"When Tragedy Strikes"

he whole idea behind "unexpected" is that it's unexpected. Duh! And no one likes to talk about the ultimate unexpected occurrence—the premature death of a parent or spouse. But although none of us wants it to happen, we're all praying that it doesn't happen, and we don't want to talk about it, life shows us no matter what we do, we have little to no control over when our loved ones will (I'm going to say it) die. In addition to holding a healthy, realistic understanding of death, preparation goes a long way toward softening the gut punch that will follow the receipt of the shocking news of your loved one's demise. Trust me, I know. At the writing of this article, I'm only 2 months past the death of my husband. The items we had worked through saved a tremendous amount of frustration, but the things we hadn't thought of are still being figured out.

(Note: If your loved one has already passed away suddenly, I am so, so sorry for your profound loss. Incorporate as much of #1 and #2 below as possible but moving straight to #3 will probably be more immediately helpful.)

#1 - Change. I believe 99% of the things we worry about never come to pass and the other 1% is going to happen whether we worry about it or not. With that in mind, death is one of those 1% happenings. So, the first thing to do is change our attitude about death. Face and erase the fear of death by understanding it as a part of life. Our faith in Christ takes away the dread because the death of the body is the beginning of a much better existence that will last for eternity. Paul shares this fact in II Corinthians 5:8 when he asserts, "We are confident, yes, well pleased rather to be absent from the body and to be present with the Lord" (NKJ).



#2 - Communicate. Next, start talking with your family members about death. Approach the subject gently, letting everyone know that no one is sick right now; however, you understand death to be a reality and accurate information about it is important. Start talking about it in a casual way. Discuss what the Bible says about Heaven and the glories of eternal life. Secure children's books that discuss the subject on the kids' levels. For example, my children's book, Mommy Cried This Morning explains, "Our bodies weren't created to just fly away through space, [Pop] had to leave his body here to see God face to face. The part of him that loved us will live on in memory. He now no longer lives in pain; he's happy as can be."

In addition to the explanations about death, read about and discuss emotions such as anger, sadness, apprehension, doubt, fear, loneliness, and grief. Ensure all family members have words to use to express their feelings and take time to encourage that expression whenever necessary. Grief takes many forms and lengths of time. Never discourage family members and friends from giving voice to their emotions. Getting those feelings out is healthy. We will find that others become freed to vent their feelings too, and everyone can move toward healing.

Finally, all adult family members should write an advance directive communicating their final wishes and understand that the immediate next of kin carries the legal right to carry out those crucial final decisions on behalf of the dying loved one. For example, in the event of no further cure from a medical perspective, my husband James did not want his life to prolonged by machines. Although heart-wrenching, my responsibility was to be sure the hospital, doctors, family members, and friends understood and respected his desire.

- #3 Connect. Third, start reaching out to the necessary professionals and companies to gather information and get a name of the person who can help you.
- See an attorney to help you draft your living trust.
- Call the Social Security Administration to find out about your standing. For example, for married couples, if both people draw social security benefits, when one spouse dies, the living spouse will continue receiving whichever person's benefit was highest.

- Check with your bank or other investment companies to discuss your retirement income or standing.
- Purchase life insurance. When someone dies, life insurance policies pay off quickly and since death is an extremely expensive event, cash in hand is extremely useful. Insurance was there for me when I still needed to pay for the programs and flower arrangements for the service.
- Make pre-need arrangements with a mortuary and a cemetery. When we first got married, James and I bought a pre-need plan. Upon his death, just one call to the mortuary that already had our arrangements on file got things moving. What a relief it was to know that everything I needed to cover the expense of his funeral was covered except for the few things the cemetery would not allow us to pay for in advance.

#4 – Change, Choose, and Commence. Next, make appointments and actually start filling out paperwork that gets your preparation underway.

- Single people with adult children, choose one of your children to be a signer on your bank account. Nothing will need to be transferred when you die. Your child will then simply take over using the accounts. James and I had joint bank accounts, so now I alone control those accounts. As a widow now, one of my sons will be a signer on my checking account and the other will be a signer on my savings account.
- Married couples Change ownership paperwork to both names. This includes your mortgage; other properties and real estate; your cars, motorcycles, and boat titles; your IRAs and bank accounts; health insurance; safety deposit boxes; and savings bonds. Couples will also save themselves a lot of headaches if the following are also in both names: regular monthly bills (water, gas, trash collection, phone, internet service, cable television service, etc.), and credit cards. The idea is anything you can think of that you would have to transfer to the other person's name when one spouse dies, put both names on it while you are both still living.

Note: Individual credit card accounts belong to each individual person. If the living spouse did not open that account, he or she is not responsible to have to pay the spouse's debts.

Whether you're married or not, decide who you will choose to be beneficiaries for all accounts you leave behind. You can divide the amounts by percentage among multiple beneficiaries. For example, your remaining spouse could receive 50% and your five children can receive 10% each.

#5 - Celebrate. Finally, breathe a sigh of relief and celebrate the fact that you can live with the comfort of knowing when death does happen—expectantly or unexpectantly—the business surrounding the event is already taken care of. You can use your energy spending time with your family and friends and enjoying the pleasant memories of your loved one who has moved from earth to Glory.



Wounded By My Dad, Set Free By My Father

I grew up desperately needing validation from my father. All I ever I wanted to do was to please him. In school I made the highest grades and I became a great athlete. I excelled in sports.

I received scholarships from the best colleges and sports programs but it was never enough. No hugs, pat on the shoulder or even an encouraging word. He never told me that he loved me.

My dad passed away when I was in my early twenties. My desire to be the best to do the best was suddenly gone. His death eliminated all of my desires to be the best in school and sports. I spent years trying to please my earthly father.

Dad never expressed any joy for any my accomplishments, so I felt he was not pleased with me. The sting of not measuring up to his expectations was a heavy burden to bare, so I turned to alcohol and drugs to numb the pain of not being enough. It led me to live a destructive life.

Although, I completed my education and began my teaching career I carried a lot of baggage. I was spiraling downward filled with emotional pain and I was lost with no direction and no self-worth. I was angry at the world, bitter, critical and hard to get along with


When I met my wife Roseanne, I never healed from the trauma. She was broken just as broken as I was. We had our first born son who was born with severe brain damage. We found out that he would never live a normal life. Our marriage suffered greatly from that revelation and I turned my pain into more anger, more alcohol and drug use.

One day Roseanna turned her life over to God and became a Proverbs 31 woman. For the next seven years, she spent time in prayer and studying the Bible.

Roseanna loved me through all of my verbal abuse and all of my mess. Finally, she had enough and with lots of faith, prayer and trusting God she gave me a ultimatum that I either change or the marriage was over. I knew she meant business, especially after I was arrested with a threat losing the possibility of losing my teaching credentials. Finally, I gave my life to Christ.

I spent many hours with the Lord allowing him to minister to me about my identity and who I was in HIM. This changed my way of thinking and it radically changed my life. I became a new creation. In Galatians 3: 29 it says, "If you are Christ's, then you are Abraham's seed and heirs according to the promise." We have the blessings of Abraham not just rich but very rich, with silver, gold, influence, blessings and righteousness. The devil wants us to look at ourselves in the flesh, but we are not in the flesh, we in the spirit. Our real identity is created in righteousness and holiness. Don't depend on your feelings! Jesus says we are forgiven, accepted, redeemed, and declared righteous and so much more.

Our identity in Christ is an important of our relationship with God and is not based on our education, economics, wealth or social status but rather having an intimate relationship with the Father. Those who know God intimately have a detailed knowledge of him and are chosen for greater purpose.





God created man in his own image on the 6th day, so we can't take any credit or glory. Man's duty is to enjoy the finished work of creation. We are a spirit man and God breathed life in us. He is spirit and he blew his spirit in us. We are a spirit being. As long as our word lines up with the word of God, we can speak things into existence. The things we see are temporal, the things we don't see are eternal. Faith is more real than the natural. If you live by sight alone you will limit yourself.

Holiness is having the mindset and posture of Jesus. 1
Peter 2:5 says, "You also, as living stones, are being built up a spiritual house, a holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ." I never knew this because I was carrying a Spirit of Rejection. God says we are chosen. In Ephesians 1: 4 says, "He chose us." He says we are a Royal Priesthood so we are valuable. God says were holy and belong to him and that is what makes us more valuable!

Isaiah 43:4 says, "You are precious to me. So through their faith in me, they will have their sins forgiven and receive their place among Gods chosen people." You don't feel capable? In 2 Corinthians 3: 5,6 it says, "The capacity we have comes from God, it is he who made us capable of serving the new covenant. Do you still feel you can't do anything? "You can do everything through Christ who gives you strength. Who are you going to believe? The accuser of the brethren or the God who says you can. God is saying go and serve me that is who you are!

When I gave my life to Christ I was struck down on the church entryway floor and was slain in the spirit.

I had no idea that I was about to receive my freedom from addiction of over 20 years! While I laid paralyzed on the floor, I felt the love of God wrap around my entire body. I felt the heaviness leaving me and I weeped out loud. I stood up feeling lighter, as if weight of the world seemed to lift off my shoulders! I realized that it was the demons of bondage leaving me. I haven't taken a drink or used any drug from that day ever!

Over time, I realized Jesus bought me with a price. It was his blood that He shed for me. My Identity is now solely in HIM. My value and worth was given to me from before the foundations of the world existed and before I was in the womb of my mother it was then Christ accepted, approved me, and most important validated me.

It was my Heavenly Father's validation I was seeking all along, and it was HIS acceptance that set me free!

God wants you to know that in Romans 8: 28 it will come to pass in your life and everything will work together for your good, even the horrific things, the traumatic things, the heartbreaking things, it will all work together for your good!
