

Traditional Style Booths


Cali (left)

- Inside back angle creates a streamlined, elegant appearance and a more comfortable resting position
- Ideal for situations where guests will be seated for longer periods

Marquis (right)

- Inside back combines with higher crown on the seat to encourage a more forwardsitting position.
- Perfect for touch down spaces.

Pullover top and wraparound ends creates the most furniture-like appearance





What's In Your Booth?

Common booth complaints:

- Back Rocking
- Squeaking
- Seating that bottoms out/uneven cushions

The Berco Quality Difference

- Frame Integrity
- Springs & Spring Clips
- Decking
- Industry-leading 12-year warranty.





What's In Your Booth?

Single Piece End Frame Construction

- Can't separate
- Prevents back rocking

Industry standard: 2 pieces glued together, which separate over time with use





What's In Your Booth?

(13) 8 ½ Gauge Seat Springs

- •Double springs on both ends
- •Less bounce getting in and out of booth
- •Heavy-duty springs hold more weight, extending booth life

Industry Standard: (10) 9 ½ gauge springs





What's In Your Booth?

Teflon Spring Clips

Eliminate Squeaking

Industry Standard: none





What's In Your Booth?

Flex Insulator

- Wire-reinforced flex insulator
- Keeps springs from twisting
- Redistributes weight across the booth for longer life

Industry Standard: no wire





What's In Your Booth?

Fiber Decking

- •3/8" Ragabond
- •Prevents spring from being seen from the surface of the booth

Industry Standard: no decking, springs visible to user





What's In Your Booth?

High Slip Polyetheline

 Protects both foam and vinyl from wear as customers slide in and out of booth

Industry Standard: none


