We reviewed the Project Costs spreadsheet. The new Budget spreadsheet now goes out to 2031, a 9-year projection. The P&L spreadsheet discussion was around an accounting difference between the "Income" year and "Fiscal" year. This is due to our bi-monthly billing cycle. Just something to be aware of. New Business:

- Transponder Issues: Recent electrical storm knocked out connection between the pump and the tanks. Dustin was able to fix. A suggestion has been made to investigate a WIFI type connection. This would allow us to monitor and discover these types of issues much faster.
- Pump Control Panel Screen: Kathleen notified us that the screen no longer works. Creston had updated theirs to WIFI which she accesses from her phone. The new unit was about \$600.
 - ➤ Rob Heinz made a Motion to research internet/cell services available to support WIFI usage for the control screen and the transponder issues. This will also assist with future upgrades. The Motion was 2nd by Todd Heaton, AIF.
- Do we have a Deed to the "Dungeon" property (the upper lot)?
- Does our insurance cover if our water line "blows out"?
- Need for an easement from the Ivy's on the pump house road along the green belt?
