Applications for the Southwest Academy of Management Doctoral Student Consortium in San Antonio are now being invited

Get ready to join your peers and mentors for a great experience learning how to navigate academia, research, network, and a lot more at the 2020 Southwest Academy of Management annual conference in San Antonio, TX. The conference runs from March 11-13, with the doctoral student consortium on Thursday, March 12. There is no cost for the consortium. It allows for management doctoral students at various stages in their program to make friends with likewise situated students and learn from junior and senior faculty in their field about time management, research & publishing, teaching, and other career-related issues. Seating is limited and applications will be processed on a first-come basis. There are a limited number of competitive \$300 stipends available to those management doctoral students who: (1) participate in the SWAM conference, (2) register for the conference, and (3) participate in the doctoral consortium. Doctoral students with accepted sole-authored papers are given first priority for stipends, followed by doctoral student with co-authors who are all doctoral students (less number of authors has priority), followed by doctoral students with co-authors who are doctoral students and faculty, followed by doctoral students who participate in panels, development workshops, or poster sessions. Doctoral students must attend the entire doctoral consortium to receive the stipend. Students who want to attend the consortium and the conference but not actively participate in the conference may apply to join the consortium without a stipend.

If you are a currently enrolled doctoral student in management or a closely related discipline, and are interested in attending the consortium, please email Dr. Robert Epstein, University of Central Oklahoma, at repstein@uco.edu by December 15, 2019. Doctoral students receive reduced registration fees and are eligible for scholarships and awards for best papers submitted to the conference. You may be asked to provide additional information when stipends are awarded. Applicants will be notified around mid-January 2020.

2. Your current CV
3. Letter from your Doctoral Program Coordinator, Advisor, or Department chair verifying that you are a doctoral student in good standing.
