God never promised that this journey would be easy. I never imagined the journey would be this long and hard. "Boy" was I in for a rude awakening. I ended up a single mother of two boys. I had received God but I wasn't really following Him. My children's father left me for another woman when I was pregnant with my second child. It wasn't easy having a 41/2 -year-old and a newborn baby not to mention I didn't drive. I had to either take a bus or walk with my two boys. The blessing in all of that was I saw the hand of God in my favor. My job at Security Pacific Bank in Yorba Linda, CA was going to be very difficult to get to with my children needing to also be dropped off at daycare. God put some very kind people in my path at my job that would pick me and the kids up and drop them off at daycare and give me a ride to work. I seemed to be putting my life back together and then boom I started having babysitting problems and had to quit my job at the bank.

God has a way of getting your attention through circumstances and situations that are painful. All of this just pushed me even closer to Jesus! God led me to Friendship Baptist Church in Yorba Linda CA. where I started walking in my call and purpose. The boys and I really loved the church. My boys sung in the choir while I started volunteering in the Women's Ministry and in Teaching Sunday School for the preschool class. I was so excited about teaching the preschool children and at the same time I was volunteering at my son's school. I was working for Albertsons, but I had gone through several jobs, and I had gone to many trade schools and just couldn't find my purpose. I began praying and asking God what my purpose on this earth was, he had been speaking through people all along I just wasn't paying attention. One of the big signs I ignored was when I started volunteering in my son's school, they had a plaque made with my name on it and put it up on the wall. I also ignored when they asked me to apply for a job at the school. I said no I am just here to volunteer. They told me how good I was with the children. At the church everybody told me how much their children loved having me for a teacher and how much they were learning.



God literally pushed me into my destiny and purpose. Sometimes God is speaking loud and clear but we are not listening. I volunteered for Pomona Adult School in their preschool program, but part of the requirement was I had to take their Child Development class and then transfer over to the college. God really does have a sense of humor because I never wanted to go to college, I didn't like school or have any dreams or aspirations. So, my journey began and I started loving school and was excited about becoming a teacher. It wasn't easy but I became a teacher's assistant during the day and went to college at night. I wasn't getting child support from my ex, so I braided hair on the weekends and evenings to make ends meet. By the way, God gave me the courage to get my driver's license and He blessed me with a new car. God is faithful even through all the struggle and pain.

God blessed me with the godly man of my dreams who is kind loving and supportive. God called my husband Pastor Deno Price and I to co-pastor Precise Christian Ministries in Upland, Ca in 2015. Ministry has not been easy and it comes with great responsibility because we are on the front-line every single day.

Just when you think the tide is turning around life hits you hard again. Prior to my marriage, I started having problems with my sons due to their financial problems and hardships. My older son was chasing girls and having sex as a teen and started to hang around the wrong crowd and ended up in jail. My youngest son started getting in trouble and he in and out of Juvenile Hall and later he went to prison. It has been a long hard journey with my youngest son. Just when I think my problems are over, my son is released from prison, he is doing well, working and living life as a productive citizen for 4 years. He ends up back in prison. Thank you Lord, my older son learned from his mistakes the first time and never went down that road again.

I was devastated when this happened and didn't think I could overcome this. This time, I didn't have it in me. I couldn't see myself going back and forth again to court or visit him in jail. Our God was so faithful to pick me up comfort me and strengthen me in the storm like he always has.

God has blessed me over the years to advance in my purpose on this earth not because I am qualified or deserving but because of his faithfulness. I was the least likely to succeed. I had low self-esteem, low self-worth and no confidence. God started using my supervisors and my husband to push me into my higher calling that God had for me. They were telling me I was more than a teacher and I needed to be running the school. I never thought I could but I stepped out in faith and went from teacher to Assistant Director to Director. God wasn't finished there, he gave my husband and I the opportunity to own and operate our own daycare facility back in 2008 for 3 years. Look at God's faithfulness to his promise.

I came from a broken home. My mother died in a fire when I was 15, I was raped at 6 years old, and I was a battered and abused girlfriend at the age of 16. I was stabbed 8 times by my youngest son and am still here to talk about it, Gods faithfulness once again. I was always shy and introverted because of the rape and being raised in broken home but look what the Lord has done!

It hasn't been easy but like I said God never promised it would be easy. Every promise he gave me up until this point he has fulfilled! My older son is a great father and role model to his children, and he has superseded in his career financially over and above what his father and I have every done. I know my youngest son will get their too. Remember God makes everything beautiful in his time! God has given me beauty for my scars.

God's Purposes, God's Promises

God gives us His Word... but what do we do when we believe His Word and yet we don't see what He has promised come to pass in our lives?

This is the question I struggled with for years. My story will focus on: God's heart, my journey in finding Him, and His healing. I believed that His Word says that health is one of His gifts to us yet didn't see it in my life. This is where I got to live by faith and not by sight.

I will share some of my testimony so you can understand how much I needed God and His faithfulness. When I was 14 years old, I was diagnosed with Type 1 diabetes. When I was about 25, I was diagnosed with Rheumatoid Arthritis. Then in 2012, I was diagnosed with Lupus. All of these are auto-immune diseases. How did I get them?

I don't know, but I did all the spiritual work that I knew to do. I broke generational curses. I had Sozos and went through all the steps of the Sozo ministry-which means to be saved, healed, and delivered. I did all the internal work to make sure I didn't have unconfessed sins or unforgiveness in my life. I memorized scripture and kept God's word in my heart. I sought Him. I broke off any agreements I had made with the lies of the enemy. I got prayer from anointed people. There were times that all I could do was cry out and pray in the Spirit.

I was in incredible pain; mostly my joints and my skin were affected (as you can see in the pictures. I kept getting flare-ups and began taking medication to lessen them. It felt like my body was unraveling. This is when they found out that I had Lupus and they started me on 6 months of Chemo to stop my over-active immune system from attacking my body. 11

Who was God to me in the midst of this? This was the question I had to settle in my heart. I was doing everything I knew to do but I did not receive the healing I believed Him for, So, I locked into the character of God and guarded myself against satan because he wanted to discourage me and make me doubt the truth of God's goodness.

God's Word became life to me in this process. It sustained me.

> "But now, thus says the LORD, who created you, O Jacob, And He who formed you, O Israel: "Fear not, for I have redeemed you; I have called you by your name; You are Mine." Isaiah 43:1

Over and over, I would declare God:

- · You created me.
- · You formed me.
- · You have called me to be courageous, and not afraid.
- · You have redeemed me.
- · You call me by my name.
- · I am yours and you have me!

The truth of this one verse has kept me through many difficult times. And the next few verses tell us how He is with us in it all.

Continuing in my journey: After I did my first set of Chemotherapy in 2013 (which was for 6 months), the Lupus went into remission. Yay! I believed this was for life. But I started getting very painful symptoms again. So in 2019, I started another round of Chemo believing it would put me back into remission. But this time I got too strong of a dose, and the medication damaged the function of my kidneys.

The doctor's tried many things to get them to start working again. But nothing worked, and in 2020 I started dialysis. I went 3 days a week for 4 hours a session. This was a very difficult schedule, but if I wanted to live, I had to do it. Whatever situation any of us are in, God calls each of us to choose life! For me, going to dialysis was choosing life.

God is life. Living in His presence is life! He became my perspective and the one I loved. I worshiped Him and continued to pray for a miracle as I went to dialysis... for years.

I took many tests to get on the wait list for a kidney and pancreas transplant—which takes years from the time one starts dialysis. Then a miracle happened! I got a call from Loma Linda, 12 days after I had gotten approved. I had a donor for a new kidney and pancreas.

It was a 7-hour surgery and has been an intensive recovery. I am still adjusting to the anti-rejection mediation that I have to take on a schedule for the rest of my life. But I believe God for all that He has promised, and for Him to have His perfect way.

Regardless of what you're going through, God is in your midst of it all. He is with you in it all. His presence will bring joy to you—regardless of how you feel. His joy is fruit that you are to feed on and live by. As you do, it will nourish and strengthen you.

Know that God does test His people just as satan, our enemy, attacks us. Let's look at the difference between God's test and satan's attack. God always has good for you. You have been blessed, predestined, forgiven, adopted, chosen, and accepted as His beloved (Eph. 1:3-6). All of God's testing is for your good. He wants to train, mature, and prove you.

Satan, on the other hand, will tempt you to doubt God and His promises. He wants to steal, kill, and destroy your heart, destiny, faith and trust in God. He will lure you with temptation as he wants you to fall, and become confused, addicted, and feel stuck.

So, I bless you as you travel through your own journey in life, and come to know God more closely and deeply. He loves you beyond words and is so near to you at all times—especially when things are hard.



"I will sing to the LORD as long as I live; I will sing praise to my God while I have my being. May my meditation be sweet to Him; I will be glad in the LORD."

Psalm 104:33-34 (NKJV)

From the earliest memories of childhood, singing has always taken me to a happy place. Of course, growing up in church back in the day, my mother would put me in the little kid's choir, called the "Sunshine Band", and not knowing the songs, I would immensely enjoy the sound of music by clapping my hands and swerving to the beat. The songs were dear to me then, and as I became older, the songs became dearer to my heart, and a relationship with God evolved that I would never, ever forget.

Growing up in the 1960's normalcy for me was hearing about civil rights, and seeing the familiar figures of Martin Luther King, and John F. Kennedy take a righteous stand for equality. But, what moved me mostly, as they stood up for the rights of the people, was the singing that went along with the justice.

And so it was, as I continued my adulthood, I would wake up in the morning with songs of music in my ear. In the good days--I heard music; and in particularly in the bad days, I would still hear God singing over me. Did you know that God sings over you as well? Yes, God rejoices over you with singing, according to Zephaniah 3:17

Zephaniah 3:17 (NKJV)

The LORD your God in your midst, The Mighty One, will save; He will rejoice over you with gladness, He will quiet you with His love, He will rejoice over you with singing. Isn't it remarkable of what songs can do? In fact, King David found the secret to an intimate relationship with God when he wrote Psalms 104.

You may say to yourself, "That was King David's situation; maybe God deals with him that way, but not with me!" Well, I beg to differ. Why?



Because if you really ask God for the songs He's singing over you, He will answer you with a song that might come on the radio, or a song you might hear at church, or a song might strike up in a conversation. Whatever the case may be, my dear friend, keep a melody in your heart.

We're living in critical times right now; people are depressed and upset; living in fear, defeat, and frustration; not knowing what to do. But I tell you what--life need not be that way when you have God on your side.

GOD RULES IN THE MIDST OF SINGING

Yes, God dwells in the praises (singing) of His people! I remember the time when I was laid off work, recently divorced, with two girls in high school, and there was no money coming in the household. What did I do? In the midst of tears, God spoke to my heart and said in a still, small voice, "Annette, I see your tears, but I respond to faith". So I dried my tears, and began to read the word of God about faith, and was led to this Scripture:

Psalm 22:3-5 (NKJV)

- 1) But You are holy, enthroned in the praises of Israel.
- Our fathers trusted in You; they trusted, and You delivered them.
- 3) They trusted in You, and were not ashamed.

Through study, I realized that the word "enthroned" means to "rule" and "reign", and the word "praises" is the Hebrew word, "T'hillah", which means to praise with "singing". And the revelation became real to me that God rules and reigns in the midst of singing! Hallelujah!

I was motivated to sing unto the LORD! And as I sang and told the Lord that I trusted Him and thanked Him for delivering me and that I would not be made ashamed but be a testimony of His provision! Not too long afterwards I began to get calls for work and unemployment was history! Yes, God made a way for me and I was full of joy!

I was certainly happy that I was working, but because it was a while, I needed to catch up on some expenses. As a result, I was summoned to court, and asked God what to do. Well, the Lord instructed me to keep tithing, and to proceed to courthouse.

On the day of court, (without any legal representation), God instructed me to park a little further from the courtroom, so I got out of the car and said, "Now what?" And the Lord said to me: "Start singing." As I began to sing praises unto the Lord, I began to gain strength, and God let me know that He was ruling and reigning in my situation and you guessed it, victory was won!

God can do the same for you, my friends. Are you in a season of lack right now? I want you to know that God has not forsaken you and the same way He provided victory and provision for me, He will do the same thing for you!

A CONTINUAL SONG OF PRAISE!

Psalm 34:1 (NKJV)

A SONG OF DELIVERANCE

2 Samuel 22:1-4

Have you had any enemies lately? Maybe someone who hates you or who is jealous of you? I know it's hard not to fight back but I'd like you to first start fighting from a spiritual aspect and get God involved. Once again, King David realized that the LORD delivered him from his enemies:

2 Samuel 22:1-4 (NKJV)

1) Then David spoke to the LORD the words of this song, on the day when the LORD had delivered him from the hand of all his enemies, and from the hand of Saul. 2) And he said: "The LORD is my rock and my fortress and my deliverer; 3) The God of my strength, in whom I will trust; My shield and the horn of my salvation, My stronghold and my refuge; My Savior, You save me from violence. 4) I will call upon the LORD, who is worthy to be praised; So shall I be saved from my enemies.

David was singing to God because the LORD delivered him from "all" his enemies! Wow! Then David gives us a list of accolades (praises) to the LORD: The Lord is my: Rock, fortress, deliverer, strength, shield, and what a perfect way to praise God!
