n the fall of 1996, I experienced a great love encounter with Jesus Christ. It wasn't long after this my whole life would go through a drastic change. I was completely set free from addiction and depression. I began to adjust my days to be about living for and serving the Lord. Church attendance, Bible Studies, and Ministry became my new normal. I loved it! I had found something worth living for and purpose was being awakened inside my heart. I was radically on fire for God and everyone I came in contact with knew it!

However, there have been times when my passion would start to fade and my love for God would begin to cool off. This would usually happen when a prayer I had been contending for would go unanswered or a trial in my life would last too long. Some examples include: My parents marriage that I was trusting God to restore sadly ended in divorce. The family member I was praying for and trusting God to save and heal didn't happen and even ended up in a worse state than before. Some people I had loved, trusted, and served in ministry with with for many years had hurt me deeply. During these times I heel disappointed, would frustrated, angry, and at times rejected. At these times, it would feel as though a wet blanket would be thrown on my excitement for God.

Have you ever experienced anything like this? I believe many have! Our hearts could start to get cold and even bitter towards God, His church, and if not dealt with we start to shipwreck our own faith. Others times we try to continue to live for God because we know it's right. We look and even find a place and people that can offer us comfort and safety. However, any small trigger of past situations can quickly put a wet blanket on us and send us running. We can be tempted to eventually give up while carefully placing walls of self-protection around ourselves. This can become a rut or pattern we just can't seem to break out of.

However, the word of God offers us hope in these situations.

John 16:33 I have told you these things, so that in me you may have peace. In this world you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the world."

God's plan isn't for us to live in a disheartened state. Jesus warned his disciples that they will have troubles in this world but to **'Take Heart'** because He is the answer to these troubles.

I had experienced this very early in my walk with God. I had the opportunity to journey across Canada as a young woman. I was certain God had sent me to evangelize the small province of Prince Edward Island. I went by faith with a friend of mine who originated from there and we were planning to stay there for about two months. We booked our flights with no extra money to show of. We were certain God would take care of us. I quickly became employed at a beautiful seasonal resort near the ocean known to have filmed TV shows and even hosted royalty. I was able to live in the staff quarters and I had weekends off for touring around the province and visiting churches. It was perfect...well, almost!

I quickly found out the staff I was living with was really a chapter out of my life before I knew God. There was plenty of alcohol, drugs, and party scene all around me. I couldn't escape it! How was I going to evangelize in this situation? Was coming here a mistake? Would I somehow get tempted and go back to a life of addiction? Disappointment and frustration quickly set in. Then I remembered Jesus' words, **'Take Heart...I have overcome the world!'** This sparked a glimmer of hope inside my heart.

Most days while working at the resort, I worked a split morning and evening shift. This meant I had every afternoon free. Looking to escape my living quarters, I would take my Bible and walk over to a small pond with a bridge nearby. It was a quiet place with no one around. For about two hours, I would walk and pray and read my Bible. I would pray for many things including God's presence to keep me and protect me, salvation of people on the island. for encounters and miracles to take place and so on. I would pray in the Spirit and pray with my understanding (1 Corinthians 14:15). At times, I would just practice exalting and worshipping God. Unbeknownst to me, I was learning how to get in the "secret place" with God.

Matt 6:6 (NIV) But when you pray, go into your room, close the door and pray to your Father, who is unseen. Then your Father, who sees what is done in secret, will reward you.

This afternoon getaway was actually teaching me how to find this 'Secret Place'. As I drew close to the Father, disappointment and frustration started to disappear. God's presence felt strong in my life. An inner resolve rose up to passionately pursue God and His plans and purposes for me that summer. I was drawing close to God and he was drawing close to me (James 4:8). I love the way the Message Bible translates this verse;

Matt.6:6 (MSG) "Here's what I want you to do: Find a quiet, secluded place so you won't be tempted to role-play before God. Just be there as simply and honestly as you can manage. The focus will shift from you to God, and you will begin to sense his grace."

When we discipline our lives to get away from the noise and distractions of the world just to be with God...He will heal our hurts and disappointments. He will also re-ignite our passion and purpose that brings joy and adventure in our lives. God's Word promises...**He will reward us** when we come into this secret place.

Back to my story...what was my reward? On a personal level, my passion and purpose was restored. I was not tempted at all to go back to the things God had previously set me free from. Once again, I was excited to talk to anyone who would listen about God. I quickly discovered and started learning about hearing the voice of God and even how to prophesy. I received several unexpected monetary blessings. Several young adults who had either never known God or had walked away from him years' prior, came into relationship with Jesus Christ and the church as a direct result of us reaching out to them. We saw people healed and encounter God's presence for the first time. What a summer of adventure!

This set a foundation for my whole life. Trials and troubles have come in my life just as I'm sure it has for many of you. I have made it a part of my life to remember to always go back and dwell in the secret place. As you saw in my story, the secret place not only helped me on a personal level.But, it also was a part of the story of the lives we touched and helped restore back to God.

Throughout Psalm 91, David the psalmist is actually explaining and reminding himself about God's loving protection and His saving and delivering power. However, if we are to receive this we must remember how important it is to 'dwell in secret place of the Most High God'. The word 'dwell' in Hebrew actually means to sit, to remain, to dwell or live in.

Psalm 9:1-2 (NKJV) He who dwells in the secret place of the Most High will rest in the shadow of the Almighty.I will say of the Lord, "He is my refuge and my fortress, my God, in whom I trust."

To sum it up, as we spend time in the secret place of God's presence the following happens:

1. We will become more aware of God's active and loving presence in our lives.

2. Negative emotions such as: frustration, disappointment, discouragement, and even hurts will start to be washed away.

3. Hope and purpose will be ignited and/or restored in our hearts.

4. We will be empowered to help others encounter the goodness of God.

5. God will reward us and fill us with a renewed sense of joy and adventure.

I believe God is looking for people who desire to spend time in His presence and really just love on Him. lames 4:8 encourages' us as we come near to God, He promises to come near to us. Let's not allow our love for God to grow cold due to temporary circumstances in our lives. Scripture warns us that this will happen. (Matt. 24: 12-13, Rev.2:4) However, as we purposefully take the time to shift our focus off ourselves and onto God, it sets us up for a life full of great adventures with God. What an amazing secret!

Do you realize that for the most part, you are the result of every 'yes' or 'no; you have said throughout your life? It's true! It's time to start living your life God's Way – in Good Health. What exactly does that mean? It means that God gave us specific directions on how to live long and healthy lives.

In Genesis 1:27 we read: "So God created man in his own image" But then man came along and invented pesticides and chemicals to make His perfect food last longer and grow bigger, then man super-sized our portions and we became bigger!

It has been my absolute passion to find ways to help people find information that will help bring people back to the way God intended them to be and live. I have seen and experienced too much loss due to illness. I have prayed to be led by the Holy Spirit to find ways to help change the course of ill-health and disease in people.

As we read in Colossians 3:10, I pray that you will join me and 'put on the new self' which is being renewed in knowledge in the image of its Creator.

In each issue of 'Global Fire', I will offer health tips, encouragement and recipes to help you. You don't know what healthy is until you truly ARE!

So, let's get started! Here is one of my favorite family recipes – Lasagna! It's really healthy & delicious. I call it "'Less on Ya' Lasagna." It's much lower in calories but really tasty. Your family will love it, and it is gluten-free!



"'Less on Ya' Lasagna"

Prep Time: 40 minutes

Cooking Time: 1 - 2 hours (depending on squash cooking method)

Oven Temp: 375 degrees

Serves: 6 to 8

Ingredients:

1 - 2 zucchini squash, sliced thin, lengthwise (you will need just enough to cover the bottom of the dish, with a bit of overlapping. If you have zucchini left over, it makes a great snack). I like using a mandolin slicer for even slices.

1 large spaghetti squash, cooked, pull the flesh into strings with a fork.

2 cups fresh spinach

Marinara Sauce (recipe to follow)

Ricotta Cheese Filling (recipe below)

4 cups shredded mozzarella cheese - you can purchase the mozzarella in a ball and shred it yourself, or buy the package of shredded cheese.*

9 X 11-inch baking dish

*Warning for gluten free dieters. Some manufactures add gluten to shredded cheese to keep the cheese from clumping.

Directions for Cooking the Squash: To BAKE the squash, preheat oven to 375 degrees. Wash squash and prick skin with fork on all sides. Place in a baking pan and bake until fork-tender, which is about 1 hour depending on size of squash. Let it cool and then cut in half.

After baking, cut squash in half, remove seeds. Using tines of a fork – drag fork down each half of the baked or boiled squash. Voila! You have created "spaghetti"! Place spaghetti on a platter, blot with paper towels to absorb extra water. There will be approximately 3 cups of spaghetti. You can also clean and dry out the seeds, sprinkle with some sea salt and toast – yummy! The seeds are great on a salad or eaten as a snack. **Marinara Sauce:** Prepare this sauce while the squash is cooking.

Ingredients:

- 2 onions, chopped
- 2 garlic cloves, diced
- 2 tablespoons balsamic vinegar
- 2 tablespoons Madhava® coconut sugar
- 1 tablespoon dried oregano
- 1 tablespoon of basil
- 2 28 oz. cans crushed tomatoes
- 1 small can tomato paste

Salt to taste

Lemon pepper to taste

Preparation:

Sauté onions & garlic in olive oil until translucent

Add tomato paste and crushed tomatoes

Add vinegar, sugar & seasonings. Sugar cuts down on the acidity of the sauce

Let simmer while you are preparing your Ricotta Cheese Filling



Ricotta Cheese Filling

Ingredients:

2 cups ricotta cheese There are dairy-free cheese alternatives like pine nut ricotta – check with your local natural foods market

- 1 teaspoon coarse garlic powder
- 1 teaspoon coarse onion powder
- 1/2 teaspoon lemon pepper
- 1/2 teaspoon salt

Preparation: Mix ricotta cheese, garlic, & onion powder together along with the lemon pepper and salt.)

Putting it all together:

Divide the Marinara Sauce into fourths, the mozzarella cheese into thirds and the Ricotta Cheese Filling in half.



Use a 9 X 11- inch baking dish and spread 1/4 of the Marinara Sauce on the bottom of the pan.

Layer the zucchini, sides touching, until the sauce on the bottom of dish until it is covered.

Evenly spoon 1/2 of the Ricotta Cheese Filling over the zucchini layer. Next, spoon 1/4 of the Marinara Sauce over the Ricotta Cheese Filling and layer with 1/3 of the mozzarella cheese.Layer the spaghetti squash over the mozzarella cheese, repeat with the remaining Ricotta Cheese Filling. Top with a 1/4 of the Marinara Sauce and layer with a 1/3 of the mozzarella cheese.

Layer spinach over the mozzarella cheese and top with the remaining Marinara Sauce. Make the final layer with the rest of the mozzarella cheese.

Bake uncovered at 375 degrees for about 30 minutes or until cheese is golden brown.



Packing at the Pulpit: This Man of God May Arm Himself to Protect His Flock

As a law enforcement officer, I can and do carry a gun almost anywhere, but I never take it to my other workplace – a church. Besides being a state constable, I'm also a church rector and an Anglican bishop. I am, however, rethinking that personal gun ban for the greater good.

My reconsideration began while I was trying to enjoy my post-church nap. I was awoken by multiple chirps from my phone. People were texting me about another church shooting. Some craven individual – for motives still not entirely known – opened fire in a scared space in Sutherland Springs, Texas – killing dozens and injuring more.

It's shocking that, in a nation founded on the idea of religious freedom, there are monsters out there who now think it's fair game to target people of faith with deadly force. I'm no stranger to religious bigotry and the condescension of non-believers, but recent church shootings like those in Charleston, South Carolina; Antioch, Tennessee and this latest one in Sutherland Springs bring intolerance to a frightening new level.

When I previously assessed my duties as a law enforcement officer, priest and bishop, I decided not to carry my pistol with me when participating in Sunday services. I made this choice at my own personal peril because I have recently received credible personal threats and routinely come across people I've arrested.

This is also despite the fact that, in my capacity as an officer, I have provided protection at synagogues and churches concerned about the safety of their congregations. But, until now, I didn't think it was appropriate for me and my church.

I've always seen my job as a bishop as that of an overseer. That's why a bishop carries an ornate staff called a crozier. Like a shepherd, it's his duty to collect the flock and guide it clear of the wolves.

From the founding of my parish, St. Alban's, in the mid-1970s, we usually left our doors unlocked. That changed about five years ago. The sad fact is that people are more willing to ignore, defile, and deface sacred spaces these days. The lines that no one would dare cross before now largely go unacknowledged.

Maybe the crozier is no longer enough.

At Sutherland Springs, there were good guys with guns. Residents near the First Baptist



Church heard the shooting, grabbed their guns and came to the defense of the congregation. This effort undoubtedly saved innocent lives. Similarly, in Antioch, an usher confronted the assailant and tried to wrestle the gun away.

While liberal politicians and activists immediately took to social media to call for more restrictions on guns, it's obvious they fail to understand how a gun can also serve as a tool of salvation.

A pistol in the pulpit may sound extreme, but – when people of faith increasingly appear to be targets of armed evil – a good shepherd must do what he must do to protect the flock from the wolves. From my perspective as both a bishop and a cop, people must be protected. This includes in sacred spaces.In the coming days, I'll be speaking with the members of my parish and examining our approach to future safety and security.

Four Slippery Steps To Adultery

At work and church, in our neighborhoods and during our daily activities we all encounter people of the opposite sex who are attractive. That's not the problem. Our selfish choices after the attraction create the problem. Adultery has a progression and most people (even Christians) take these steps before they slide down the slippery slope.

I know, because I chose this dark path when I left my husband for a coworker named Jake. I know the lies I told myself, the selfish decisions that broke my husband's heart and the sins I committed. I also know the healing and restoration that took place when I confessed, broke off the affair, and found

forgiveness from my husband and God. Although I have healed, there are scars that remain, even 37 years later, so I pray you will learn from my mistakes as you consider these progressive elements of adultery.

An Unguarded Mind


This is the "What if....." stage where your thoughts begin to grow unchecked. You may ask yourself questions like "I wonder if he thinks I'm attractive?" or think "I hope she sits near me during the meeting."

Perhaps you try to manipulate your schedule or activities to create more opportunities for contact.

Nothing inappropriate has happened yet, but you think about the possibilities. If you allow this to continue, your emotions will grow, the fantasies will take root, and you'll think about the other person in romantic or sexual situations. **Solution**: If an inappropriate thought pops into your head, do NOT allow it to linger. Quickly remove yourself from any tempting situations. Follow the advice in Proverbs 7: 25 "Don't let your desires get out of hand: don't let yourself think about her." Look up Philippians 4:8 and learn how God want us to think.

An Unguarded Heart

This is the stage where your emotions run wild and you begin to lie to yourself. (In my case, I told myself "I deserve to be happy.") You may start to build emotional bonds with the other person by creating excuses to spend time



together. You may try to increase the positive contact and do things to please him or her. Example: If he mentions that he likes red: you may be tempted to wear a red dress or if she talks about a favorite flower, you may want to bring her one.

Solution: Ask the Lord to help you get control of your emotions and to give you a clean heart, which seeks after Him. "Draw near to God and He will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners; and purify your hearts, you double-minded."(James 4: 8)

Consider the negative consequences if this flirtation continues: your spouse's pain, loss of respect from

children, friends, and relatives, and financial losses. You may need to confess your temptation to your spouse or a trusted friend who will hold you accountable because dark secrets have less power when you bring them into the light.

An Unguarded Mouth

This step includes verbal flirtations and taking the relationship beyond theory into reality. Perhaps you begin by offering or responding to personal compliments such as, "You are the perfect match for me" or "When I'm with you, the rest of my life fades away."

Knowing that compliments are like magnets, you begin to form an attraction and create a verbal intimacy that includes whispers, code words, pet names, and intimate secrets. This can also include flirtatious or sensual/sexual email conversations and texts.

The next verbal step is to talk about the "what if's." For example, "If I weren't married, you'd be my soul mate." "I wish I'd met you before I got married." Jake and I used to imagine our future together: "If we could run away together, where would we go?"

Then the negative words about your current mate begin:

- "My husband treats me like a maid and never compliments me."
- "My wife just treats me like a paycheck and I'm not attracted to her anymore."
- "My wife/husband and I are just roommates and if it weren't for the kids, I'd have left years ago."

Solution: Focus on the good things in your marriage and try to compliment your mate at least once a day. Be aware that any emails or texts you send are not truly private. If you would be ashamed to have your pastor or mother read it, don't type it. "Let no corrupt word proceed out of your mouth." (or keyboard) (Eph 4:29)

<u>An Unguarded Body</u>

This is the step where emotional adultery becomes physical. Some people think that only intercourse defines adultery, but I strongly disagree. If you have intimate, sensual contact, with someone other than your spouse, it is a breach of your marriage vows. Ask yourself, "if my actions were photographed, would they condemn me?" I know how exciting the forbidden kiss is and how electrifying the stolen, passionate caress is but also know how costly they are because I almost lost everything, including my marriage. I walked away from my relationship with Christ as I chose to follow my selfish heart into sin. But I, like the prodigal son, came to my senses as I ran back to the Lord and He welcomed me home.

Then I begged my husband's forgiveness, broke off all contact with Jake, and rebuilt my marriage. Ron and I now help couples see that no marriage is beyond God's ability to heal. Solution: If you've already crossed the line, stop all contact with the other person, confess your sin, ask for God's forgiveness, and follow the instruction in Romans 12:1 "Present your bodies as a living sacrifice to God." Then read and comply with 2 Corinthians 7:1 "Since we have these promises, dear friends, let us ourselves purify from everything that contaminates body and spirit, perfecting holiness out of reverence for God".

PRAYER: Oh Lord, purify my mind, my heart, my mouth, and my body. I want to be a clean vessel, always ready for your use, available to serve your purposes. Deliver me from evil as I flee temptation and run to the shelter of your outstretched arms. I want to be holy and set apart for you Lord. Help me to stand strong and bring honor to you and my family. Through the power of Jesus' name, I ask these things, Amen.



I would like to share a little about myself and how God got me started on my way in the Ministry. First, my dreams were to be an actor. I began

God had me start an English and a Spanish Bible Study in 2003, while in San Bernardino County Jail. In 2004, God had me start another Bible Study on Terminal Island. In 2005, I became an associate Pastor at Star Light MBC in Santa Ana, California. In 2009, I got ordained to become the Pastor of <u>Greater Light Family Church</u>, located in Santa Ana, California, about a mile from Starlight MBC.

In 2012, while attending a Supernatural Conference Lead by Guillermo Maldonado, at the City of Refuge, Bishop Noel Jones Church. Elder Hood an Evangelist in Orange County, had a dream from God, and God told him to bring me on board on his media ministry, and in the same week, Apostle Maldonado prophesied, that God is giving me a media ministry, which was started two days before that prophesy. We began recording, "Dream Big and Make it Happen Ministries," in the summer of 2012 at Zion Media Ministry located in Downey, California. We did 25 recordings, and could no longer afford it.

So we had a divine connection, and now we can record and air, "Dream Big and Make it Happen Ministries," twice a month, Praise God!!! So we are building locally and going globally.

"Hey, Mom, we're going to play basketball – you're going to be on my team," Scott informed me one sunny afternoon. Having been a basketball player in college and still loving the sport, I jumped at the chance to play; no matter my son was a teenager and I was in my fifties. The other boys engaged fully, with no reservations. The game went on for an hour or so, then broke up.



Afterward, Scott raced into the garage and picked up his skateboard. "Be back after a while, Mom – the guys are going down to the skate park," he shouted as he rolled down the street to join the others.

Standing in the driveway, I relished the fact my son was so active and athletic, enjoying the many activities I did, and was very good at them. He certainly was all boy – the boy I had prayed for and the boy that God had graciously given me. Due to a knee injury, my husband, Gary, wasn't able to do many of the things I enjoyed. Therefore, Scott and I engaged in such things as playing football, snowboarding, tennis, bike riding, and hiking. During those times together, my heart would sing with joy. That joy was shattered later, however, as he entered his latter teen years.

I had put off having children later than most women. But, then again, I wasn't like most women. Gary was a weightlifter when we got married in 1971. I immediately became interested in the sport as I had always been intrigued with strength. Weightlifting wasn't something women got into in the seventies, however. That didn't stop me from engaging in something I found fascinating. I started competing with Gary as my coach. Starting weightlifting for women became my focus.

We decided to put off starting a family until I was finished competing and I knew the sport was on the road to Olympic inclusion. By 1989, I had accomplished much of what I wanted in the way of my own achievements in the sport. I had won several national championships and had gotten the sport recognized on the international scene. That's when my only son came into my life. He truly was the light of my life from the first time I saw him on September 8, 1989.

When he was about eleven, he asked me a question that I didn't think all that unusual at the time. "Mom, did you ever think you should have been a boy?" he asked one night during our 'before bedtime' talks."Well, many times I thought it would have been better if I had been a boy but I knew God created me a girl so that settled it for me," I answered with a little chuckle.

At that time, I thought it was a simple matter of him starting to question his own identity as most preteens do about that age. Of course, knowing my background in weightlifting and doing the things we did together, I didn't question his motive. He was probably wondering where I was coming from in respect to my inclination to many "non-girl" activities.

He didn't ask anything further about it. I thought it was just that, a natural pondering of life and where he fit into the scheme of things.

A couple of years roll by and he is now into his teen years. Passing by his room one afternoon I noticed him silently lying on his bed, very contemplative. I stopped and peered in.


What's up? Do you want to talk about it?" I posed nonchalantly. "You don't want to know," he matter-of-factly. stated. head down with arms crossed. "Well, give me a try," I said as I stepped into the room and sat down on the bed. Lifting his head and looking me in the eye, he clearly said, "Mom, I know I should have been a girl. I'm tired of living a lie and I'm going to transition into being what I know I should have been."

"How long have you felt this way?" I queried, trying to get a handle on what I just heard. I couldn't process exactly what was going on. Surely, "this is just a passing phase and once we talk it out it will all be O.K. "I've known for quite a while – just didn't tell you and Dad because I knew you'd get all weirded out. But I can't

go on pretending." He was visibly distraught as he continued to stare at me without flinching. Now I knew this was serious. My heart started racing as the questions swirled in my head.

Transgenderism wasn't something on my radar. I knew next to nothing about it. What is it? – a mental illness? A mental disorder? Is it hereditary? Did I cause this? Is it caused by a traumatic experience? Where is this coming from? Did we, as parents, cause this? He's a Christian, he knows God created him a boy! He always has been a boy. He acted like a boy, he thought like a boy; there was no indication of anything otherwise.

As I delved into this situation more seriously, I began to get some answers. First of all, this is a decision that the individual makes on their own. It is all psychological, not physiological. It is not hereditary. It may be caused by some traumatic experience but not always. I do not believe this to be the case with Scott. He was vastly influenced by the Internet, his peers, and even the school. He obviously had done his homework in this area as he



had all the facts when I would approach him with questions regarding this. His mind was fast tracking now as to how he could get his reassignment surgery. Meanwhile, my confusion and frustration were raging as the family conflicts began. My once happy home was being torn apart.

After he graduated from high school he started working to get the necessary funding for the surgery. Since he knew we were not going to help him in any way, he needed to get the money on his own. He started working at a local restaurant. He scheduled his surgery to take place in Thailand. Then the floor dropped out from under him.

He lost his job, thereby losing his opportunity for the scheduled surgery. On June 5, 2009, three months shy of his twentieth birthday, we read part of his note he left beside his body."Since I can't live my life as a woman, I

won't live it at all." God allowed my son to come home to be with Him. But my life continued. More doubts, more confusion, and now the overwhelming guilt that I may have contributed to this outcome. I questioned God as to why He would take the only son He had given me. As I tearfully approached my Heavenly Father in the ensuing weeks, He began to impress on me the word **trust**. Could I fully trust in His divine will even in this? Could I trust **all** His promises? Slowly, He transitioned me through the guilt, the frustration, and even the anger to finding unexpected joy.

The next year was Israel's 60th Birthday and, again, we had a packed event in the Great Hall at Government under Stormont Christian Initiative. Jim was an MLA [Member of the Local Assembly at Stormont] when we Co-Founded SCI and within three years, he was Elected to be an MP at Westminster UK Parliament.

At the end of 2015, my good friend Sally Klein O'Connor from California, who is a broadcaster for HSBN, skyped me to say that Bishop Andrew Bills from the Holy Spirit Broadcasting Network would be contacting me. Bishop Andy asked me to be a broadcaster on HSBN. My agreeing to this was an almighty step of faith as I had been diagnosed in 2006 with MS and it had gradually gotten worse to the stage where I could not hold a pen or cup of tea. But, I moved in faith and accepted God's plan and I started broadcasting in 2016, which then led to Bishop Andrew asking me to be the UK & Ireland Branch Director. Although still in a wheelchair, in faith according to Hebrews 11:1, I am completely healed.

I am off all medication and have no pain or spasms. God always fulfills his promises. In September 2017, from Stormont, we had a fabulous anointed Event to Launch the HSBN UK & Ireland Branch. Then, in October we had our first studio broadcast with a family of believers who are musicians and Cowboy Ranchers from Arizona, The Broken Chair Band. We were very blessed spending time with them and interviewing them.

Topping that list was a rule everyone knew: don't fall. If you fell down, you would be the butt of jokes for weeks, maybe even years, depending upon the artistry of the fall.

I soon realized that the psychology behind the "don't fall" rule had to do with more than just being judged as clumsy. Teenagers dread being embarrassed. They all



Falling at Jesus' feet can be easier said than done. This means we are going to have to trust Him when what He says contradicts what seems to be going on all around us. We are going to be called upon to stand against the culture by espousing truths from Scripture that contradict popular sentiment. We are going to have to see with the eyes of

faith what others can't see with their natural peepers. We are going to have to speak of deliverances not yet seen as though they are just around the corner. After all, this indeed is the essence of faith, "the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen" Hebrews 11:1 (NKJ).

When we fall at the feet of the Lord, believing in faith for what has not yet

want to be treated as their own person, but no one wants to stick out. That's the driving understanding of fads and trends. Let's all dress this way, wear our hair this way, choose these colors, buy these brands, follow these groups, eat these foods, go to these places, and repeat these sayings.

David, the great Psalmist, knew the feeling of not wanting to be embarrassed, so he wrote, "In You, O Lord, I put my trust; Let me never be put to shame" Psalm 71:1 (NKJ). To be put to shame means to be dry, anxious, confounded, or disappointed. David had found the key to the strength of the fallen position, and that is to realize whose feet we're in front of. As long as we're clinging to God's truth about any subject, we can be assured that we will "never be put to shame." Another scripture says, "For what if some did not believe? Will their unbelief make the faithfulness of God without effect? Certainly not! Indeed, let God be true but every man a liar" Romans 3:3-4a (NKJ).

So, unlike the teenagers I teach, let's not be afraid to fall—to fall before the Lord that is. We will not be embarrassed. We can confidently worship God's trustworthiness, knowing that by falling at Jesus' feet, we are placing our faith in His word, and we will never be ashamed about whatever we are believing for Him to do.

If you open the door and let what he's presenting—often sinful pleasure—in, it will gladly come in, but it never comes in alone. Here's the hitch: if you open the door, blinded by your desire, you do not see Satan sneaking in behind this "feel good" thing.

Sin and Satan are a package deal. Always.It is not possible to welcome sin in without the enemy also taking up residence. Sadly, although he disguises himself with pleasure, if you invite him in, he has every right to be there.He has legal access to your life because you opened the door, and he is not a pleasant house guest.

He does not try to remain in the area in which you invited him in. that the enemy of your soul has taken place in your life. You must guard the door of your heart. Romans 6:23 tells us that the effect of sin is death. Sin brings death—because it is attached to our enemy and it separates us from God, who is Life.

So, be aware when sinful desire knocks at the door of your heart. Resist it, knowing that the enemy of your soul comes with it."...Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. Draw near to God, and He will draw near to you..." James 4:7-8

Remember that in Him, there is forgiveness, cleansing, redemption, and restoration.





"<u>Windows on The World</u>"-"The Persecuted Church"

One of the premier weekly programs on our Holy Spirit Broadcasting Network (HSBN), is **"Windows on the World,"** which is co-hosted by international journalist, Dan Wooding, the show's resident "guest expert," and founder of the ASSIST



30-minute talk-show, featuring some of the top stories on my ASSIST News Service," said Dan Wooding, 76, the author of numerous books, a long-standing broadcaster in both the UK and US, and a journalist, who has worked for some of Great

News Service (<u>www.assistnews.net</u>), and Dr. Garry Ansdell, Senior Pastor of Hosanna Christian Fellowship in Bellflower, California, and the Co-founder of Ambassadors for Peace (<u>http://am4peace.org/</u>).

In his nearly 50 years, Dan has interviewed literally thousands of personalities, including Johnny Mathis, Burt Lancaster, David Soul, Paul McCartney and Ringo Starr from The Beatles. He also interviewed Mother Teresa in Calcutta, Mahalia Jackson and Coretta Scott King in London, as well as iconic singer, Pat Boone and Dolly Parton in Hollywood and finally, Archbishop Desmond Tutu in Sheffield, England. Together, Dan, who was born in Nigeria, of British missionary parents, Alfred and Anne Wooding, and Canada-born Garry, interview a series of fascinating guests, seeking to raise the awareness of persecuted Christians around the world in an effort to help remedy this tragic reality, where an estimated 100,000 Christians are murdered each year for their faith by terror groups like ISIS and Boko Haram.

"Windows on The World" began some two years ago, after Dan was a guest on "Holy Spirit Live" with myself and Pamela Christian, an award-winning author, international speaker, radio and television talk-show host and media personality.

"After the show, we began discussing how Pam and I could start working together on a Britain's largest-circulation newspapers, and later as a writer with Billy Graham on some of his overseas crusades in Moscow, Russia; Essen, Germany; and also San Juan, Puerto Rico.

"Soon, we were up-and-running, and for about a year, we would tape our shows in the HSBN studio in Orange, California, until Pam was unable to continue because of her busy workload. I was sorry to end our excellent time together, but I then invited Mark Ellis, the senior correspondent for my ASSIST News Service and is also the founder of <u>www.GodReports.com</u>, a website that shares testimonies and videos from the church around the world to build interest and involvement in world missions, to join me as co-host for the program."

Dan and Mark co-hosted "Windows on the World," for some nine months, each week covering stories from the hot-spots of the world, until Mark felt unable to continue and so, Dan approached Canada-born Dr. Garry Ansdell to ask him to join him for the weekly shows and they, eventually, changed the format of the show and began interviewing a succession of fascinating guests who are making a difference for Christ in our ever-more-violent world. They have included: Bruce Sonnenberg, founder of He Intends Victory, a ministry that works with those affected and infected with the HIV/AIDS virus and Ray Comfort. Ray is the Founder and CEO of Living Waters and the best-selling author of more than 80 books including: Hell's Best Kept Secret, Scientific Facts in the Bible, and The Evidence Bible. He co-hosts (with actor Kirk Cameron) the award-winning television program "The Way of the Master," seen in 200 countries. He is also the Executive Producer on the movies, "Audacity," "180," "Evolution vs. God," and "Exit: The Appeal of Suicide," which have been seen by millions. Ray, and his wife, Sue, live in Southern California, where they have three grown children. In fact, it was Garry who first invited Ray Comfort to move to Southern California and initially helped him launch his US ministry.

Other guests have included Pat Boone's daughter, Lindy Boone Michaelis, who talked movingly about the terrible day when her oldest son, Ryan Corbin, who was 24 in 2001, went up to the roof of his Southern California apartment building, with his roommate, to get some sun. Ryan stepped over this skylight, his foot came down on it, and he fell three stories. When the paramedics arrived, he was laboring to breathe, his lungs had collapsed, and his spleen had burst. Also, his ribs were cracked, and he had a skull fracture.

"Pat Boone contacted me and ask if I would help start a prayer campaign for Ryan, and this was followed up by several appearances by the family on Larry King's CNN TV show," explained Wooding. "Eventually, millions around the world began praying for Ryan, and today he has made an extraordinary recovery. "Another astonishing interview was with Egypt-born Mona Estefanos and her American friend, Bonnie Brown, who shared about how Bonnie's daughter, Jessica, had become a heroin addict, and was close to death, yet Mona, despite suffering from cancer herself, spent many hours praying for Jessica, and encouraging Bonnie.

Others have included shows with veteran Christian broadcaster, Harold Sala, and his daughter, Bonnie Sala, of Guidelines International Ministries which is a Christian nonprofit that transforms lives and communities with the message of Jesus by creating digital content that's shared around the world. Also, Tim Timmons, who founded Orange County's first mega-church, Attorney Brad Dacus, the founder of Pacific Justice Institute, who provides free legal help to individuals and organizations caught up in often anti-Christian legal struggles; and Peter Wooding, Dan's youngest son, who is now a respected TV journalist in the UK, and who recently spent a week in Lagos, Nigeria covering the Reinhard Bonnke Farewell Crusade, attended by millions.

What made this so special was that it was from Lagos that, in 1942, an infant Dan Wooding left Nigeria with his parents in a convoy of 28 ships, many of which were sunk by German U-Boats, and thousands died in the freezing waters of the Atlantic. Miraculously, the Wooding family where spared from death. (Dan's father had been told that he could soon die if he didn't get treatment for his various tropical diseases). During his trip to Lagos, Peter was able to find the actual spot where they sailed from all those years ago.

Besides his ministry at Hosanna Christian Fellowship, Garry Ansdell is the co-founder with the late Ameal Haddad, of Ambassadors for Peace (http://am4peace.org/), an organization that provides a religious rights document that people can sign, and which allows people of all faiths from around the word, to be free to share their faith with anyone, without the fear of retribution. Garry


has traveled to many Islamic countries, where many religious leaders signed the document, and Dan has accompanied Garry on two visits to Indonesia, the world's largest Muslim country. Besides "Windows on the World," Dan also hosts "Inside Hollywood with Dan Wooding," where he interviews many movie celebrities about their faith in Jesus Christ. His cameraman/producer, Tim Hathaway, had previously spent some 32 years running the television ministry for the late Pastor Church Smith at Calvary Chapel Costa Mesa in Southern California.

In 2015, Rosetta and Robert Daniels, the hosts of the show "Journey to Breakthrough" on HSBN.tv invited Marla Reid to share about her experience ministering with Harvest India and what the Lord revealed to her during her time there in 2014. After the taping of the show, Bishop Bills asked Marla if she would be interested in hosting a show of her own. Her initial reaction was

Marla was released from the hospital a few days later. Her vision was blurry for a month, but she was given the word, "Walk by faith, not by sight" which was the important lesson to be learned in this.

Eighteen years ago, I was given an open vision, which is the strongest of all visions. What is an open vision? First, allow me to explain what a vision is. such as positive thinking. It is and must be granted by God to whomever, whenever to reveal whatever He chooses.

Regardless or however old I become, I will



A vision is a visible picture sent by God. A divine sent vision can be received while dreaming and is unmistakable when God sends it compared to any other ordinary dream. What is revealed bears witness with your spirit of the meaning of what is seen or could be literally what is to happen in the future.

Another type of spiritual vision may occur while meditating on the Lord and by the Holy Spirit led into the Spiritual realm to see things, as the Book of Revelation is described by John. An open vision is when you are neither asleep or caught up in the spirit like in a spiritual trance. An open vision is shown to you when you are wide awake and have full mental capacity and all-natural senses working simultaneously. You cannot feel a vision come on and you cannot conjure or create the vision yourself never forget where I was, what I was doing or what I saw in that open vision. That vision was the most impactful, meaningful experience of my life as it was the first day of my new life in Christ. It was the third time He called me, I had run from Him but this time, more than ever, He meant business. He knew I would never understand what I

was to do and probably would be slow in my seeking to discover it on my own. So, literally, to cut to the chase, He gave me the vision, it played like watching a movie on fast forward on an old VHS videotape. So, no audio could be heard, just fast pictures with the static screen messed up in the middle until the tape ran out and would spit out of a VCR (video cassette recorder) player.



Once the flash of all I saw came to an abrupt halt, I was overwhelmed. Then I heard His voice, 'Will you do it?" He was asking if I would do what I saw in the vision. Still overwhelmed and in awe, all I could say, "That's BIG!" Not realizing how much bigger GOD is at that time, He dismissed my comment and repeated His question

firmly. "Will you do it?!" Somehow, I knew this wasn't a time to keep God waiting or to need to pray about it; God wanted an answer and now! So, I said, "Yes." Then God told me to go to a specific local church.

Originally, God called me to that church in 1995, but I made excuses that it was too far to drive. A few years later and due to circumstances, which God was orchestrating, I moved closer to that



returned to church and served wholeheartedly for 17 years, and I never forgot the vision.

In that 17 years, God was introducing Himself to me, wooing me, loving me, growing me, healing me, restoring me, developing my gifts and talents for His purpose and Glory. He was becoming larger

to me as our love and intimacy grew in our relationship. His voice became ever clearer and louder. What He was actually doing was training me, equipping me, strengthening me, preparing me to be a spokesperson, a weapon, a warrior for His Kingdom. Once I recognized how truly ENORMOUS my God is, then the opportunity to fulfill this vision began to unfold.

What was this vision? To travel, to evangelize, to

church and eventually answered my calling.In 1998, God spoke to me a second time, but I ran away not being familiar with how the Holy Spirit uses people to speak into your life with the gift of prophecy, word of knowledge and a word of wisdom.I was so freaked out, I refused the senior pastor's word and quickly left only to hear God correct me for telling a man of God, "NO!"Then God revealed to me to return, apologize and serve that House of God. I ran and never returned until, the third call, the open vision. Then I finally said, "Yes." I

preach the gospel to the people both DEAF and hearing in Africa. God has gifted me with the talent of communicating via American Sign Language (ASL). Upon accepting my assignment to serve in that local church, I was immediately put into ministry to interpret the Word of God to His children, the Deaf Community. As I served, His fruit, favor, faithfulness, and blessings were evident all granted but not without a price; however, the pain and suffering added to my development as well. All of this was merely preparation for His true purpose for me, to join the Holy Spirit Broadcasting Network (HSBN) Team as a broadcaster of the program, Deaf To The World (DTTW). Then upon divine revelation was invited to embark on the first step, my first journey to fulfilling that vision, to travel to Africa to minister to the Deaf people of Kenya. I had 17 days to get ready to walk out the vision I had received 17 years before.



Those you see in the picture with me were the first group of deaf people that sincerely embraced me at the official government building for the Governor of Eldoret. That day, in that moment of meeting my deaf brothers and sisters face to face for the first time, I felt so much love, joy, purpose and a sense of Home. There is so much more to this incredible story, but I hope my initial article of this amazing story of this part of God's journey for me creates an interest for you to join me again in the future as I continue to share all the wonders experienced from this divinely ordained trip.

Most of all I pray it inspires you to believe God for whatever He is calling you to do no matter how long the wait and to restore to you an anchor of Hope to hold one to as you hold on to Him.

In all those years, I have witnessed too many lives destroyed by fear. I have seen so many people lose their minds because of fear and the most bizarre thing is that most are oblivious to this killer. Since fear is subjective, we tend to down play those who present symptoms of fear. Also, the majority of those in fear have an underlying issue with other diseases, so we can diagnose the disease, but not the fear factors. One of the major reasons is because of the code of silence that surrounds it. People don't like to admit that they are afraid, specifically in the context of what we are talking about now, which is the FEAR OF THE UNKNOWN.

Do you find yourself always making excuses as to

why you cannot make decisions? Do you refuse to let others know what you are truly thinking?Is it impossible for you to believe that your situation can change for the better? 




Seven years ago I walked into Pitches Detention Facility, a men's jail, on a cold Wednesday evening, not knowing what I would be walking into, but just trusting God that He had sent me into this place for such a time.

Services are held in an on-site chapel and on that night something special was being birthed. 15 inmates attended the very first service, eagerly awaiting a teaching from the Holy Spirit. I remember spending hours and hours preparing my Message, yet little did I know that God had ordained something else. It would be big and it would not be stopped.

In the middle of my Message I heard the Holy Spirit tell me to "stop, and ask them about baptism". So as directed I stopped the Message and did exactly as I was told. I taught them about water baptism (immersion) and its biblical and eternal importance. Then I asked them if any of them had been baptized. None. Then I asked them if God made a way would they like to get baptized. They all responded with a resounding "yes". I recall telling them that if God wanted them to be baptized nothing could stand in the way.

The next day I called the Senior Chaplain and asked if we could do actual baptisms in the jail. His initial response was no, but said he would speak with the facility Captain. The next day I got a call





from him telling me that the Captain had agreed to allowing baptisms. The only problem was that we would need some type of pool or container to actually use for the baptism. The Senior Chaplain didn't have any ideas and nor did I since we were all new to this process in the jail. Several days passed when I received another phone call from the same Senior Chaplain sounding astonished. He told me that as they were cleaning a room in the Chapel they found an unmarked, strapped box. They opened it and found it to be a brand new baptismal pool! God wanted them to be baptized and nothing was going to stand in the way.

This singular event started a chain reaction that to this day has not stopped.

Needless to say the 15 men that were baptized were not the last. The following months and several years after led to over 2,000 being baptized in the Name of Jesus adding to the Kingdom of God. Through the efforts of this ministry and through the leading and direction of the Holy Spirit, over 5,000 men have accepted Jesus as their personal Savior. There have been many miracles as well. Tumors and cancers have been healed.Backs and shoulders have been healed. Relationships with fathers have been established and even healed. The spirits of fear, addiction and religion have been bound just to name a few. Even generational curses have been isolated, rebuked and lives have been impacted all to the glory of God.

Since my initial visit to the facility, God has blessed this prison ministry effort and it has expanded to another level. ATtheWELL now has secured our own standalone approval, so expanding this Kingdom effort is a goal for 2018. Even now we have begun an effort led by the Holy Spirit, to disciple men who are called to serve the Kingdom of God either in the jail or once they have been released, in the world. ATtheWELL is prepared to make a spiritual investment into their lives so they can encounter the living God and fulfill their divine Calling.



The ATtheWELL Prison Ministry is looking for financial partners in upcoming 2018. This is a full time ministry with goals and expectations to change not only lives but also communities. It is our desire to engage these potential five-fold ministers on a daily basis rather than on a monthly visit.
