ALLOW THE CHILDREN TO COME TO ME AND FORBID THEM NOT.



When parents brought their children to Jesus to pray over them and bless them, the disciples tried to stop the parents. They tried to discourage

them, saying Jesus was much too busy to be bothered with *mere* children. In Matthew 19:13, Jesus made this statement, "Let the children come to me and do not forbid them, for the Kingdom of Heaven belongs to such as these."

In an average church you might have the children for only an hour and a half once a week. What are the children being taught in church during that precious time? Are they watching movies, eating, coloring or running around on the playground? Could they not be included in the same kind of teaching and training as the adults and made into disciples?

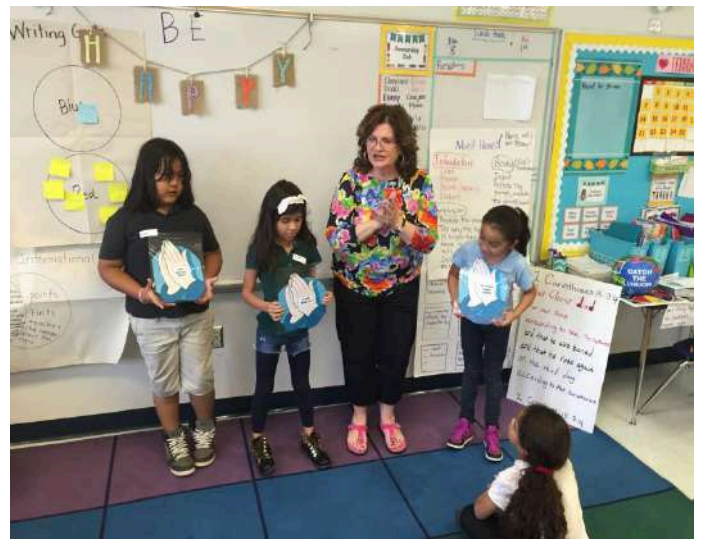
I was in church listening to my pastor preaching about an entirely different topic. Suddenly I heard the words in my spirit, "**the children must not be forgotten**". The thought came to me that in past moves of God, children were more of an afterthought just like they had been in Jesus' day. Jesus had to rebuke His disciples for trying to dismiss the children. I felt that He was saying that this same pattern must not happen now as we are living in the days of another mighty outpouring of God's Spirit. The

children must be included right along with the adults.

Shortly after the Lord spoke to me in church, as I was coming back from a prayer assignment in Seattle, the Lord spoke to me again and said, "**I want you to teach children that they are a 'House of Prayer for all the Nations'.**" I became the director of the Children's Global Prayer Movement under Esther Network International and we began to create PRAYERTOOLS and teach children that the Holy Spirit lived in them and therefore their temple was to become a "House of Prayer" according to Isaiah 56:7.

Children began to recognize who they were in Christ and we had an all night prayer meeting with the children (adults were invited too) called "The Night Of Power" to pray for the Muslim world. We prayed that Muslim people would see dreams and visions of Jesus and come to know him. When I hear of stories of people in the Muslim world who have come to know Jesus in dreams and visions, I just smile because I know the children had a part in this!





Another time we had a delegation of 40 children from around the world with us in Seoul, Korea in 1995 at the Global Consultation on World Evangelism. As I had the children take turns praying what was on their hearts, one boy's prayer from Texas stood out. It was on his heart to pray against the Ebola virus that had broken out in Zaire. One child saw a vision of what the virus looked like, another saw many people falling into eternity without Jesus. We prayed until a spirit of joy and celebration hit the room. We danced and celebrated for we knew it was done! God had heard and answered our prayers. Three days later we heard that the Ebola virus had been suddenly arrested in Zaire. This news came from the World Health Organization.

I have seen a child cast out a demon of cancer, lay hands on people with heart ailments, back problems, foot problems, incurable diseases and even broken hearts. **Let's let the children pray! They are uncluttered and simple in their prayers.** Theology doesn't get in their way. They can easily believe that Jesus is the same yesterday today and forever and that the Greater one lives in them. If Jesus used a little boy with a few little fish and loaves of bread, He can use our children today. This seemingly insignificant gesture of a young boy brought forth a *miracle*

on God's part. How many more opportunities like this one are we missing in the body of Christ because we don't see the value of a child's contribution like Jesus did? Let's *make room* for the children. Let's teach and let the children pray, worship, evangelize and move in the gifts!

Children can be saved and filled with the Holy Spirit at an early age. James Dobson from Focus on the Family was three years old when he got saved, Amy Carmichael (famous missionary to India) was saved at the age of three. One of my own daughters was saved at the age of three.

Charles Spurgeon said, "A child of five, if properly instructed, can truly believe, and be regenerated, just as an adult." Charles Spurgeon, at the Metropolitan Tabernacle in London in 1866 used a little three-page colored booklet to teach children and adults the gospel of Jesus Christ. Dwight L. Moody added a gold page. I don't know when it became known as the Wordless Book but Child Evangelism Fellowship added a fifth page on growth.

The **gold page** stands for God, that He is the creator, He loves us and He is holy! There is one thing that can never be in heaven and that is sin! The dark or **black page** stands for sin. Sin is anything you think, say or do that breaks God's laws or God's rules. Everyone has sinned (Romans 3:23) and was born with a sin nature. There is a punishment for sin -- it is to be separated from God forever in a terrible place of punishment. *But God has made a way so that we do not have to be punished for our sins.*

The **red page**, which represents Jesus' blood, tells us about Jesus and that He is the sinless Son of God. Jesus never thought or said or did anything wrong. He willingly died and rose again and shed His blood to pay the price for your sins and for mine.



Now, because of what Jesus did, you can have your sins forgiven. The **white page** teaches us that you can pray a prayer something like this, "Dear Jesus, I believe you

died, shed your blood and rose again to pay for my sins. I now take you as my very own Savior. Come into my heart and make me your child." The **green page** teaches me to confess my sins to the Lord, go to church, read my bible and share my faith through the Wordless Book. We teach each child the Wordless Book so that they can share their faith with friends and family.

No leading of children would be complete without worship, as Jesus inhabits the praises of His people. One child in one of our clubs said, "When I worship, I feel Jesus and He feels sooo good!" Even a three-year-old can sense God's presence. A little girl came with her grandmother for worship and prayer. As I was playing my instrument, I felt the Holy Spirit impress me not to play one more note because the holy presence of God filled the room. One-by-one, without me saying a word, people began to get on their face before the Lord. The little girl did the same and then tapped her grandmother on the shoulder and said, "Every time I get on my face, I smell Jesus and He smells like roses!"

The Lord has given us an open door of opportunity to go into the public elementary schools in America. On June 11, 2011, the Supreme Court of the US provided equal access to clubs such as our Light Clubs to go in after school in the same manner that other groups come in and use the facilities. I stepped out in 1998 to start The Light Club which later became Light Club Ministries. 2018 was our 20th Year Anniversary! We take the gospel once a week after school into public elementary schools and aftercare facilities to lead children to the Lord and to disciple them. We can train and equip you to reach these often un-churched children through after-school bible clubs. Training is even offered on our web site:

In this end- time outpouring, allow the children to come to Jesus through His word, prayer and worship. Teach and disciple them. You could be mentoring the next Billy Graham or Katherine Kuhlman! Don't allow them to be forgotten, denied or despised. Let's become the spiritual moms and dads this generation needs.

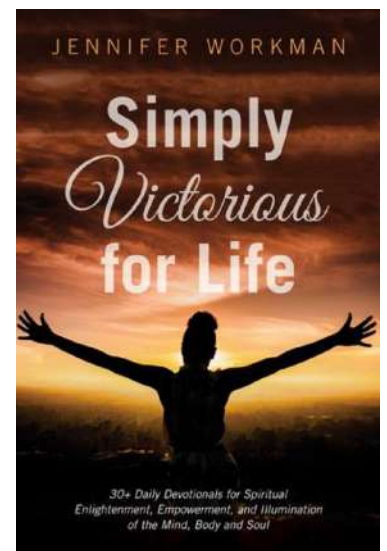

I beat him miserably; however, before we started playing, I had no idea I was going to win, especially since there was a new technique involved. I had to get used to hitting the squares with the pads of my fingers to make them light up, so I could then “move” my checkers to the spaces where I wanted them to go. This difference in operation almost distracted my attention from the strategy of the game which I knew how to play.

As with checkers, so with life. Most of us know the right strategies to use in order to win: put God first, honor our parents and our spouse, dedicate ourselves to family, live within our means, do an honest day's work, strive to better ourselves, help the needy, tithe, save, and give. Don't let the differences in operation distract from the strategies of this game of life that we already know how to play.

- We still have to tithe, save, and give; now we just may organize it all with a computer-based accounting program.
- We still have to help the needy; now we

just may send our donations to the missions of our choice via automatic deduction.

- We still have to strive to better ourselves; now we just may complete our degree with classes once a week over the internet.
- We still have to do an honest day's work; now we just may send our resumes by fax rather than showing up in person at first.
- We still have to live within our means and pay our bills; now we just may manage our finances and pay bills on-line.
- We still have to dedicate ourselves to family; now we just may attend some of the great seminars that help us understand more about each other.
- We still have to honor our loved ones; now we just may add texts, Facebook, and Twitter messages to those love notes and flowers we're used to sending.
- We still have to put God first; now we just may read our Bibles using on-line study helps, keep our prayer journal on a blog, and follow Bible study lessons during the week with a WebTV mentor/teacher (while remaining active as members of our local church, of course).

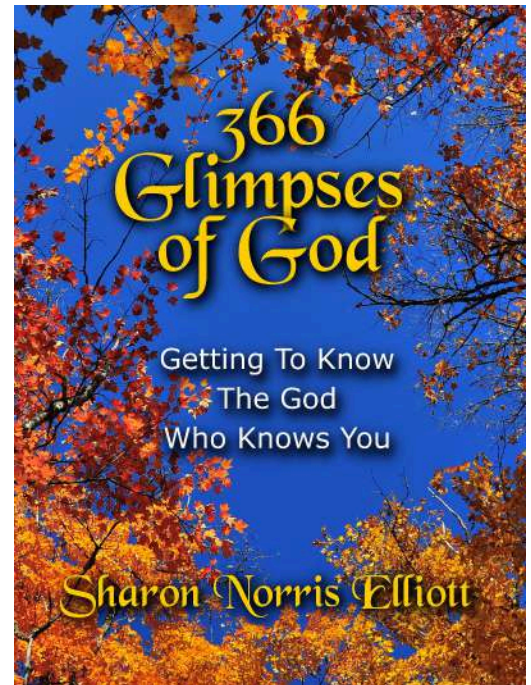
So, you see, the strategies for winning in life are still the same as they have been for generations; the operation is just a little bit different. As long as we do what we know we're supposed to do, no matter how we have to get it done, like me with my checkers game, we will win in the end. That's the good news of the final chapters of the book of Revelation. Read chapters 21 and 22. We win! We read that "...only those who are written in the Lamb's Book of Life" will enjoy the victory of the end of this game (Revelation 21:27b, NKJ).

If we're going to make any resolutions for the new year, let's make at least one all-encompassing, tenacious determination, and that's to stick to the strategies we already know in the Lord. What we're not doing that we should be doing; we'll start. What we're doing wrong; we'll stop. Simple.

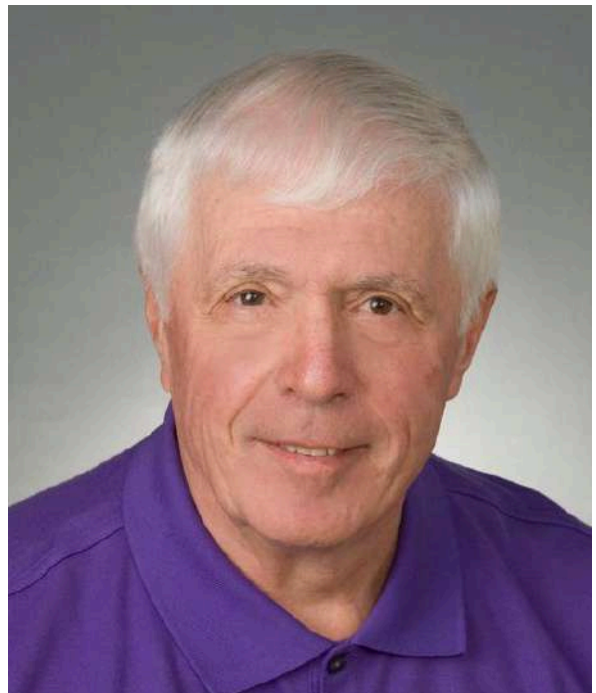

Cairns became actively involved in Christian outreach television in the Regina and Saskatchewan market areas with a series entitled, *"Women at the Well"* --- based upon the Book of John, Chapter Four. Guests included women from all walks of life, including international ministries. Women fearlessly shared their personal testimonies with specific details of their encounter with Jesus of Nazareth and their journey of faith. The Series was warmly received and ran for many years. The Series was followed by assisting First Nations Christians with a continuation of their television outreach, *"Songs of Living Waters"*.

Based upon a vision received during a time of prayer, a new series was launched entitled, *"Valley of Decision"*. At the completion of this Series (and after a hiatus) the Spirit of God nudged Leon to once again contact Access Communications about the possibility of another series entitled, *"Sound of the Trumpet!"*. This Series is designed to awaken the sleeping church and also, as a call to the lost. In 2018, *"Sound of the Trumpet!"* completed Season Four of its programming. It is currently running in the Regina market area and on affiliated cable television stations throughout Saskatchewan.

"The Word" was launched as this article relates. It is currently on re-runs on Access 7 TV, a local station airing locally in Regina, SK & Region. We are excited with its launch on HSBN globally.

Leon has served as a member of the Board of Directors of *Nicky Cruz Outreach* for in excess of 35 years. His wife of 55 years went to be with Jesus of Nazareth in October of 2014. Terry Severson, Host

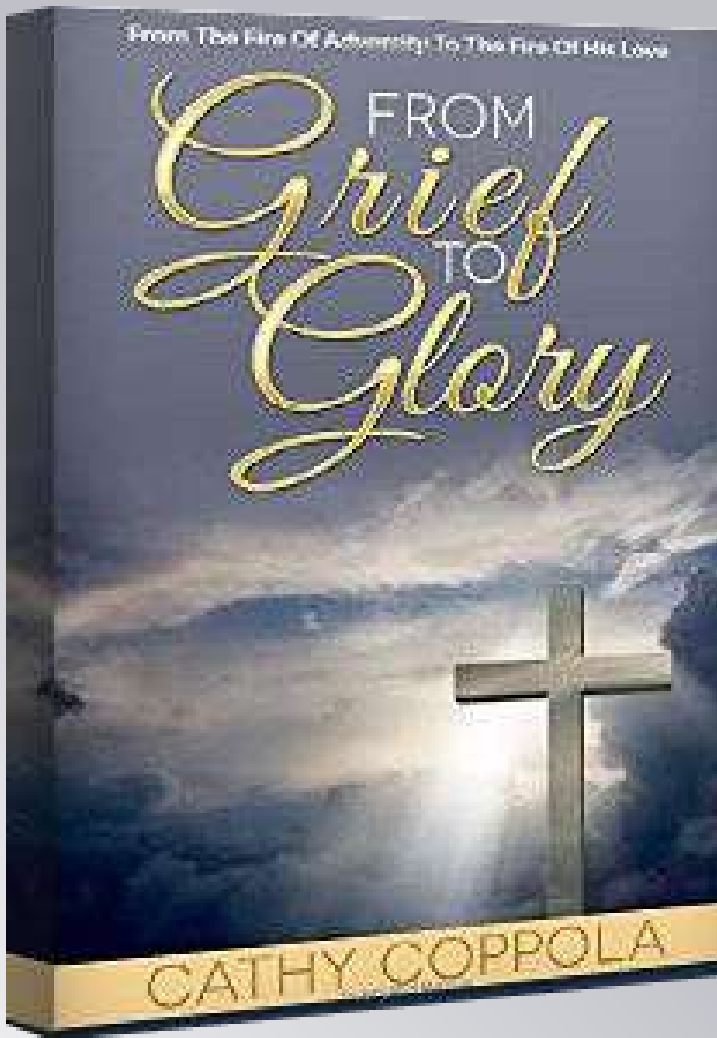

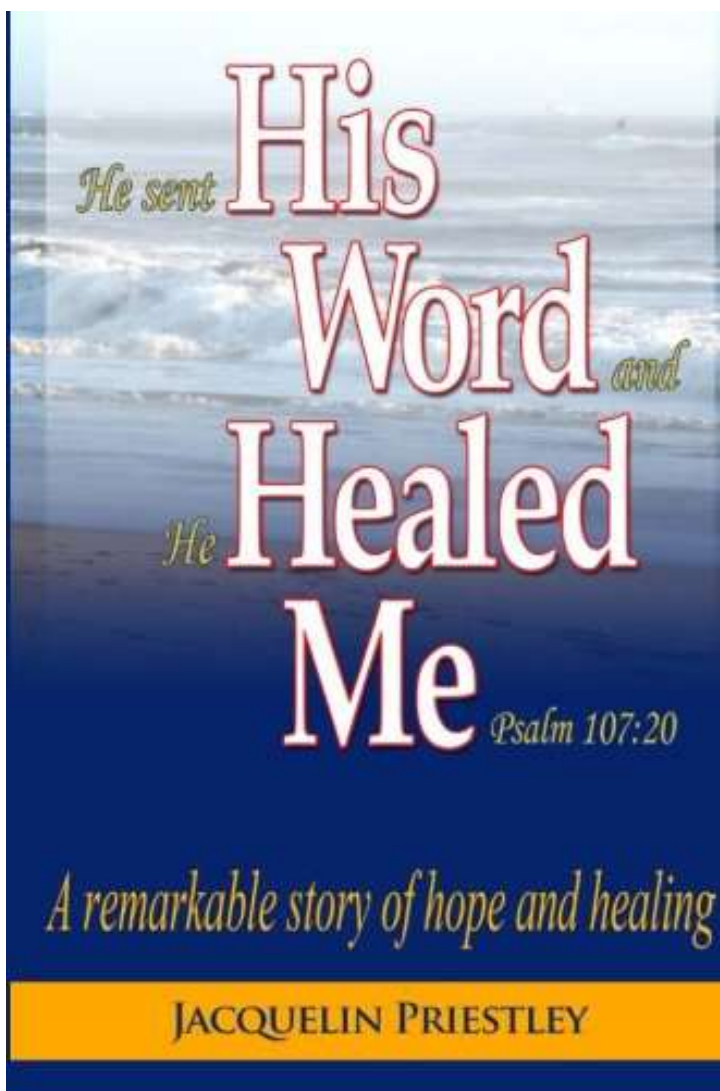

THE HEALING POWER OF LEARNING TO FORGIVE

God has so many ways to bring us healing. LEARNING to FORGIVE is one of the biggest and most important.

Learning to forgive heals the soul (the mind, will, and emotions), the spirit, the memories, perspectives, *and* the body. It also restores the heart's ability to love and reconcile.

In the book of the prophet Isaiah, the Lord says, "I will heal your broken thinking." I LOVE that! Wrong or broken thinking can make us sick; sick in our soul and spirit, and that can leak over into our bodies. God defines "broken" differently than we do. If our thinking doesn't align with His Word, it is *broken*, and can harm us.

When serious attacks come at our family, our children, our livelihood, or especially the health of our own body, with a diagnosis that has words like "possible survival rates" attached to it, it is time to really seek the counsel of God, and to ask *"Have I in any way left the door open, or knocked down Your hedge of protection Lord, to let the enemy in to be able to strike such a blow at me?"* Especially if the medical news, along with ensuing surgeries, has hit you up the side of the head twice in under 11 months...can anybody out there relate?

How do we **DO** that? How do we seek the

counsel of the Lord? By re-prioritizing and making time to get still, open our Bible, and come to the Heavenly Father with a seeking heart...a heart that is more willing than ever to really hear, be guided, and corrected deeply.



I'm not talking about grab a daily verse out of the promise box on the window sill, and for those of us who are genuine students of the Word, I'm not talking about our daily 30 minutes to an hour devotional study time...I'm talking about beyond that.

I have found many times in life that a wise question to ask God is "Have I had any responsibility in what I may be facing or dealing with?", and if so, to then ask for God to show me where repentance is needed.

A few months ago, I did ask that question, and He revealed the culprit was **UNFORGIVENESS**...I drew my breath in and said, "Show me every bit of it, no matter how subtle, that may be trapped anywhere

in my heart, and let's GET IT OUT!"

There is surgery that doctors do on us, with scars to show for it, but then there is the surgery that God does, deep in the heart. The amazing thing is, He leaves no scars. Often His "surgery" brings tears, but they are cleansing, helping to wash a heart clean to make it light again.

The Lord revealed layers of UNFORGIVENESS in my heart toward three people, two of whom are family members. Layers of hurt, heartbreak, resentment, and stuffed-down anger due to feeling very betrayed. This was all hidden under "good efforts," "sweet attitudes," "loving gestures," "giving of time," etc. on my side of the equation in my commitment to be a loving person and honor Christ.

That is why I didn't catch or realize that unforgiveness was still there inside me.

Trust me, if you knew the details, you would say "Well, you have every RIGHT to have all that in there, my goodness! How have you ever managed to make the efforts you have when the issues were so significant, and apologies and recompense should have been extended to you!?"

God revealed a very pointed truth: The layers of things stuffed down in my heart WERE the cancer and were simply manifesting in my body as dis-ease, and the UNFORGIVENESS was the open door, the "crack in the dyke" as it were, that the enemy was hoping to use for my destruction.

The Lord healed my heart by showing me that FORGIVENESS is a priority above all else. Without it, true AGAPE is not flowing, prayers are hindered, blessings are also hindered, and there is a slow eroding of soul that can eventually pollute the well-being of the body. This isn't theory, dear reader, this is "spoke it to my heart" revelation from the Lord.

Since I had already read every book on forgiveness I could find to cope with years of emotional and psychological abuse, and stepped out by faith and acted in love despite the internal pain, I really had to ask the Lord "How? Where do I go from here to have a pure heart?"

Jesus answered my question through a phone call of encouragement from a friend, and then, as I prayed more, I got this picture: I saw Jesus standing by a well, and I realized somehow, He WAS and IS the *living well*. He said, "Lean over and reach your arms as far as possible into the well, all

the way up to your armpits." As I did so, I saw the well was full of *His* blood, and *His* forgiveness.

Jesus showed me I could borrow from the abundance of His forgiveness toward me that is in His shed blood.... That I could reach into that well of His powerful forgiveness and ***in my heart and with prayers DO what Jesus teaches*** ("Pray for those who hurt you, mistreat you, and despitely use you." Matt 5:44). I could imagine myself flinging His blood and loving forgiveness all over the people who had done so much harm to me, WHILE SAYING OUT LOUD "***I FORGIVE*** you (saying their name) with ***the abundance of FORGIVENESS with which Christ Jesus forgives me.***" I could do it over and over until not only was I clean and free, but so were THEY in and by the power of the Holy Spirit as I prayed. He showed me *what I utterly lacked* in my own ability, I could borrow from HIS ABILITY and POWER TO FORGIVE.

Then the Lord showed me to take it one step further and to *SPEAK LOVE* over each one of them daily in prayer, saying "***I choose to LOVE*** (their name) ***with the abundance of love with which Christ Jesus lavishes on me***" and then to pray for their well-being, blessing, salvation, and growth in Christ.

The results in my own heart and temperament have been wonderfully freeing, transforming, and more healing than I could have ever imagined.

I am so grateful to God for His correction, and ***for showing me His Son as a Resource for FORGIVENESS*** in a way I had never seen before.

***Now, here are 19 ways
to make positive changes:***

- 1) Always start and end each day with prayer; 2) Set goals, but make them realistic - don't set yourself up to fail; 3) Resolve to move your body more - walking is wonderful, free, and effective.
- 4) Take time each day to read the Bible! All the answers are in there; 5) Resolve to share your love of the Lord more - there are hurting people who are thirsty for truth and love - offer to share the Lord with them and He will quench their thirst and hunger;
- 6) Before you do something or eat something that you know you shouldn't, stop before you act and have RESOLVE; 7) Challenge yourself; 8) Ask the Lord to put His finger on your heart where your choices are concerned.

You will be surprised how your conscience will be your guide. You know when you are about to make a choice that will not have a positive effect on your life or your body; 9) Make a wise choice - it is up to you; 10) Resolve to eat more vegetables - add an extra serving or two a day; 11) Become familiar with the glycemic index of the food you are eating. my book.

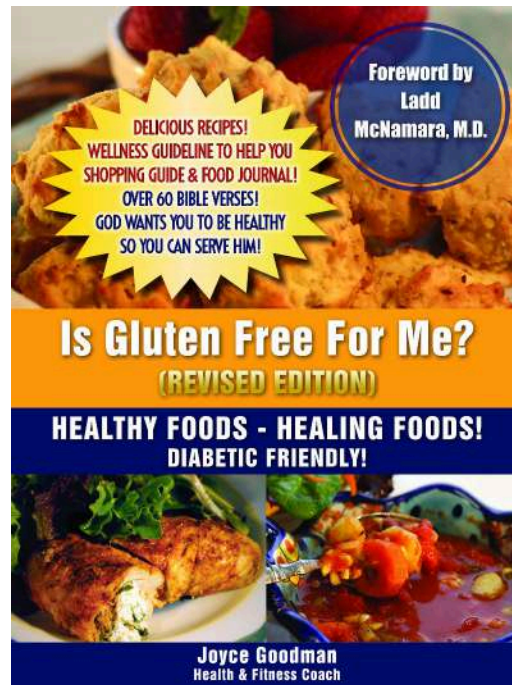

How To "Do Jesus in 2019"

Have you ever felt that you were standing in a place that you have no business being in, or it was a dream come true to even *be* in that place? In the first two weeks of March 2016, I found myself in such a place.

As in a dream, I found myself standing in Israel! In Jerusalem! To be exact, I was standing at the entrance of the East Gate of the temple where Jesus would have walked through every time He came to the temple! My mind raced, picturing being able to have Jesus there with me to talk to Him about so many things, to get so many questions answered!

A few minutes later I got some great answers because our teacher and guide, Dr. Mark Turnage, started to teach us about the three pillars of Jesus' faith. I was amazed to realize that God had just answered me here on the spot and I have not been the same since! Let's take a look at those transformational pillars!

Number 1: CHARITY and GIVING ALMS

Scripture teaches that Charity suffers long and is kind; it does not envy and does not parade itself, nor is it puffed up. Are

you surprised to see Jesus' first pillar is charity, and giving of alms? It is not hard to believe that in order to minister to the souls of those around Him, Jesus had to first minister to their hurts and needs. He demonstrated this to us so many times, in so many ways. He healed lepers who were rejected by society and validated the worth

of the children that played on His lap. He fed five thousand hungry people and delivered those oppressed by demons. Jesus gave continuously!!

In charity (love) Jesus gave alms to demonstrate His charity and love for others. Jesus didn't overlook people the way we often do. He took time to reach out to them. He was willing to give according to His

riches in glory! We are told by Him to give according to a measure and it will be given back to us with the measure with which we gave. We can see there is no valid excuse not to give. If you are alive you can find ways to give. I used to think that I had to give money to people in order for it to be considered giving, but I found myself in a place where money was not available to give; that is when I realized I have so much more to give than money and my giving went to another level because I am giving at Jesus' level!!



Number 2: PRAYER

Jesus' disciples asked Him to teach them how to pray. Ever wonder why they asked Him such a question? Could it be because they saw Him constantly in prayer, and they saw whatever He prayed for came to pass? When He spoke with authority winds obeyed, demons obeyed! Healing power came out of Him when He was touched; Jesus taught by example, when He tells us "Come, follow Me " that is exactly what He intends to do!

Number 3: FASTING and REPENTANCE

Igniting Your Prophetic Gift

The first year I had become a Christian, the Holy Spirit introduced a spiritual gift to me I knew very little about. At a large church conference I was visiting in Eastern Canada, I had a very clear and vivid picture come to my mind of a large volcano

overflowing with fiery lava. The Holy Spirit then spoke to me

in an internal audible voice. He told me to share what I was seeing with one specific pastor from the local area. This picture represented what the Lord

was doing in this pastor's life. I was instantly fearful and said "NO!" Two more times the Holy Spirit prompting me to share this vision. I continued to say "No Way!" I was quite spiritually timid and afraid of looking strange. This specific pastor was across the conference hall quite busy visiting people and there were hundreds of people between him and I. The Holy Spirit spoke once more and said, *"Go and share this vision with him."* Finally, I said *"Yes, BUT only if this pastor comes right next me and*

says hello!" I breathed a sigh of relief thinking there is no way this would happen in this large of a building with so many people present.

Can you guess what happened next? Within five minutes, this pastor appeared right next to me and said *"Hello!"* I couldn't believe it! I knew then it was time to share this vision. So, I asked him if I could share what I had seen. He said, *"Of course!"* So, I closed my eyes and started sharing everything I had seen to the best of my

descriptive ability. I nervously opened my eyes to see his reaction. The pastor's eyes were huge like saucers and the power of God came upon him.

He was slain in the Spirit and fell backwards landing on the floor. Being a young believer, I had no understanding of what was really happening. I asked worriedly, *"Are you ok?"* and helped him up. This great life, energy, and freedom was now pouring out from this man of God.





He looked at me in a bewildered way and said, *"I received that exact same prophetic word through my apostolic leader's wife two years earlier."* He was excited and full of joy!

Many believers don't ever operate in the gift of prophecy. If they do, it usually isn't on a regular basis. Even many charismatic churches don't really embrace this gift. They may allow a corporate prophetic word by a special speaker or one of the pastors in the church. Rarely is it a ministry taught and encouraged throughout congregations. However, the Bible actually teaches us prophetic ministry should be happening regularly and by



anyone who desires it. This gift has the potential to be

operating in fellowship groups, evangelism efforts, worship services, prayer lines, healing ministries, and even in our daily communication with others.

I believe prophetic ministry is at times misunderstood, and possibly mystified, to the point that normal believers wouldn't even think to desire or embrace it. However, this is contrary to the teaching of it in God's word.

What is Prophetic Ministry?

Acts 2:16-18 (NIV) *No, this is what was spoken by the prophet Joel "In the last days, God says, I will pour out my Spirit on all*

*people. Your sons and daughters **will** prophecy. your young men will see visions your old men will dream dreams. Even on my servants, both men and women, I will pour out my Spirit in those days,*

*and **they will prophecy.**"*

1 Corinthians 14:1... *desire spiritual gifts, especially that you **may prophecy**.*



What Is Prophecy?

Prophecy is when an individual **speaks out** the mind and counsel of God, as the Spirit of God impresses them. It is God directly **communicating** His Word to human beings, through human beings. It is a speaking gift that requires **faith** in hearing or sensing something from God and speaking it out to a specific person or group of people.

Prophecy is not miracle. It is not merely words of **human** encouragement being spoken. It is **NOT** only meant for a selective or special group of people. It is not someone standing and giving a general exhortation to a congregation (although this can be an expression of prophecy).

Who can prophesy? 1 Corinthians 14:31 *"For you may **all prophesy** one by one that all my learn, and **all may be comforted**."*



Anyone who is a believer in the body of Christ may be able to prophesy!

1 Corinthians 14:1-3 (NKJV) *"Pursue love, and desire spiritual gifts, but especially that you may prophesy. For he who speaks in a tongue does not speak to men but to God, for no one understands him; however, in the spirit he speaks mysteries. But he who prophesies speaks **edification and exhortation and comfort** to men."*

What is the Purpose of Prophecy?

There is so much pain and struggles in the world that these gifts are necessary for bringing **hope and encouragement**. Therefore, in its simplest form prophecy is used **primarily** for: **Comforting** meaning to cheer up, **Edification** meaning to build up, & **Exhortation** referring to stirring up or firing up.

Do you or anyone you know need some cheering up, building up, or firing up? We have an enemy constantly trying to steal our hope, challenge our faith, and hinder our joy. All of us could certainly benefit from this ministry in our lives from time to time.

In addition to the above primary or main purposes of prophetic ministry, the Holy Spirit will on occasion also use this gift to **confirm** what God has already revealed.



I Cor 14:31 *"that all may learn and all may be encouraged."* The word **"learn"** here in the Greek means not only instructive learning, but also **corrective learning**.

The body of Christ needs the prophetic gift activated & operating with proper Biblical understanding, honorable character, and accountability. A couple things to note in the story I shared about the pastor who received the word. After receiving the prophecy, the pastor was built up, fired up, & the word confirmed what God had previously spoken to him.

Perhaps we will receive a word so we have a **strategy in prayer**. I Tim 1:18 *"that by them you may wage the good warfare"*. This gift is also used at times to **bring life** - Matt 4:4 *"man shall not live by bread alone but by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God"*.

Those with a five-fold ministry office may also use this gift to **Confer or Impart** gifts to others. I Tim 4:14 *"Do not neglect the gift that is in you, which was given to you "by" prophecy with the laying on of the hands of the eldership."* A trusted and season prophetic minister may be able to share gifts of **Direction** amongst those they have influence with. It may even help establish ministries in the house of God. When this gift is rooted in love and the Word of God, it may also be used to bring **Correction**



How Can We Develop Our Gifting?

a) Expect to hear the voice of God - My sheep hear my voice and they follow me and I give unto them eternal life (John 10:27,28).

b) Covet to prophecy I Cor 14:1 *"desire spiritual gifts especially that you may prophesy"* Paul exhorts the church that we should *"Covet this gift"*, which actually means, **"to desire with intense passion."**





In order to speak the mind and counsel of God; we really need to be open to and learn to hear God's voice. Many of us have preconceived ideas about God. Many Christians believe that God only speaks to us only through **His Word**. Others believe it is totally **unnatural** to hear God's voice. Still others believe we must be very **devout or special** Christians before we can hear from Him. These preconceived notions do not reflect God's reality. Our God is a communicating God and He wants to communicate with us. In fact, He specifically created us with ears to hear His voice.

It should be normal for us to hear His voice on a daily basis. It is actually **abnormal** NOT to hear God's voice. In John 10:27, Jesus says, *"My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me."* Jesus expects to speak to you and it **is normal for you to hear His voice**.

The past couple of years I have seen an awakening and hunger start to rise up once again in the body of Christ. Believers are eager to learn, grow, & mature in the prophetic gift and ministry. Foundations such as biblical accountability, submission to church authority, increasing accuracy, and demystifying this amazing gift are a few areas we are working hard at building

in local church bodies. Some are overcoming their own religious traditional misunderstandings and fear of this gift. Numerous believers are awestruck as they realize they too can prophesy and impact others as they speak prophetic words of life to others.

I have seen many prophesy for the first time leaving the people they are ministering to edified, encouraged, comforted, and even weeping in a good way at the words being spoken to them.

In Conclusion, I want to encourage you to listen for God's voice and learn more about this amazing spiritual gift. God wants to speak to you through His Word, His voice, impressions, visions, dreams, pictures, and more. You may already have been hearing from Him in different ways without even realizing it. All that's required is to **desire the gift of prophecy**, judge what you see or hear by God's word, and start to learn how and when to share it with others.
