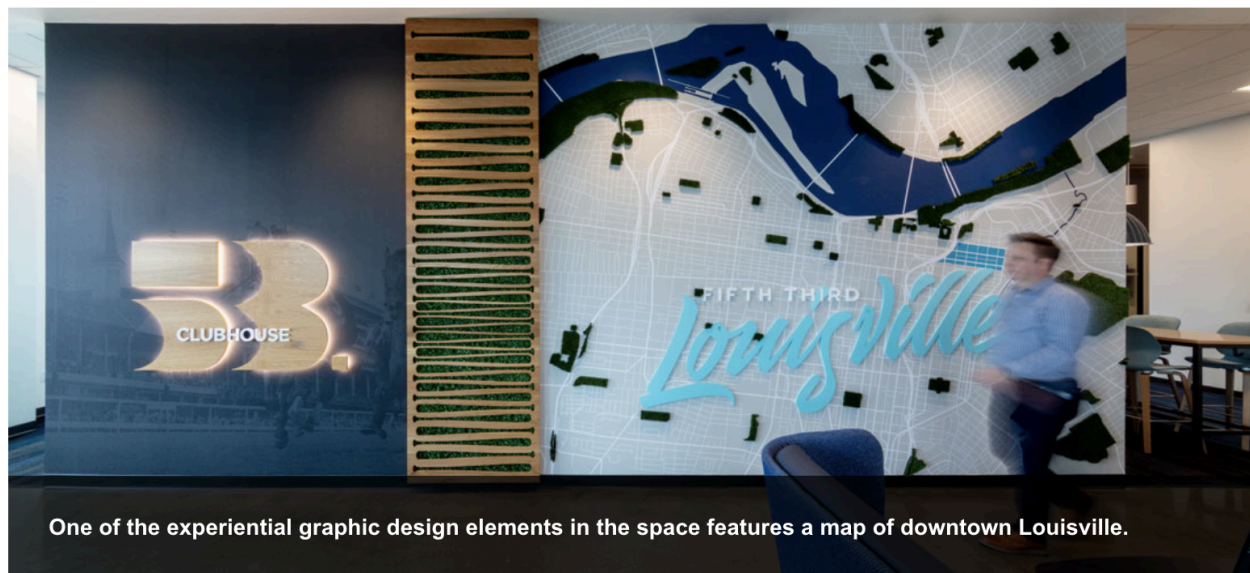
technology to flexible student collaborative spaces, we've worked to ensure the facility supports Galen's mission and can adapt to the future needs of nursing education."
