There's a saying in Alaska, when a pine needle falls in the forest, the eagle sees it, the deer hears it and the bear smells it. For bald eagles this is certainly true. Their eyesight is around eight times better than ours and they can spot prey from a distance of two miles. Along the Inside Passage, the extensive shoreline, old growth forests and healthy salmon runs provide ideal bald eagle habitat. Consequently, their numbers are robust throughout the region.




Bald eagles return to the same nesting sites year after year and usually mate for life.






