Candler Elementary School Playground Stage 2019/2020 Program FAQ

Q: How much is the program?

A: The program is completely free. There are no costume fees and no tickets to buy to see the performance.

Q: How is the program free?

A: Playground Stage is a non-profit organization registered with the IRS under section 501(c)(3). We are able to accept large donations to fund our programs. This year we have selected Candler Elementary to host programs funded by our donors.

Q: How can my child participate?

A: Fill out the application provided and send it in one of three ways: to your child's teacher, to the main office, or email it to education@playgroundstage.org. Your child will need to submit a creative project along with the application.

Q: Why does my child need to submit a project?

A: This portion of the application is to ensure that the child is engaged and motivated to be in the program.

Q: Will you be judging the best projects?

A: The project serves mainly as a way to let us know that the child is invested. If there is more interest than spots available in the class we will be looking for creativity, time, and attention spent on the project.

Q: How many spots are in the program?

A: There are only 15 spots in each program K-2nd and 2nd -4th

Q: Can my 2nd grader apply for both classes?

A: You must choose which class is best suited for your 2^{nd} grader. If they are new to any kind of singing, dancing, or acting we advise that you choose the Musical Theatre Beginnings Class. If they have some experience in musical theatre or read on a higher than average reading level the Mini-Musical might be a better fit. If we find that a 2^{nd} grader has applied but is recommended by their teacher for a class other than what you have applied for – we will contact you.
