PRE-ENTRY FEES \$14.00 for 1st dog, \$8.00 add'l dogs, same household, to a max of \$30 per day.

POST-ENTRY FEE \$20.00 per dog. Post entries close 1/2 hour before roll call.

ROLL CALL/DOG INSPECTION: 9:30am, both days.

WHERE: @ Race Secretary desk (Jennifer Johansson & Zsu Lindenmeir) .

WHY: Confirming you and your dog(s) presence, checking for bitches in season, lameness.

ELIGIBLE BREEDS:

Open to any Afghan Hound, Basenji, Borzoi, Greyhound, Ibizan Hound, Irish Wolfhound, Italian Greyhound, Pharaoh Hound, Rhodesian Ridgeback, Saluki, Scottish Deerhound, Silken Windhound, Sloughi, Thai Ridgeback and Whippet. Non-regular racing will be offered for other breeds.

ALL HOUNDS MUST BE CERTIFIED PRIOR TO ENTERING THEIR FIRST CARA RACE MEET.

- Mounds must be one year of age or older to be eligible to race.
- ☑All hounds must be individually registered with the AKC, CKC, UKC, NGA or any foreign registry, or possess a CKC PEN number.
- ☑All hounds must be registered with CARA. Every dog not already registered must submit payment of \$2.00 and a photocopy of the papers with your entry. CARA registration is for the life of the dog.
- Hounds with coursing or racing titles from other organizations will be exempt from the certification. The Certification Exemption form must be submitted the first time a dog is entered in an official race meet (Form can be found on page 9).

- Ribbons for BOB through 5th place
- Trophies for Best of Breed
- High Scoring Field Champion
- High Scoring Show Champion
- High Scoring Veteran (6 years)
- Turtle Award (lower qualifying score)



GENERAL INFORMATION

- All racers must wear muzzles and racing blankets.
- Racing blankets can be purchased by contacting Laurie Soutar at Sirius Supply.

- All races are ~ 200 yards, and dogs will run three times unless scratched, dismissed, or disqualified. All programs will be a maximum of 4 dog races, with dogs running within their own breed only.
- All races will be box started exceptions may be made for individual breeds ,as necessary, and will be hand slipped.
- Track will be drag, with real fur lure and/or white plastic.
- Exhibitors (a.k.a., dog owners) are expected to help in re-stringing the lure following each run by walking the lure from the finish line back to the starting line. Suitable footwear is highly recommended. Thank you!!

CERTIFICATION

- Certification runs will be available following the official race meet program.
- Please let the **Secretary, Ms Jennifer Johansson**, know if you have dogs needing qualification on your arrival.
- NCHC will help to make arrangements in finding two (2) dogs that can race with the 'dog to be certified' in order to complete the required two (2) qualifying runs.

PRACTICE

- Practice runs will offered on both days.
- Practice fee is 5\$ per 2 runs per dog.

Note. For this event, NCHC <u>will NOT offer free practice</u> for any volunteers including club members, field workers, and foul & finish judges.

Further, the dog will be considered to be on probation for its first two race meets. The designation P will be added to a dog's CARA registration number while it is on probation.
