## Recital Costumes

All recital costumes have been ordered and the majority have been sent home. When your costumes come in please remove them from the bag they come in and hang them in a safe place. Many of the costumes get very wrinkled in shipping and may require a steamer to get the wrinkles out. Also, if your child's costume has straps, check the fit of the straps. Sometimes straps need to be taken up if they are not adjustable. Several of the costumes have been sent home already. All costumes are due to arrive in time for recital pictures. We will send home costumes as they come in.

## Recital Photos

Recital Photos will be taken on Saturday, April 1st from 9:00-5:00 pm at the Madison studio and on Sunday, April 2nd from 1:00-5:00 pm at the Reservoir studio. Make-up Photo date is Saturday, April 15th at the Madison studio from 10:00- 3:00. Recital photos are not mandatory; this is just for your convenience. These are your photos, and your child can wear their hair any way you prefer. Leah Kackley of Sanomo Photo-sanomophoto.com is the photographer and she has several packages available. One of her portrait rate sheets is attached for your review. Please bring the filled-out photo form on the day of pictures. **Do Not turn in at the studio.** If you buy an ad or want to put your dancer's photo in the recital program but do not want to buy a photo packet, you may come and have your child's photo taken strictly for the program book for \$12.00. Please click on the [following link](#) to sign up for a time slot to have your dancer's photo made. You do not have to sign up at the studio your dancer takes at. If you are going to purchase an ad or put your child's photo in the recital program book you **MUST** have your photo taken by Leah Kackley. ***If you are going to purchase an ad or put your child's photo in the recital program book you MUST have your photo taken by Leah Kackley.***

## Recital Tickets

Recital tickets will go on sale on April 1 through our website - [www.msmetroballet.com](http://www.msmetroballet.com). To simplify the reserved seating ticketing procedure your recital fee was reduced this year, therefore, you will be responsible for purchasing all of your tickets this year. Please be sure that you know what recital your dancer is in before you purchase your tickets. Ticket purchases are non refundable. You will go online and reserve your tickets but you will not pay anything at that time. Your ticket purchases will be drafted from you account for those of you set up on monthly auto draft and those who pay semester by check will need to send a check to the school within 7 days of the reservation or the tickets will be released.

## Recital Souvenirs

**T-shirts:** We are pre-selling selling recital T-Shirts. Recital T-shirts are \$25 each and will be distributed in class before the recital. There will be a Beauty & the Beast themed design on the front. Artwork will be posted at the studio soon and emailed to everyone to preview. We will also be offering a tank with artwork on front. # RECITAL TIGHTS

To ensure that there are no discrepancies in color and style, students are required to have the following tights for their classes. Since we do not have a fully stocked dance store in town anymore I am going to order the tights for the COMBO classes since they do not wear tights as part of their normal dress code. All level 1b and classes will need to order their tights using the link below. Tights for the combo classes will be \$10 per pair. These tights will be sent home the week of March 27 th so that you have them for pictures. If you are set up on draft we will draft your account for an additional \$10 (3/4, 4/5 and 5/6 combo classes) and \$20(for the 6/7 combo classes-two pair of tights) on April 1 for your tights. If you pay semester by check please send a check for your tights to the dance academy no later than April 1. Remember: This is for the combo classes only. All other classes must purchase their tights. Here is the link to purchase recital tights for level 1B and higher. The pink tights for ballet are the same as your normal dress code but if your dancer takes jazz or hip hop you will need to purchase the tan tights. Please do not substitute styles or colors. ## Recital Souvenir Yearbook/Program

We produce a beautiful “souvenir yearbook” program for the recital each year. The program is 8 ½ X 11 with a glossy cover and heavy-weight paper inside. It usually approximately 100 pages. The printed version of the program will be in black and white, however this year we will produce a digital version of the “souvenir yearbook” program that will be in color. There will be a QR code made available to everyone who attends the recital that can be scanned to view the color version of the souvenir book. We will be taking a class photo during class time in the upcoming weeks (see below for dates) and this photo will be included free of charge as part of your recital fee. If you would like your child's individual photo to appear in the program as well, you may purchase an “AD” displaying their photo and well wishes. You may also sell an “AD” to businesses which will include your child's picture in addition to the business logo or personal message. A sample of an ad is attached to this newsletter. You can see last year's program in the lobby of the studios. Families will receive one complimentary recital program with the purchase of an “AD.” Additional printed copies can be purchased for \$10 and must be pre-ordered to assure that you get the amount of copies you need. The free copy with ad purchase and any additional copies you buy will be picked up at dress rehearsal at JA the day before your child's recital. **All ad contracts must be turned in by 6:00 pm on April 10<sup>th</sup>.**

## Class Pictures

Class Pictures We will be taking an informal class photo of each class during their regular class the week of March 27th in Madison and April 3rd at the Reservoir. Dancers are to be sure to wear their dress code and have their hair fixed neatly out of their face for the class photo. All hair will be worn in a bun for the actual recital for all combo and ballet classes and out of the face for jazz, contemporary and hip hop. You will receive these instructions soon for recital day. We are not requiring a bun for the combo and ballet classes for class photo days for level 1A and under but we do recommend it. At the very least please have your dancer's hair fixed neatly out of their face. Dancers in ballet 2 and higher must wear their hair in a bun for the class photos as it is a requirement for these classes anyway. We ask Hip Hop dancers to wear their hair pulled back in a pony tail for the class photos.

DID YOU KNOW that the Mississippi Metropolitan Ballet has been a member of Regional Dance America/Southeast (RDA/SE) for 14 years?

MMB became an honor company (the highest member status) last year based on our performance at the 2020 festival.

MMB is the only company in the state of Mississippi that is a member of this prestigious organization. Our membership in RDASE sets us apart from other dance studios.

RDA/SE is an association of dance companies that promotes excellence in instruction, choreography, performance and production. It offers regional and national networking between directors, choreographers and dancers along with providing educational and scholarship opportunities for dancers and choreographers. In 2020 our dancers received over \$40,000 in scholarship offers to summer programs and Universities. RDA/SE strives to foster the growth of dance education and the appreciation of dance throughout local communities.

RDA member companies participate in an adjudication each year where a dance professional is sent to each company to watch the company in class and performance. He/She provides detailed feedback to the member company which helps us grow and improve. We perform several pieces of choreography and the adjudicator selects which piece that each member company will perform at the annual festival in May. This year's festival is in Montgomery, AL. Our 2023 Adjudicator was Penny Askew, the former Director of the Western Oklahoma Ballet Theatre. Ms. Askew selected the piece "Impulse" choreographed by MMB 17 year old dancer Eleanora Ellis to be performed on the Emerging Choreographers Concert and the piece "Dream" choreographed by George Birkadze to be performed on the Gala Concert at the 2023 Festival. We are so proud of our dancers!
