

This includes: painting, drawing, digital art, short films, etc. What matters most is your interpretation of these themes, not your artistic expertise. A selection of art pieces may be exhibited during the event and/or across official **Gandhi-King Season For Nonviolence** Internet Sites etc. Digital submissions must be submitted as a high-quality JPEG, GIF, or MPEG.

### In order to submit your art piece digitally it must be:

- 1400 x 1400 pixels minimum; 3000 x 3000 pixels maximum
- A high quality JPEG file type for still images is preferred.
- A high quality GIF or MPEG file type for moving images or slideshows etc.
- File should be named as "Art Peace & Your Name/Organization or School etc."


