🎒 What to Bring

Required

- Washable bed/blanket
- Sufficient food (plus a little extra)
- Medications and pill pockets
- Slow feeder (if needed)

Optional

- Harness
- Jacket
- Toys, chews, or treats (especially if your dog has allergies)

Provided On Site

- Leashes
- Bowls (unless a slow feeder is needed)

Please Leave These at Home

- Rope toys
- Hard-framed beds
- Crates/kennels



Feeding Info

- We can feed your pup just like at home—including raw diets
- We have freezer space for long stays
- Maintaining your dog's normal regimen is important to us

Vaccination Requirements

- Rabies
- Distemper
- Bordetella
- Leptospirosis

 **Puppies:** Please wait **10–14 days after vaccinations** before arrival

 **Revaccination:** Wait **72 hours** before arrival

 Flea, lice & tick prevention is **recommended**, not required

 Only **signed vaccine certificates** accepted

Daily Schedule

- **6:00 AM** – First bathroom break
- **7:00 AM** – Breakfast
- **9:30 AM onward** – Walks begin, with outdoor time throughout the day
- **12:00 PM** – Lunch (for mid-day eaters)
- **4:00 PM** – Dinner
- **8:30 PM** – Final bathroom break

 **Outdoor play is guided by weather and tailored to each dog's limits and needs. No two days look the same—variety keeps things fun and enriching!**
