RULES TO BE OBSERVED AT ST MARY'S POOL

Please read and retain the following rules associated with the swimming lessons at St. Mary's School pool. Note that neither the Head Teacher nor the Swimming Instructors will be held responsible for any injury to persons or loss/damage to property whilst on the premises. The parent/guardian will be responsible for any damage to school property caused by their child/children.

- 1. Pupils shall at all times obey any instructions given by the swimming teacher(s) whether or not the same is embodied in these rules and comply with any safety regulations that from time to time may be in operation.
- 2. Pupils and parents must not enter the pool building unless an H2O Swim School member of staff is present. Pupils must not enter the water until directed to do so by the swimming teacher. Floats and other swimming aids are to be used only when under the instruction and supervision of the Swimming Instructor.
- 3. No running is permitted on any part of the premises. Children not swimming are the responsibility of the parent/guardian/carer and must remain with them at all times. They must not be allowed to run around the swimming pool area. No pupil shall push or attempt to push any person into the pool.
- 4. Diving is forbidden at all times unless specifically instructed to do so by the Swimming Instructor.
- 5. Do not bring glass/plastic bottles, cans or potentially dangerous containers onto the premises where the swimming pool operates. No food or drink will be allowed on the premises.
- 6. A swimming hat must be worn in the water, (these can be purchased from the Swim School).
- 7. The School and Playgrounds are out of bounds at all times. The parent/guardian/carer will be held responsible for any damage to school property caused by their child.
- 8. The use of mobile phones is forbidden on poolside. No parent, or member of the public, will be allowed to take photographs, or video footage, of the children in the swimming pool unless prior permission has been given by the Swimming School and by the parents of the children involved.
- 9. Spectators should sit on the right hand side of the pool. It would be appreciated if the numbers of spectators were kept to a minimum, as space is very limited. Please vacate the changing area as quickly and as quietly as possible.
- 10. No jewellery may be worn (including earrings) whilst swimming in the water. The parent/guardian/carer will be responsible for the safe keeping of any of their child/children's valuables.
- 11. Classes will be run during the East Sussex school term and will be invoiced by the term. Should for any reason I have to cancel a lesson, an alternative day and time will be offered where possible. No refunds will be provided for lessons that are cancelled for reasons outside the control of the Swim School.

Please note that parking within the school or St Mary's church grounds is not permitted at any time.

St Mary's head teacher has restricted the use of the school parking spaces to the staff only. Vehicles should be parked either on the road outside the school grounds, or alternatively All Saints Church has kindly agreed to allow parents to use their car park, which is located a few minutes' walk from the school. From the school turn right towards Crowborough and left on to Church Road. Take the first turning right into The Glebelands and follow the road round and the car park is located on your right hand side.

When walking down the drive to and from St. Mary's pool building please ensure that you keep on the side pathway where possible. Please do not walk in the roadway where a path is available, particularly where the driveway bends sharply.

Failure to comply with any of the above rules may result in you being asked to leave the Swim School.
