After the very successful launching of the Christian Women's Word TV Network at CWWN.tv, we have just launched the Christian Men's Ministry TV Network at CMMN.tv.



"What Should You Do When You Feel Like Quitting?"

Have you ever realized that the "Spirit of Quit" always attacks your mind when things don't go the way you'd planned or hoped for?

Well, I've discovered how " quitters " can turn things around and begin to start again and even prosper, where you've once come up empty-handed, felt exhausted, discouraged, depressed, or even a failure.

Our greatest learning opportunities will often emerge from our mistakes, shortcomings, defeats, and failures. But only if you are willing to take control of your emotions and realize that where you are is not your final disappointment or your fatal breath of air.

One of the greatest passages of scripture that can be used to help you regain motivation, change your focus, readjust your energy, and reposition yourself is found in Luke 5: 4-7 NASB:

"When He (Jesus) had finished speaking, He said to Simon, "Put out into the deep water and let down your nets for a catch." Simon answered and said, "Master, we worked hard all night and caught nothing, but I will do as You say and let down the nets." When they had done this, they enclosed a great quantity of fish, and their nets began to break, so they signaled to their partners in the other boat for them to come and help them. And they came and filled both of the boats, so that they began to sink."


This biblical illustration is one of the most encouraging to me for many reasons. Can you hear, feel or identify with Simon Peter's absolute frustration?

Are you doing something and you're not feeling appreciated, only to go to bed frustrated because of your empty net? Do you feel overwhelmed with the challenges of trying to make a living, working overtime or 2 or 3 jobs to make it or struggling through your school or online classes? Are you in a relationship that seems as if it's not going anywhere?

As a man, I've often returned to this story because it's here that I can hear The Holy Spirit speak and give me the guidance, direction, and encouragement I need to get past any disappointment, discouragement, or sense of failure. It's through listening to the directions from Christ that the "Spirit of Quit" can be dealt with and overcome. It's here that you, too, will realize that "quitting is not your best option."

It's here that you too will learn that The Holy Spirit will often reveal and direct you to do something that either you've never done before or something that may even seem foolish to natural minds. But obedience is your single key towards overcoming a nervous breakdown and receiving your spiritual breakthrough or blessings from God.

Satan's temptation is always to keep you defeated by looking at your empty nets and listening to thoughts of discouragement, defeat, failure and impossibilities.



But just like in Simon Peter's situation, The Lord wants to speak to you in your situation and wants you to hear and follow His direction. And no matter how negative, painful, or impossible circumstances may appear, He knows the way out for you, and faith comes by hearing and obeying His direction.

Isn't that what Peter finally did? And his experience can become yours also! Why not try following the advice from The Lord? It time to get rid of the "spirit of quit" by asking The Holy Spirit to help you arise.

Stand up and begin to worship God and stand on His Word. For in doing so, you're attacking back and admitting that you're not the loser the devil or others want you to think that you are.


Hearing God always brings a fresh perspective that will inspire you no matter how many times you've struggled, been worn out, or failed.

I'm not usually one to scan these things and enter all the contests, but this one my daughter saw, and she checked it and said, "Momma, do this too; we can win something." So, for her, I did. I did not know any details about what we were entering; It was just something from Klove, so I had confidence we would like it. After some time, we made it to the front of the line, got our packets, and went our merry way. We were all so excited!!

We had waited a whole year for this and were ready to worship our King!! We saw that night at the kickoff

concert. Jordan Feliz was part of the lineup, and my daughter and aunt love him, so again, we got in line hours early to get a good seat. As the hours passed, we got more and more excited! And finally, the doors opened, and we made a mad dash for the closest set of six seats we could find. We landed on the right side about four rows back, and it was amazing! To see my daughter sing along in worship to songs like "Jesus is Coming Back" and "My Jesus" made my heart melt. It was priceless!! It had only been day one, and we already had a ball. When I started thinking about writing this article, I felt as though the Holy Spirit wasn't connecting with all of the themes that I had considered. But, he spoke to me in prayer and I realized that one thing that they wanted me to share is my journey to Christ. What it has done for me and the kingdom, how much it has transformed my every day life, my spiritual relationship with God and my relationship with Christianity as a whole. I'm hoping that this will become a tool that someone can use to teach and just share with others that there is always a path back to God. None of us is so far away that we can't ask him to come into our lives and be with the Father.

As I think about my journey, it wasn't a pretty one as a matter fact it was pretty horrific for a long time. I accepted Jesus into my life in 2001, so I've been a Christian for 23 years going on 24 which sounds to me like I'm almost a baby Christian, but I am far from it at this point, I know so much has happened in my life that without forgiveness from Jesus, I probably would not have been able to survive.

My ex-husband was extremely abusive verbally and mentally and in hindsight I know that Jesus was with me through it all, even though I had not accepted him as my personal Savior, even though I did not see him as who he was, he was still there with me. There are incidences over the years where now I recognize that I was under protection most of my life. And in 2001 after my divorce and after literally saving myself (so I thought) I decided to go to a Reverend Billy Graham revival at the Rose Bowl in California. I did this because my grandmother absolutely worshipped and adored him. Actually, anytime he was on the radio or

television most of my life. I knew that Grandma loved him and his messages.

After she passed away I thought I would go to honor her. If I'm totally honest, it was because I felt empty and lost. I was like a boat which had a rudder that was half working. But, I knew that there was something inside of me urging me to go.

That year at the Rose Bowl in California, Reverend Franklin Graham was there and so was Pastor Greg Laurie from Harvest. There was great music. This man walks up in a walker with Pastor Greg Laurie on one side and Reverend Franklin Graham on the other and my immediate thought was what is he gonna be able to tell me that I needed to hear. In hindsight that was very arrogant of me at the time. When he stood up to the podium and started to talk, it was the exact same voice with the same strength that I had heard as a little girl over the radio and over the TV and I was stunned. I didn't expect the strength. I didn't expect the power. I didn't expect the Holy Spirit to speak to me that way and through Reverend Billy Graham, but he did. By the time he finished with his message, I went down and accepted Chris as my personal Savior.

At that moment, it started to rain so slightly (symbolically washing me clean).

I looked at the people that I was with and I said I gotta go buy a Bible! I don't have one! We go to Pasadena to find a bookstore so I can buy a Bible. I went outside in the rain and I just felt like I was being washed clean, even though at the time I didn't understand all the ins and outs of Christianity.





I didn't understand what washed in the blood was and I didn't understand Living Water. I didn't understand any of it. I still needed to learn and when I looked at the Bible, I couldn't figure out where to start or what to react first! Who would have known, seven years later, I meet Jon my wonderful Pastor and Husband!

I'm an educator and I love learning so for me, getting every Bible Study I could was really important. I began to learn and study. I know now that God was preparing me for what he had planned.

Seven years later, I am going to a church in Palm Springs called, Desert Chapel. I liked the lead Pastor Fred, he's amazingly good at teaching the Word. I met the staff and Pastor who was Jon. Jon and I got married six months later. We just celebrated our 15th anniversary.

Eleven years ago, we joined Apache Wells Community Church in Mesa, AZ. We are Pastors of the church. It has been an amazing journey. There are ups and downs, but we have never doubted each other or our faith in Christ or our church.

I received a Bachelors, Masters and Doctorate in Divinity. I teach regularly on the Word and to be very honest I never thought this would be my life. The blessings that I have received have been so overwhelming, humbling and so transformative.

I know, it would never have happened without God's intervention. I have been literally and figuratively transformed in the sense that I don't have to worry about anything because I know God is in control.

When I tell you there's hope when you come to Christ. There is hope in the blood. There is hope in His Word. I don't say that lightly I say that as someone who has seen life without Christ until my 40s. Now I have Christ and in my 60s and I am teaching His Word. This only happened through God and my knowledge of God, my faith and my love of him.

I can say is it's never too late to give your heart to God.

I now share my ministry with women who feel lost, who feel like God is forgetting them, has given up on them or they've done too much to ever seek God's face. Don't let that stop you. Those are the lies of the enemy. God still wants you.

I have been at the deathbed of people who've accepted Christ and I've seen their faces. I've seen their joy when they go be with the Father. I've seen those who refused to accept Christ and have seen their faces. They're not with the Father and it's heartbreaking because this is eternity folks this is not a rehearsal.

I want you to know in my heart that for each and every one of us there is a path to Christ! It doesn't matter who you are or what you've done. I know there is a path. All you have to do is see it. The best way to start to seek that path is to pray. Just say, I'm ready. I have sinned. I need to repent.

Don't be surprised at the outcome of accepting Jesus as your Savior. God will send Christians who will talk to you, and pray with you. You will suddenly receive His word with all of your heart. God will send people to you to encourage you to follow those signs find a church.

I'm telling you this from personal experience because the life that you will lead after you accept Him is nothing but glorious, even when the hard times come and they will. God will still be with you and you know that there is glory in the journey and glory in the end!

I love you so much for reading this. It is all for the glory of God and God be with you.

The Miracle Baby: The Story of The Birth of Carla Arianna Lewis

As Karl and I share our testimony of the birth of Carla, we pray that your heart will be encouraged to know that there is hope amid apparent hopelessness and impossibility.

Carla Arianna Lewis was born on Sunday, March 16th, 1997 at 26 weeks of pregnancy, weighing 1 lb 8 oz.

On January 27th, at 19 weeks of pregnancy, I began experiencing complications which led to the premature rupturing of my amniotic membrane (water-sac). The doctors then informed me that, medically, there was nothing that could be done to prevent labor. They also said our baby at 19 weeks had a zero percent chance of survival due to the severe prematurity of her organs.

The present medical experience at that time shows that babies born before 24 weeks of pregnancy have a shallow rate of survival. Although, a baby born at 24 weeks has a 50 percent chance of survival, their mental and physical development is uncertain. My situation at 19 weeks seemed medically impossible and hopeless.

Karl and I were strongly encouraged to terminate the pregnancy. We respectfully thanked the doctors for their medical consultation but informed them that we choose to believe in God and take it one day at a time.

After spending a week in the hospital, I was discharged home and instructed to remain on bed rest. During this week at the hospital, the Lord spoke certain scriptures and songs to my heart. Two scriptures were Luke 1:37 and Acts 12:5. A week after coming home, the Holy Spirit told my heart these words: 'You are either going to believe my word that nothing is impossible or you're not; there is no middle ground. Our faith in God's word was challenged as we faced this situation.

For five weeks, I remained on bed rest at home with weekly visits to the doctor. At 22 weeks, the doctor expressed amazement that Carla continued to grow normally despite no fluid around her. (The amniotic fluid is vital for lung development, protection against infection, etc.) The Lord not only kept Carla but also kept me from infection, bleeding, and labor.



At 25 weeks, I was taken to the hospital with bleeding, but the Lord was still at work. A week later on March 16th, 1997, Carla Arianna Lewis was born. This was seven (7) weeks and two days after the dilating of my cervix, which led to the breakage of my amniotic sac.

Five days after my delivery, I was adischarged home without my baby, these words came into my heart: "You are leaving a baby that is alive, not dead."

Carla remained in the hospital for three and a half months as her body grew and developed. We watched in amazement as God perfected her little body.

Two weeks after her birth, we were given the results of Carla's head ultrasound. It showed a small area of brain death. We were informed that if this area increased, it would mean possible mental and physical disability. We were given the option of removing the ventilation machine and allowing Carla to die should the repeated ultrasound show increased brain death. We continued to believe God's word. This designated area of 'brain damage' began to decrease. Subsequent ultrasounds showed no mal-effects. Today, Carla shows no signs of brain death or damage.

Our strength in facing this situation came because of God's faithfulness to His word. Day and night, we filled and surrounded ourselves with healing scriptures, songs, and our covenant with God's promises from Psalm 138:8 and Psalm 139:13-17, key scriptures that we declared night and day concerning our baby.



We also experienced our natural and spiritual family's genuine love, faith, prayer, and encouragement.

We also appreciate the medical care the doctors and nurses provide at Mount Sinai Hospital in Toronto, Ontario, Canada.

The words of two doctors, who at 19 weeks encouraged the termination of the pregnancy, best describe the results of this experience: "She is a miracle! Go and show her off" and "Miracles still do occur."

Today, Carla Arianna Lewis, at the age of 27, stands as a testimony of God's mighty healing power. She is a Bible school graduate, an elementary and middle school teacher, and has completed two university degrees.

She will live and not die to declare the praises of God to her generation (Psalm 118:17). She is truly a child of destiny and is now telling "Her Story"!

Redeemed by Faith: A Journey from Despair to Spiritual Fulfillment

I was born Sheila Marie Hamilton on December 16, 1958, in Mulberry, Florida to Carol and Eddie Hamilton. Growing up my family faced numerous challenges that shaped our lives. I was the fourth of six children, and by the time I came into the world, our family was already struggling. My father, Eddie, had suffered a terrible accident at work, which left him in a body cast for more than three years. To cope with his bone pain, he was advised to drink beer, which unfortunately led to him becoming an alcoholic by the age of 28. This drastically affected our family life.

My mother, Carol, was a pillar of strength and faith despite the turmoil. She was a beautiful, praying woman who had faith beyond measure. Every day, she prayed for strength and guidance, even as she faced the hardships of living with an alcoholic husband who was often mean and violent when he drank. My father was a working alcoholic, which made things even harder. He would work, then go to the bar, cheat on my mom, and come home to beat her. It was a terrible life for our Mama and her six kids.

Eventually, my mother reached her breaking point. One day, she said, "I can't take this anymore," and she had my dad arrested. This event was a turning point for him. Realizing that he was about to lose everything, he decided to seek help. He went to rehab, a rare and courageous step at the time, and stayed there for six months.

My siblings and I lived with our grandparents in Naples, Florida, during this period. Living with our grandparents, however, turned into one of the most devastating times of our lives. My sister and I became victims of sexual molestation by a close family member, a trauma that continued even after we moved back to Mulberry. Despite these harrowing experiences, God, in His goodness, gave us unique ways to cope. I found solace in singing.



Even though we were poverty-stricken, we had love and our praying Mama, for which we are still thankful for God rest her soul. In 1966, my father finally bacame alcohol-free. Although he stumbled a few times, each time he did, he went back to rehab and got back up. For more than 30 years, my dad remained alcohol-free. He dedicated himself to reading the Bible and the encyclopedia every day because he wanted to be wise and intelligent.

His transformation was nothing short of miraculous. He went on to build a successful shrimping (bait) business that is still operated by two of my brothers. He founded it on the principles of faith and perseverance. The unwavering faith of my mother and the recovery of my father had a profound impact on us children. Three of the six Hamilton siblings, including myself, became ministers, dedicating our lives to spreading God's word.

My journey has been a testament to the power of God's love and grace. Despite the numerous trials I faced, including the pain of my father's alcoholism and the trauma of sexual abuse, what Satan meant for my fall, God set me up for His call. Through the love of God, family, and Godly people, I emerged with a strong, unshakable faith.


