MPC Space 1999 This was an easy kit to built, painted Tamiya gloss white. The many decals were softened by using Solvaset




Hasegawa 1/24 Toyota Taka-Q

The kit is a typical Japanese auto kit with simplified undercarriage detail, no engine Horrible decals to place and broke multiple times.

Masking was easy though, for the separate colors that didn't have decals provided in the kit

Tamiya 1/72 Zero early war



Tamiya 1/48 FW 190-A8
This version had extra plating on the sides.
Painted with AK paints & thinner, couldn't mask over it

Tamiya 1/48 Corsair MK IV

Launched from the HMS Formidable in the Pacific theater, it bombed targets in Viet Nam and Formosa

Painted Glossy sea blue and lightly weathered showing paint faded panels



Hetzer Bergpanther 1/35 tow vehicle

The kit contains lots of small parts and small photo etch that is not seen inside
The instructions show exploded diagrams, so the placement of parts was vague and therefore a lot
were not used

The crane was difficult to build



Revell S-boat

The kit had very poor instructions for the small parts location
It took a lot of tweeking to get the deck to go onto the fixed hull
This was a commission build

Airfix AC47 gunship converted to a civilian aircraft. This is a representation of a 1948 SAS Flying Vikings aircraft. Scandinavian Air used aircraft leftover from the war. The aircraft was painted with multiple silvers: Citidel, Tamiya, Silver Sharpie and a paint pen. The real aircraft had a cloth rudder and it was duplicated on the model with ribs. The decals were purchased on line. A sextant was used through the top bubble for navigation






Revell 1/144 P3A Orion - The kit came with no clear canopy, canopy was from a civilian Elektra. The model has a sculpted front end and nose. Starboard windows were made using Citidel green paint and window maker white glue.



John's Tip: Old kits may be the only way to get an interesting subject!

Hand sculpted figure, posed to leap from a building. The figure had to be engineered to be broken apart to make a mold and cast multiple copies. The mold box was made up of foam core, seams taped and sealed with hot melt glue gun. The sculpted figure was in-bedded in clay and thoughtfully placed to minimize the seam line. There was a wire molded into one foot as a sturdy mounting point, also acted as a casting vent hole. The mold was keyed using metal acorn nuts and to allow correct placement. Platinum based silicon was used on the mold pour and the air was vacuumed out. Once the original piece was removed from the mold, the resin was poured in and pressure cast. Using these techniques, even small and thin parts can be cast.

Italeari 1/9 Harley- Davidson 750A motorcycle contract build for golf tournament
Two models were built, one for the tournament and one for the sponsor, Harv's Harley- Davidson
The model was engineered to be built up in layers, one upon another, inside to out
It was very important to research the particular type to get the details correct (as all model are)
The completed model is were delicate and top heavy (like the real thing) and needed to be pinned to
the base

Paint was overall Olive drab, aluminum engine block with black details and 3 shades of leather colors mixed for the seat and saddle bags

The hardest part of the build was masking of the windscreen that was very fragile
