Meredith Gardens Neighborhood Beautification

With spring in the air, Meredith Gardens Homeowners Association is evaluating some beautification projects for our neighborhood.

The first project is a spruce-up to the median on the Brookhurst St. access road. These days the median has been looking in need of help. This project was proposed by local realtor, Jo-An Hawley Verstraete, who is willing to help with some professional landscape support, weeding and new plants. It is anticipated we will also ask for volunteer help from local high school clubs, Boy Scouts, neighborhood residents, etc. We are presently working with the City for permission and direction on what we are allowed to do. We are trying to make this happen in the very near term, so stay tuned.

Meredith Gardens Homeowners Association budget is set aside each year for periodic wall maintenance. The MG walls and signs were last painted in 2009. This summer, the 10 MG signs will be sanded, repaired, cleaned, and painted to look like new. As done previously, the Board will be looking for teens from the neighborhood interested in helping with this project. When the perimeter wall was last painted, the work required was extensive. The walls were pressure-sprayed, scraped/ repaired where needed, painted and back-rolled with quality paint. They have held up fairly well for eight years. Most of the peeling paint now visible is from resident back yard moisture from behind the walls.

We are currently collecting bids from painters for this project. This is a fairly big job - between the Brookhurst and Adams segments, there is over 2000 feet of wall. As budget allows, this project will take place at the earliest this fall, but no later than next spring. As we get nearer, we will be asking residents around the perimeter of the tract for permission to tie into a water source for pressure spray cleaning the wall immediately adjacent to their homes.

The seven residents directly affected by the building will have a new wall built flush against the existing wall starting in July. This was agreed by these residents since the construction would be the least damaging and disruptive.
