- Family Contact Information form
- Family Medication form
- Copies of health insurance cards for your family
- A copy of your homeowner's insurance policy
- Birth certificates and Social Security cards
- Driver's licenses and vehicle registration
- Copies of major credit cards (front and back)
- Bank account and contact numbers
Local hospital addresses and phone numbers
- Inventory of valuables in your home
- Recent service or utility bill with your home address

HURRICANE DOCUMENTS AND PHONE NUMBERS

- Local and state highway maps
- Local emergency management office phone number
- A copy of your homeowner's insurance policy
- Local law enforcement phone numbers
- Local utilities' phone numbers
- County and city government phone numbers
- Local hospital addresses and phone numbers
- Local American Red Cross shelter phone number
- Local radio station frequencies and phone numbers
- Maps to your local shelter
