

Summary of Annual Requirements for SLO County CISM Team

Training

- Courses hosted locally on a 5 year cycle to meet re-certification & operational readiness.
- All team members will attend the three minimum courses recognized by the ICISF:
 - Individual & Group Crisis Intervention and Peer Support
 - (3 day combined course)
 - Suicide, Prevention, Intervention, and Postvention
 - (2 day course)
 - NIMS (100, 200, 700 & 800) required for all emergency responders

Meetings and CE Courses

- Quarterly Annual CISM meeting/CE training: 2 – 2 hour sessions.
- CE qualifying training is open to other emergency responders.

Team Activations

- Average of 1-2 CISD deployments per team member. County wide average 8-10.
- Average of 5 critical incident contacts/assessment for service/ Conducted on shift/on duty.

Critical Incident Text Notifications

- Average of 20 critical incidents text communications to confirm team member contact.
- Number of texts initiated per team member estimated to be 5 annually.

ROSS Certification

- Required for operational readiness team certification.
- Does not obligate employee or department for out of unit deployment.

Team Recruitment and Peer Education

Spring 2015 our team is launching a county wide training effort – conducted generationally.
