

How do I get an application?

Applications are available through the Marion & Polk Early Learning for 2020-2021 program year consideration.

I applied last year & didn't get in. Do I need to reapply?

Yes. All applicants who are not currently attending a Preschool Promise program need to reapply.

If eligible, is my child guaranteed a spot?

Applying does not automatically enroll your child or secure a spot.

What will I need to apply for this program?

- Age verification: Child birth certificate, hospital record OR immunization records.
- Income verification: 2019 income tax form 1040 or 1040A, 2019 form W-2, OR pay stubs for the last 12 months of employment*.
- Oregon residency verification: Copy of driver's license, ID card, OR utility bill.
- * Please note that children in foster care are categorically eligible for Preschool Promise.

Preschool Promise offers free, high-quality preschool for 3 and 4-year-old children from income-eligible families.
