WiL Mentorship Programme

Strong mentorship is invaluable throughout our careers, a positive mentor can have a huge impact on career paths and ultimate success. In late 2024, Kat Lewis proposed an idea to encourage mentorship within the WiL global community via a mentorship programme.

The concept is to establish a voluntary, international 'bank' of self-identified mentors and mentees within the WiL community, providing WiL members the opportunity to connect with other WiL members with greater experience in particular fields of interest. It is recognised that this may be particularly useful for those without access to such relationships within their existing professional and personal networks. The program will not only be aimed at 'junior' WiL seeking mentorship from 'senior' WiL, but also at those who may have extensive experience in certain areas and wish to develop knowledge and expertise in others.

Women in Lymphoma will develop and support this mentorship programme within the WiL community, and once a connection is established, the relationship will be self-directed between the WiL involved. There will be an open invitation to participate in the program and those interested will specify if they are looking to join as mentees or mentors, along with their field of expertise or interest, which will lead to connections between those with aligning interests and goals.
