PURPOSE:

The purpose of this document is to establish a standard and expectation for the SLO County Fire Service regarding the equipment to be assembled by a fire company who is assigned RIC at an incident (aka RIC Tool Strip). Items designated with an * are considered mandatory/required items.

QTY	DESCRIPTION
1	RIC Air Pack with air cylinder (45-minute bottle minimum), universal quick fill connection (UAC), buddy breather hose, and a face mask*
1	Thermal Imaging Camera*
1	Flathead Axe*
1	Halligan*
1	24" Bolt Cutter*
2	Box-lite or equivalent*
4	Door Chock/Wedge*
1	Wire/Cable Cutter*
2	Rescue strap system or tube webbing (10' minimum loop, pre-tied) for victim dragging*
1	Large Area Search Bag (with a 200' 9mm min. life safety rope)
1	8-10 lb. Sledge Hammer
1	Pike Pole or Rubbish Hook or New York Hook
1	Circ Saw
1	Chain Saw
1	Drop Bag
1	Tarp/Salvage Cover for RIC equipment cache
1	Backboard/Miller Board or equivalent
1	Pre-assembled High Rise Kit

Note: If no unit is assigned for Medical stand-by, have EMS gear with RIC equipment.
