## MORE RECITAL INFO

#### MMDA Recital Themes for 2022

All Ballet 1b classes and higher recital theme will be "Aladdin" for the ballet portion of their recital and "From Hollywood to Broadway" for the jazz, contemporary and hip-hop portion of the recital. The theme for all combo classes (3/4 Combo, 4/5 Combo, 5/6 Combo, 6/7 Combo) recitals will be "Once Upon a Time."

#### Recital Costumes

All recital costumes were ordered the first week in December. When your costumes come in please remove them from the bag they come in and hang them in a safe place. Many of the costumes get very wrinkled in shipping and may require a steamer to get the wrinkles out. Also, if your child's costume has straps, check the fit of the straps. Sometimes straps need to be taken up if they are not adjustable. Several of the costumes have been sent home already. The costume companies are having supply problems so there are a few costumes that are backordered and the original ship dates have been pushed forward. Therefore, some costumes will not be here for the April 9th and 10th picture day. I am sending emails on Friday, March 11th to the individual classes who will not have their costumes by April 9/10. Those dancers will need to sign up for pictures on the April 23rd picture day.

#### **Recital Photos**

Recital Photos will be taken on Saturday, April 9<sup>th</sup> from 9:00-5:00 pm at the Madison studio and on Sunday, April 10<sup>th</sup> from 1:00-6:00pm at the Reservoir studio and Saturday, April 23rd at the Madison studio from 10:00-3:00. Recital photos are not mandatory; this is just for your convenience. These are your photos, and your child can wear their hair any way you prefer. However, if you are planning to use the photo in the recital program; dancers in ballet level 2b and higher must wear their hair in a bun for these photos. Dancers taking photos in jazz, contemporary or hip hop costumes may wear their hair any way you prefer for photos. Leah Kackley of Sanomo Photo-sanomophoto.com is the photographer and she has several packages available. One of her portrait rate sheets is attached for your review. Please bring the filled-out photo form on the day of pictures. Do Not turn in at the studio. If you buy an ad or want to put your dancer's photo in the recital program but do not want to buy a photo packet, you may come and have your child's photo taken strictly for the program book for \$12.00.

#### **Recital Tickets**

Each family will receive 2 free tickets to the dance recital. On April 8th at midnight tickets will go on sale. This year you will be required to go online to reserve your two free tickets along with any additional tickets that you may want to purchase. Additional tickets are \$10. The link to purchase tickets along with specific instructions will be forthcoming in the next few weeks.

**T-shirts & Tanks:** We are offering recital t-shirts and tanks for sale through our online store. Both are \$25 each and will be distributed in class before the recital. There will be a "Aladdin" or "Once Upon a Time" themed design on the back of the t-shirt and the MMDA logo on the front left chest. Tanks will only be offered with the Aladdin design on the front. #### Recital Souvenir Yearbook/Program

We produce a beautiful "souvenir yearbook" program for the recital each year. The program is 8 ½ X 11 with a glossy cover and heavyweight paper inside. It usually approximately 100 pages. The printed version of the program will be in black and white, however this year we will produce a digital version of the "souvenir yearbook" program that will be in color. There will be a QR code made available to everyone who attends the recital that can be scanned to view the color version of the souvenir book. We will be taking a class photo during class time in the upcoming weeks(weeks are listed in this newsletter) and this photo will be included free of charge as part of your recital fee. If you would like your child's individual photo to appear in the program as well, you may purchase an "AD" displaying their photo and well wishes. You may also sell an "AD" to businesses which will include your child's picture in addition to the business logo or personal message. A sample of an ad is attached to this newsletter. You can see last year's program in the lobby of the studios. Families will receive one complimentary recital program with the purchase of an "AD." Additional printed copies can be purchased for \$10 and must be pre-ordered to assure that you get the amount of copies you need. The free copy with ad purchase and any additional copies you buy will be picked up at dress rehearsal at JA the day before your child's recital. All ad contracts must be turned in by 9:00 AM on April 11<sup>th</sup>.

#### Class Pictures

We will be taking an informal class photo of each class during their regular class time the week of March 21<sup>st</sup> in Madison and March 28<sup>th</sup> at the Reservoir. Dancers are to be sure to wear their dress code and have their hair fixed neatly out of their face for the class photo. All hair will be worn in a bun for the actual recital for all combo and ballet classes and out of the face for jazz, contemporary and hip hop. You will receive these instructions soon for recital day. We are not requiring a bun for the combo and ballet classes for class photo days for level 1A and under but we do recommend it. At the very least please have your dancer's hair fixed neatly out of their face. Dancers in ballet 2 and higher must wear their hair in a bun for the class photos as it is a requirement for these classes anyway. We ask Hip Hop dancers to wear their hair pulled back in a pony tail for the class photos.



#### Ballet Term of the Month

Gargouillade is a classical ballet term meaning "rumbling." A dancer performs a gargouillade by degageing one leg to the side, then doing a small rond de jambe with that leg while pushing off the floor with the other leg and then doing a rond de jambe with that leg! The rond de jambes must both happen in the air before closing to fifth.

Mississippi Metropolitan Ballet presents a brand-new production of Charles Maple's "Wizard of Oz" on April 2 and 3 at Jackson Academy Performing Arts Center. Follow Dorothy from Kansas to Munchkin land and along the Yellow Brick Road to Oz, where she meets the Wizard. DID YOU KNOW that the Mississippi Metropolitan Ballet has been a member of Regional Dance America/Southeast (RDA/SE) for 14 years?

MMB became an honor company (the highest member status) last year based on our performance at the 2020 festival.

MMB is the only company in the state of Mississippi that is a member of this prestigious organization. Our membership in RDASE sets us apart from other dance studios.

RDA/SE is an association of dance companies that promotes excellence in instruction, choreography, performance and production. It offers regional and national networking between directors, choreographers and dancers along with providing educational and scholarship opportunities for dancers and choreographers. in 2020 our dancers received over \$40,000 in scholarship offers to summer programs and Universities. RDA/SE strives to foster the growth of dance education and the appreciation of dance throughout local communities.

RDA member companies participate in an adjudication each year where a dance professional is sent to each company to watch the company in class and performance. He/She provides detailed feedback to the member company which helps us grow and improve. We perform several pieces of choreography and the adjudicator selects which piece that each member company will perform at the annual festival in May. This year's festival is in Daytona, FL. Our 2022 Adjudicator was Armando Luna, the former Director of the Atlanta Ballet Center for Dance Education. Our dancers performed beautifully and we are so proud of them!
