Coaches Code Of Conduct

- Do not criticize players in front of spectators, but reserve constructive criticism for private or in the presence of the team members, if they might benefit.
- Accept decisions of the game officials on the field as being fair and called to the best of their ability of said official.
- Do not criticize opposing coaches, players, or fans by gestures or comments.
- Emphasize that winning is the result of hard work and team work.
- Head coaches are responsible for the conduct of the team, all players, parents and assistant coaches and fans. Anyone who refuses to conduct themselves will be asked to leave.
- Refrain from using profanity and abusive language.
- Do not permit ineligible players to participate in practice or games.
- Do not deliberately incite unsportsmanlike conduct.
- B.T.A (Belt To A**) is prohibited.
- Abstain from drinking alcoholic beverages on field, at games and practices. Do not come to game or practices under the influence of alcoholic beverages or mind altering drugs.
- Remove any player from the game or practice whenever the slightest doubt exists that the player's health is in danger until he can be examined or competent medical advice is available.
- Uphold all rules and regulations of the Saint Lucie Lions Youth football league.
