

- Adults only, please







Lebard Park and Housing Development Update

Updates on the progress of the housing development and the park for LeBard are provided on a regular basis on the NextDoor App. Communication with both the Keystone Developers and H.B. City Planning Department has been very good. The lates schedule on the demolition of the school are:

- Plan to start the building demo January 2018.
- The asphalt will be demoed Late January 2018
- The Park parking resurface January/February

Once the actual demolition takes place the equipment used will be bulldozers and excavators. Large dump trucks will be used to carry the trash offsite likely using Brookhurst via Crailet but could use other routes thru the neighborhood. Parking of the workers will be inside the property when available and in the Park parking lots when construction on the new street is under way. Several neighbors have asked about the asbestos in the school. Keystone has indicated there is some asbestos in the building. The asbestos removal company is working to remove it in compliance with the AQMD and being watched closely by the city. LeBard Park will be affected by the housing construction. A swell will be built in the park for water drainage. While the swings have been repaired, the jungle-gym will not be fixed until the renovation to the rest of the park is completed. Any other enhancements will be schedule after the construction. Contact with the Community Services and Public Works is on-going and as updates are provided the information will be posted on NextDoor.


MG Movie Night
