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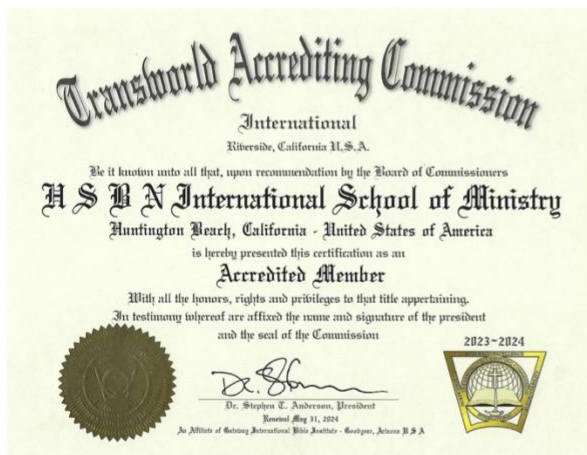

So they thought that if they could use Jesus's name, like the magic expression “ab-ra-ca-da-bra,” they would have the same results as The Apostle Paul.

They believed these exorcisms would become a wealthy source of income because of the demonic individuals throughout that land.

**Satan knows if Christ is dwelling in your life, if you’re being led by The Holy Spirit, walking in the anointing, and if you have credibility with God.** The powers of darkness knows if you have a personal relationship with Christ and have **“Son-ship Rights of Authority.”**

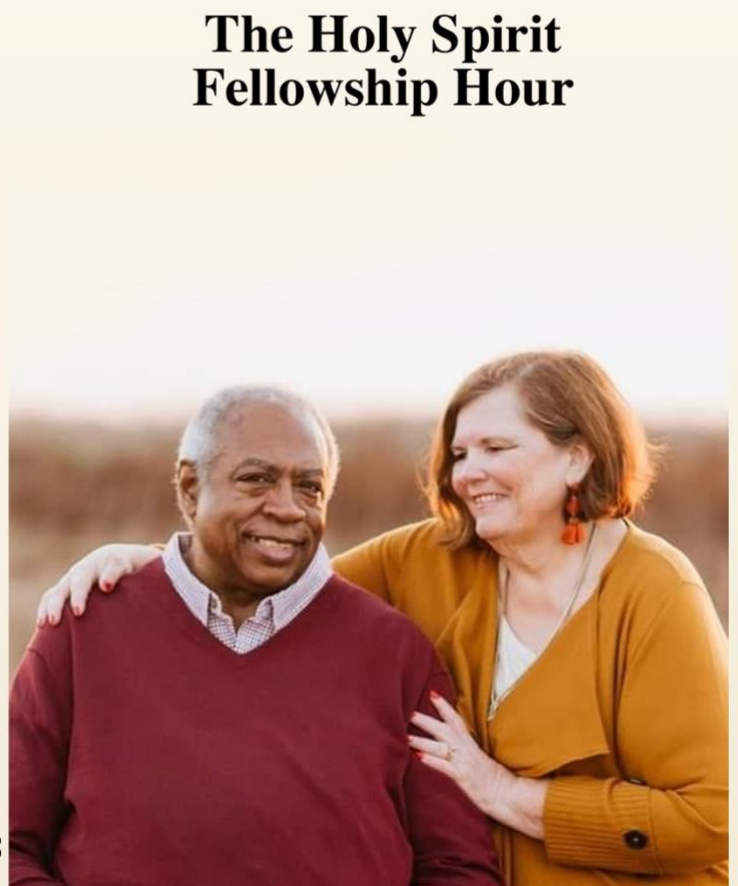

# What Did Jesus Really Say?



**T**oday we are in interesting times because we have more information available to us today than ever before, but we also have more misinformation than we have ever had. People are believing a lot of information that is untrue and is a partial truth. I believe that the words Jesus said are being misquoted and used out of context more today than ever before. Some of this is coming out of churches where pastors teach what they want people to believe and hear, rather than what Jesus actually said. Some people are intentionally twisting the words that Jesus said because they have an agenda and do not want people to know the truth. Let me give some examples of what I am talking about.

Have you ever heard the statement that all ways lead to heaven. I am not sure where this saying came from, but it certainly is not what Jesus said. In the NKJV, Matthew 7:13-14 Jesus said, "Enter by the narrow gate; for wide is the gate and broad is the way that leads to destruction, and there are many who go in by it. Because narrow is the gate and difficult is the way which leads to life, and there are few that find it."

**Jesus' statement is very different than what I hear talking about. Jesus says that the gate is narrow and difficult which leads to life. This means there are a lot of people and a lot of religions that will not get into heaven.**

When Jesus says that there are few who find the way in and most people won't get to heaven.

**2 Peter 3: 9** says, "The Lord is not slack concerning His promise, as some count slackness, but is longsuffering toward us, not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance. God does not want anyone to go to Hell. Hell is meant for Satan and the fallen angels, not for people. God wants everyone to choose to accept Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior. God wants everyone to repent of their sinful actions, but it is each and everyone's personal choice. We cannot choose for anyone but ourselves. God gave each and every person that is born on this Earth free will. The ability to choose to love God and accept His plan for redemption of their lives by accepting His Son, Jesus Christ. You don't have freedom unless you have a choice. If God forced everyone to do it His way, we would be nothing more than AI robots.

Romans 5: 8-10 says, "But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us. Much more then having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath through Him. For if when we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life." Another statement that Jesus made was in Luke 9: 23-25 says, "If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow Me. For whoever desires to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for My sake will save it. For what profit is it to a man if he gains the whole world, and is himself destroyed or lost?" This is a very harsh teaching. This is not seeker friendly. This is saying that you need to do it God's way and not the world's way. Jesus is making a very clear statement that goes against what the people of this Earth want to follow.

People are seeking after everything this world has to offer and they don't care who they hurt, lie to, steal from, or even kill. Jesus is saying that if you don't surrender your will and your ways to Him you are going to face destruction. I am not willing to take the risk with my eternal destination for the temporal things of this world. Everyone is given a choice to choose.

Matthew 6:24 says, "No one can serve two masters; for either he will hate the one and love the other, or else he will be loyal to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and mammon." This means you cannot serve God and the idols gods of this world. We are seeing the gods of this world who are ruling today. Sexual identity and lust have never been so strong. This has been going on since the sixties, and it has accelerated in the last 10 years.

Beauty and stardom are being held to a higher level more than ever before because of social media. The desire for financial wealth has probably never been so great. Slavery has never been as great as it is today with human trafficking and sex trafficking numbers beyond what anyone can even imagine. In Matthew 22: 37-39, "Jesus said to him, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind. This the first and greatest commandment. And the second is like it: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.'"

I don't believe human trafficking, sex trafficking, drug trafficking, murder or any form of violence, financial crimes, and any other crimes or offenses where we are hurting people is a sign of loving our neighbor as ourselves. People are not believing they are going to be held accountable for their actions, but we are all going to stand in front of Jesus when we die and be held accountable for our actions. A good test for your actions is this, God's ways are to love people and use things. Satan's way is to love things and use people. If you are following Satan's ways it is not going to end well for you.

I encourage everyone to read the red letters in the Bible, which simply means to read all the statements that Jesus made. 

# He Can Heal Your Emotional Wounds

I remember the day the Lord told me “I can heal those emotional wounds” but you will need to let me remove those make shift “Band-Aids.” I knew instinctively it was going to be a painful process. I had placed short-term Band-Aids on long standing emotional issues like fear, rejection, abandonment, low self-esteem, self-hatred and intimidation. Being the first born, I felt I was an example to my siblings and though those feelings plagued my life. I repressed and suppressed my negative feelings about myself.

I always felt I was not good enough. I also had a father whose favorite words of encouragement were: “Pull yourself up by your boot straps; You're the captain of your ship; You're the master of your own fate; or You can do whatever you set your mind to do.”

## **I Just Kept It Moving!**

My most successful and rewarding job was my work as a Probation Officer. My income rivaled my husband's income. I was married with two children, we owned our own home. My children were attending private Christian schools. I had all the trappings of an emotionally stable life!

## **Me In An Identity Crises?**

But I was suffering from an Identity Crises! I was absolutely oblivious and I was blind as a bat that I was in crises mode. I had no idea the quote “Identity Thief” had stolen and wrapped my identity! John 10:10 says, “The thief comes only to steal, kill and destroy.” I didn't even believe the devil existed, therefore, I was deceived, hoodwinked, and bamboozled by the enemy of my soul.

## **I Was Held Up!**

I didn't realize that I was fooled into thinking that having this prestigious position at work, my title, my money, my accomplishments, my achievements, my statues and possessions was all I needed! I thought I had a healthy self-image for the better part of my life until I retired from my job of almost 28 years.

## **Remember When You Hated Yourself?**

When I stepped into doing ministry, that still small voice my Helper, Comforter, Instructor, and Guide spoke to me, “Remember when you hated yourself?” “What, why are you telling me this Lord?” At this point, God began to do a deep dive into my heart to yank at my feelings of self-hatred. I didn't like the way I felt, I spoke negative words about myself. I didn't like anything about me.

## **The Holy Spirit Uncovered The Truth!**

I understood God wanted me to unearth the true feelings I had buried in my subconscious about myself. I submitted to his inner healing process, I had never connected the idea that the way my mother treated me is why I developed negative feelings about myself. In the process of allowing the Lord to heal me, God revealed that I had internalized my mother's mistreatment of me. He took me back to my childhood when my mother struggled with anxiety attacks. She didn't embrace me as a child as she would physically abuse me. So she held back her loving physical touch towards me.

She rarely embraced me and she never told me she loved me. Shame followed me because of her mistreatment of me. Her mistreatment of me made me feel rejected, not enough, abandoned and not valued. When I internalized my past wounds, I ended up hating myself! My negative self-talk was related to my abilities, my body image, my worth and my self-esteem. Shame followed my mistreatment.

## **I Related to Hagar!**

In Genesis 16, Sara treats Hagar harshly and she flees into the desert where God speaks to her. Hagar felt she wasn't good enough and she had an identity crises. She was a servant, a slave and enslaved. She belonged to Sara, she was a possession and an object. Hagar was rejected, mistreated, abandoned by the family she belonged to. She was a wounded woman. Hagar didn't recognize her value because of the way she was mistreated.



Her only consolation was while she was running away from her past into the desert God spoke to her, "He said, I can heal those wounds!" She finally realized that she was seen, heard, understood and cared for. The desert encounter changed her, healed her and gave her a new identity. She realized not even her traumatic experiences could label her as a reject or a misfit. I AM seen by God!

### **Stop Running!**

God wanted me to go back and understand why this nine year old girl hated herself. God told me to stop running, you can't spend the rest of your life running from everything that is uncomfortable. If you keep running you'll never discover your Purpose, you will never find out who you are, you'll never understand the treasure that I have placed in you. If you keep on running you will always have low self-esteem. You will never become what I meant for you to be.



### **I am A Child of God!**

When my faulty foundation was crumbling, because I had put my identity in sinking sand, the sand of titles, money, accomplishment, career, job, status and possession. I finally looked to the Lord to give me my identity. My worth and my value is found solely in Christ and I am more than enough! I found God is the only one who can define me. Not my feelings, not the opinion of others, not my adverse circumstances! Only my Father in Heaven can give me an identity! I am a new creation, I am made in his image, complete in Christ, loved, chosen, called and consecrated!

### **Forgiveness Sets You Free!**

God does not take us back in time to past hurts, disappointments, fears & pain to leave us there. He takes us back so we can face our past without blaming those who we see as responsible for our pain and suffering. God wants us to know why we feel the way we do. He wants us to see that we are handling our situation without HIM in our lives. We were suffering and need to have His forgiveness. When you are able to forgive others for their mistreatment, I believe you simultaneously open that locked rusty prison door. The person that emerges from prison is you, the new you, the you that can forgive, can show mercy and compassion. First to others and then to yourself. You no longer carry the weight of abandonment, rejection, fear, self-hatred and unforgiveness.

O, who the Son set-free is free indeed!

# I Am Free - Set Free Indeed

**T**he Bible describes the woman with an issue of blood as someone who suffered for 12 long years. Mark 5:24-34. She spent all her money on medicines to stop the bleeding, but to no avail. Her family and friends ostracized her and made her feel not welcomed any way she went. Her blood issue grew even worse as she became older. The Bible did not indicate what her age was, but she suffered for a long time. Jewish law declared that she was unclean and unfit due to this blood issue. She was not even allowed to go to the temple to worship. But this one day! She had enough! She heard about Jesus! She heard he could heal her. So she pressed through the crowd to find and be near him. The Bible doesn't say how far she had to go, and I am sure she did not care. She was determined to touch Him. She wanted freedom and normalcy no matter what the cost. So she pressed through the crowd, got as close as possible, and felt his garment! At that moment, her faith through her actions healed her.

The other woman in the Bible was the woman at the well. John 4:4-42 She was a Samaritan despised by the Jews. She was an outcast, looked down on by family and friends. She had been with at least five men and was unmarried. She was an outcast. This one morning, she decided to go to the community well to get water. The well was famous because many people gathered at the well, a place to gather and socialize. But this woman went to the well when she knew no one would likely be there. It was the perfect time for her because she met Jesus. Jesus met her at the well. Jesus showed his love for her and that she had a purpose. He forgave her sins. He did not come to condemn; he came to redeem her. It was because of her that many Samaritans came to Jesus.

Then there is me. Growing up, I was the black sheep of the family. I became an unwed mother at 22. I disgraced my family. My parents were upset, 15

and my grandparents did not call, give support, or offer any prayers, and my friends stayed away. You wouldn't know I existed if I didn't come and visit my family now and then. My parents had a large shelf filled with family photos of them: my brother throughout his life, my sister, her husband, and their children. But there was no picture of my children and me anywhere on that shelf or in any other room in the house. If a stranger walked into the house and saw that wall full of pictures of the family, they would not know that I existed and had four children. We were the Neal family's best-kept secret.

So, I stayed away. I allowed my sin to keep me far away from family and childhood friends, and I would rarely visit home. My parents, especially my dad, are okay with that. Every time I saw Dad, he made it a point to remind me that I was an embarrassment to the family. On top of all of this, I struggled because my children's father left and walked out of my life right after I had my twins. They were three months old, and he decided he needed his freedom. He felt that I was holding him back from opportunities. So he left. A few months later, I discovered he had a new girlfriend with a three-month-old baby. I had no idea if the child was his. I didn't ask, and at that point, I didn't care.

I stayed in California with little or no family support. But God didn't forget me. Did I struggle? Yes. Did I feel like a failure? Yes, but God was with me. I had no idea how much until I gave my life to him.





One night, I woke up surrounded by all four children in bed. They did that often. They would come in the middle of the night and crawl in my bed. Can you imagine four children in a queen-sized bed, plus me? This particular night, I had a rough week. Money was scarce. I didn't know how all my bills were going to be paid. I exited my bed and sat in a chair near my children, looking at them. They were my beautiful babies, and I loved them so much. But that night, I had given up. I was tired. I wanted to end it all. What kept me from ending my life was them—my beautiful, innocent babies.

I reminded my Dad of what he saw his mother go through. She was left abandoned and hurt; His mother died when he was only ten years old. He never liked to talk about her, so it was hard to find out what had happened to her. I never knew how she died. My Dad became an orphan. His Dad never stepped up to help or acknowledge him, so he went from family to family until he was a teenager, and his uncle took him in.

I reminded my Dad of his mother. How she had him, how she wasn't married, and how my grandfather left her never to return. I reminded him of the pain she went through, and it hurt him deeply, so much so that he took his anger and frustration out on me.

Those memories flooded my mind a lot, especially when I was hurting or lonely, and I had no one to turn to. So many nights, I would think about giving up. But I knew ending it all would sentence my four children to go through what my Dad went through. I couldn't do that to my children. I knew no one would love them like I did. But this one night, I felt the heaviness of all my burdens becoming too much. I felt alone. It was quiet that night, and I was sitting in my dark room in the middle of the night, staring at my children. As I sat there, this still small voice in my head spoke to me. He said it was going to be okay. He said it was going to be OK. He said don't give up. When I heard that voice, I felt peace. So I kept going.

There were days when I felt like giving up. But that voice, those words kept me going! There were days when I had enough, but I kept me going. God was waiting for me to make that leap. At first, I kept making excuses that I couldn't walk into a church because of my sin, so I had to clean myself up and get my act together. That never happened. I realized that I couldn't be the one to clean myself or get my act together.

Just like the woman who was tired of bleeding, so she fought her way through the crowd to Jesus, I was exhausted, and I was determined to go to church. I was seeking that peace beyond all understanding. I was seeking that eternal love that only Jesus could give. So, I walked into church on that one particular day. I didn't know who was going to be there. I didn't care. I had enough. I walked into that church and immediately saw people I knew. God made sure that I didn't feel like a stranger. I saw people who welcomed me and made me feel at home. I finally found that home. I was set free. Jesus was waiting for me to come to him. He met me where I was. Life was never the same for me.

My friend, where is your faith today? Are you tired? Are you struggling? Are you still trying to get your "act" together? Do you want to be set free? Do you need to touch "his hem"? Well, Jesus has been waiting for you. He invites you in. In Matthew 11:28, "Come to Me, all of you who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest." He is your rest and your peace.

Jesus will meet you where you are. Your creator has been waiting for you. John 3:16 says He died on the cross for you because he loved you. In Psalm 139:14, He created you with love and affection.

Remember, Jesus has freed us from our past, infirmities, doubts, rejections, failures, and fears. The Bible says in John 8:36, Therefore if the Son makes you accessible, you shall be free indeed.

# Jesus Dropped the Charges

**P**salm 120:1 says, "In my distress, I cried to the Lord, and he answered me." This verse describes God's loving grace and how he loves and cares for his children.

In late 2022, I had what can only be described as a supernatural salvation and calling placed on my life by God. This experience came at the absolute lowest time in my life when I was (and still am) facing a prison sentence that would separate me from my daughters. I was in a dark place of desperation and despair when Jesus pulled me out of that pit.

I struggled with alcoholism my entire adult life. Between the ages of 19 and 25, I had gotten arrested four times for driving under the influence and had been in and out of several rehab programs. After completing a year in jail and three years of probation for my 4th OWI arrest, I vowed to myself I would never be in the system again. I got sober, cleaned up my life, and completed my college degree.

Shortly after, I married, and the Lord blessed me with two beautiful baby girls. Raising my daughters became my purpose and life as a stay-at-home mom for six years.

In 2020, during the midst of the Covid, while I was going through a nasty divorce, I regrettably relapsed into my alcoholism and was arrested again for driving under the influence. Due to my previous arrests, despite being ten years late, the sentence I am facing is a minimum of three years in prison.

At the time of my arrest, I was a newly single mother struggling badly with depression and personal trauma.

But nothing brought me to my knees faster than realizing my addiction, and mistakes could leave my children without their mother when they needed me most. I spent roughly a year in intense prayer to God about my situation before I heard him answer me. My prayer was repentance, begging for forgiveness, and his will to be done in the best interest of my beautiful babies.

Although I was raised in the church and was always a believer in Jesus, my faith life at that time was not a priority. My daily walk with God was non-existent. When I was indeed at rock bottom and believed I had no hope left in life, Jesus revealed himself to me and said, "I'm coming back soon." From that moment forward, my seeking of the lord intensified, and my faith journey has been nothing short of supernatural and overwhelming.

After I was born again, the veil between the spiritual realm and the physical world was torn. I started to see and even feel demonic attacks. I sought out deliverance to break the bondage of my addiction as well as generational curses that have long plagued my family line. Casting out demons and breaking Satan's strongholds on our lives was a cornerstone of Jesus' ministry, and I believe it needs to be preached and practiced in today's church. Seeking out and receiving deliverance was the best possible thing I did for my mental health.

Revelation 12:11 says, "They overcame him by the blood of the lamb and by the word of their testimony, and they have not loved their life unto death." Through my salvation, I eagerly answered the lord's call; I gave my life to serving Christ. I knew it would be my life's work now to share the love of Jesus and the freedom



of deliverance, whether I went to prison or not. If I went to prison, I knew I would need spiritual inspiration and guidance to get me through that lonely and mentally challenging time. Seeking a connection to the body of Christ while I was to be incarcerated is what led me divinely to Pastor Debbie, a broadcaster on HSBN. After speaking with her, it was placed on my heart to share my story with others. Regardless of how difficult and shameful sharing my own story has been, I know my truth can encourage others in a hopeless situation to seek Jesus and find the freedom and peace he gives us in our hearts.

After sharing my story on HSBN, I was blessed to meet Apostle Dr Andrew Bills and Ann Marie Bills. I am honored that my story touched them. They have taken me under their wing and support the vision of my ministry, which is to share the testimonies of others who have found God as a source of strength during incarceration.

**"Jesus Dropped the Charges"** is a compelling and uplifting show that features real-life stories of transformation. Each episode invites listeners into the stories of formerly incarcerated inmates who have encountered Jesus while behind bars. These testimonies reveal the profound impact of faith, forgiveness, and second chances.

Former inmates share their personal journeys—from despair to the moment they gave their life to Christ. Listeners will hear about the struggles, regrets, and pivotal moments that led to their salvation and transformation. The show sheds light on the darkness of prison life and the challenges faced by those who have been incarcerated. Yet, it also emphasizes the hope that can be found even in the bleakest circumstances. Each episode highlights how a relationship with Jesus has led to redemption, restoration, and hope for a future. Listeners witness the power of grace to break chains and set captives free.

My vision for this ministry is that it's a beacon of hope to bring more people to Jesus who think they are too guilty for God's forgiveness or too broken for God's healing. I hope sharing stories of salvation from those who have been to rock bottom can show anyone still struggling that if they lean on God, he has the supernatural power to lead them into a life of countless blessings.

As a part of my ministry, I also want to help incarcerated men and women not feel forgotten. I hope also to develop a program of community mentors that can keep the spirits of current inmates high and their minds on their walk with the lord during their difficult time behind bars. Becoming faith mentors can also benefit formerly incarcerated individuals who are reintegrating into society by keeping their faith first and inspiring others.

Regardless of their past, everyone deserves a chance for redemption and a brighter future. Whether you've experienced incarceration, know someone who has, or wants to be inspired by stories of resilience, this show invites you to witness the transformative power of faith. 2 Corinthians 5:17 says, "Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away, behold all things have become new."

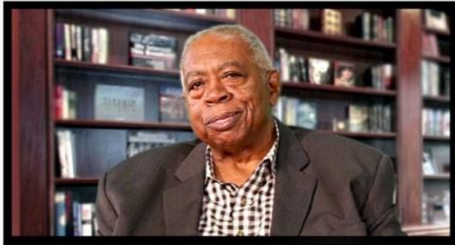
