STRUCTURE

- Two day or four day program
- Support throughout the preschool day and across all activities
- High ratio of support (one educator to two children)
- Small group instruction, 1:1 sessions and facilitated playdates
- Specialist team of educators & therapists
- Goal-oriented intervention across key learning areas
- Individualised Learning Plans and ongoing data collection
- Transition support and faded supports to promote full inclusion

KEY LEARNING AREAS

- Everyday Living Skills Goal areas: mealtimes, toileting and building independence
- Transitions & Routines Goal areas: following routines, independent transitions, group participation
- Functional Communication Goal areas: building functional communication skills, conversation skills and language in play
- Social Skills and Play Skills
 Goal areas: expanding play skills and building social skills with peers





LEVELS OF SUPPORT Systematically fading intervention to build independence



Focused Individualised program providing 1:1 intervention + level 2 group based program. Intervention occurring across multiple settings eg pre school and childcare. Services include additional therapy hours through therapy assistant and consultation from lead therapist

Level 2: Early Intervention Group Program

Two-day group based early intervention program (min 16 hours/week.) Small group instruction and 1:2 ratio across the day.

Level 3: Transition Support

Social skills/ School Readiness group, collaboration with teacher, Individualised education support and therapy support allocated as needed.

Consultative services offered throughout the year as needed.
