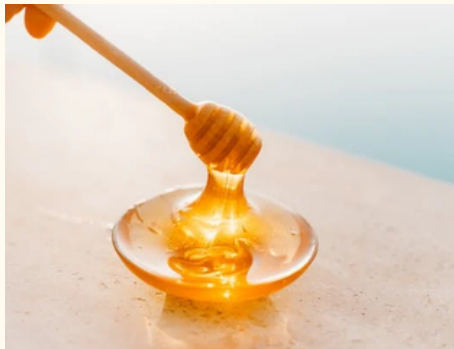


THE HAULIN' OATS BAR SOAP:
