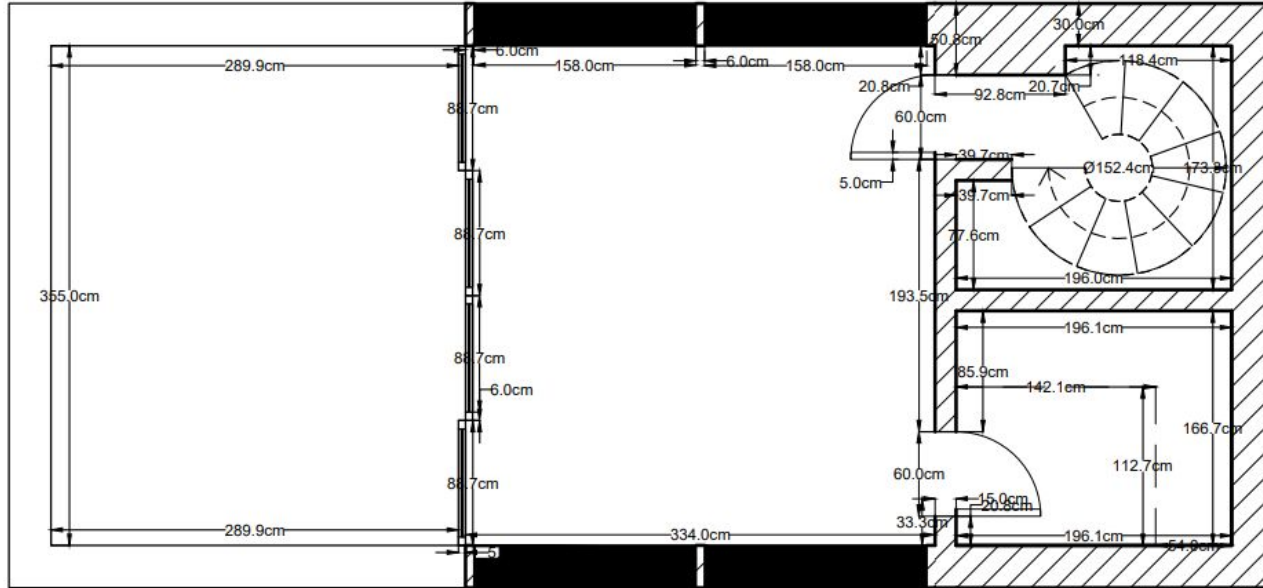

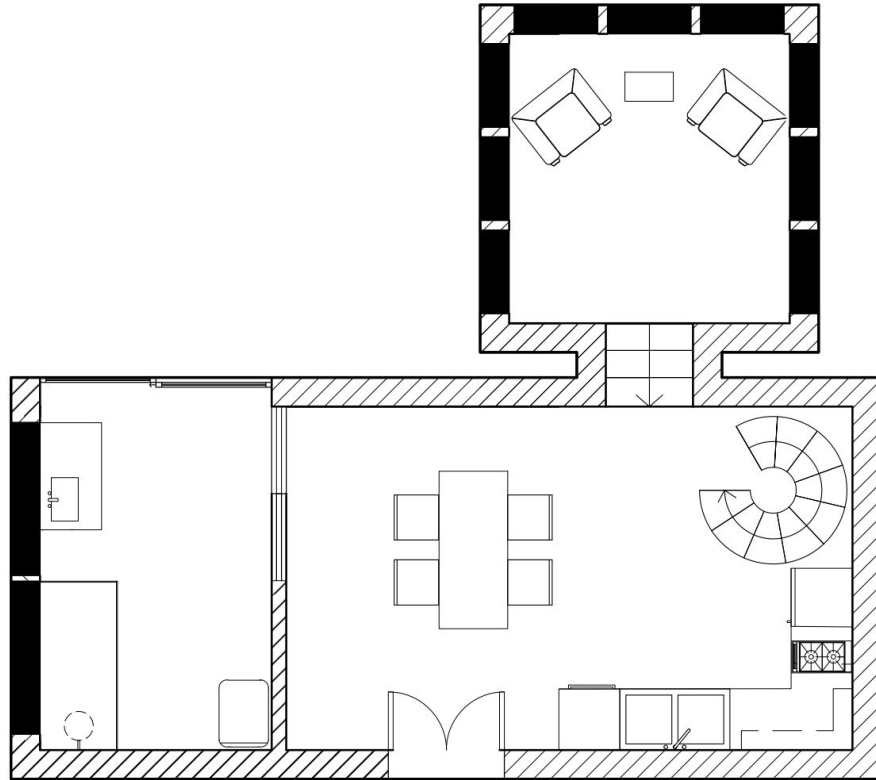
# Ground Level with Dimensions



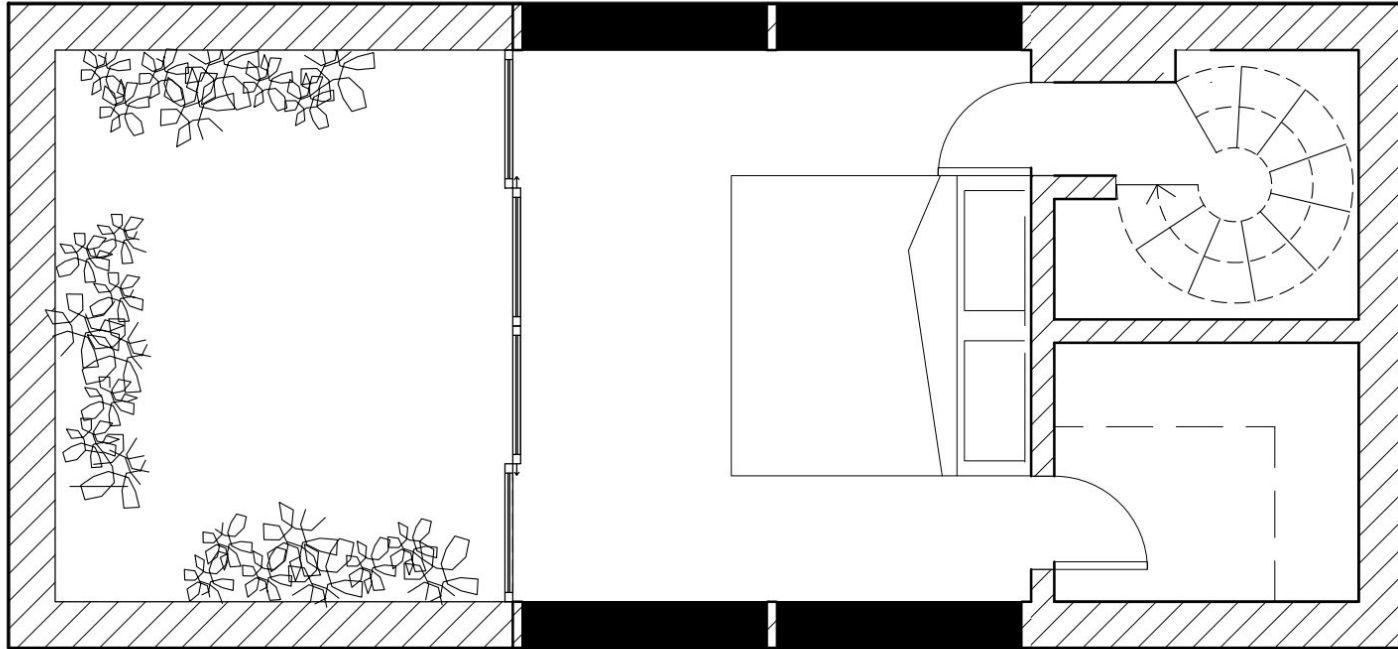
# Upper Level with Dimensions



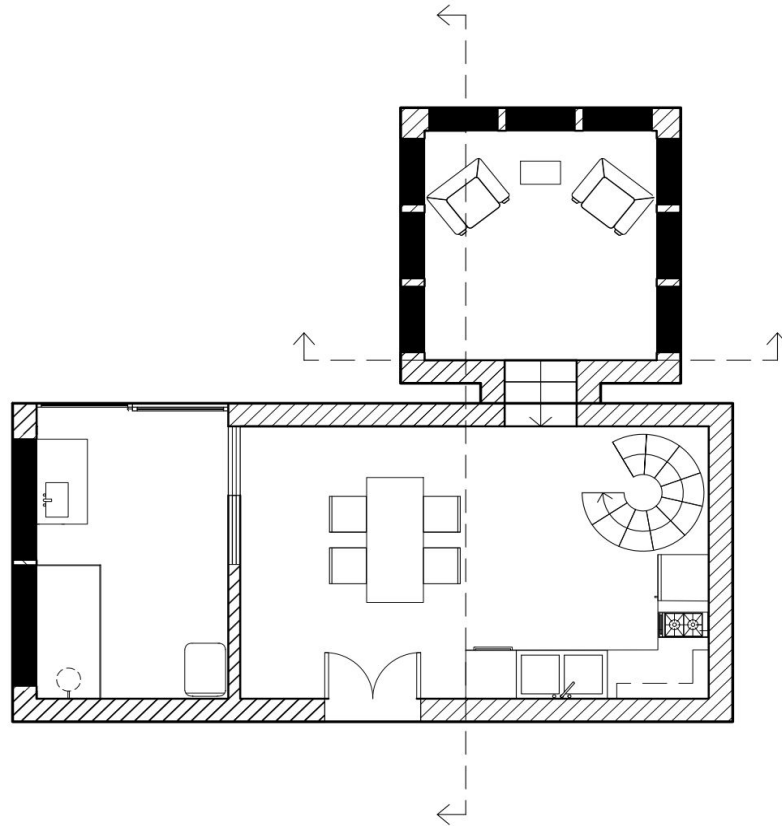

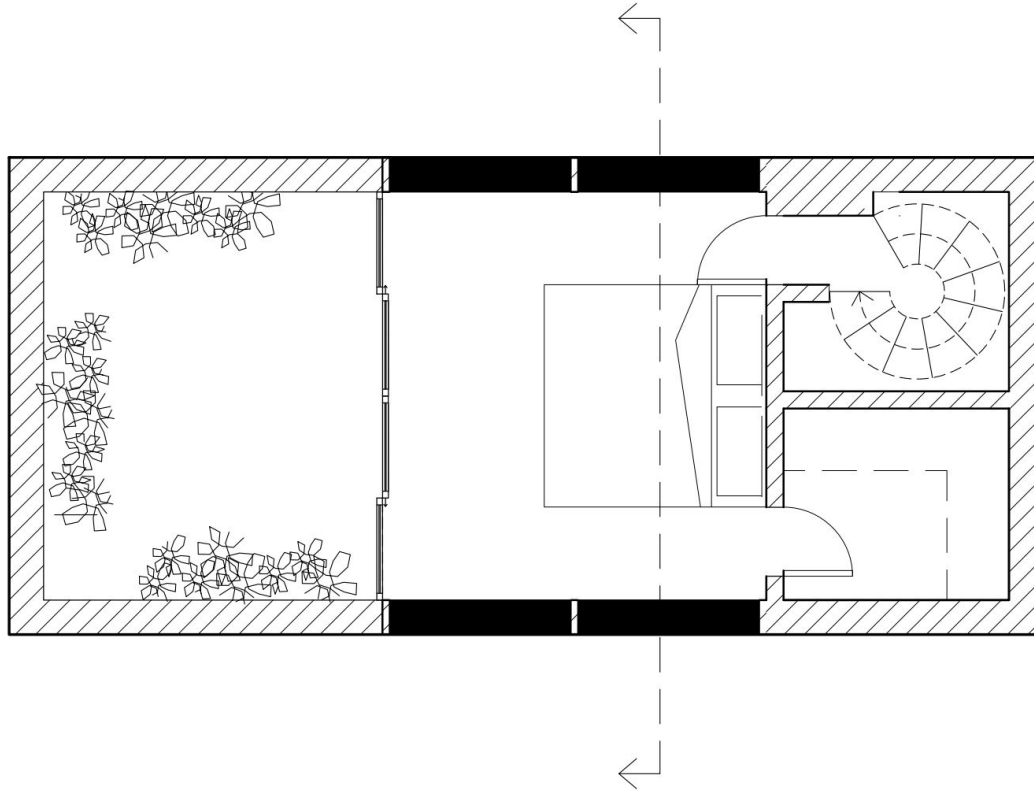


# Ground Level Section Lines

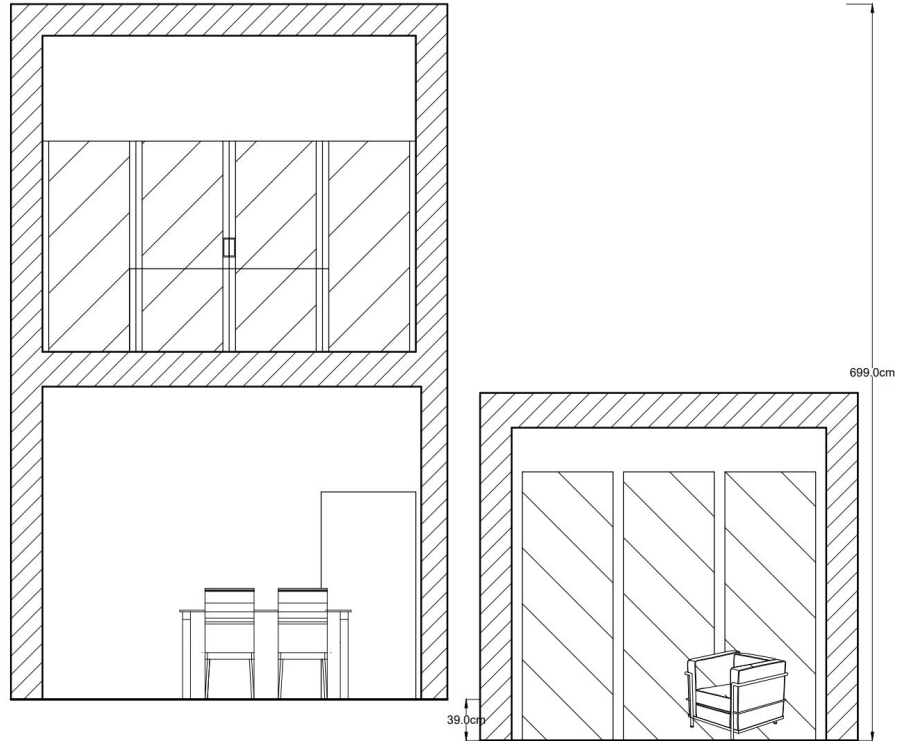




# Upper Level Section Lines
