## How to get ashore using the tenders

Tender tickets will be required for those guests who are not booked on a Cunard shore experience, and will be available from the Royal Court Theatre on Deck 2, starboard side, forward from 7.00am. The tender ride is approximately 10 minutes.

When you are ready to go ashore, please follow the instructions below:

- Collect a numbered tender ticket from the Entertainment Staff in the Royal Court Theatre on Deck 2, starboard side, forward and take a seat until your number is called.
- When your number is called you will be escorted to the tender embarkation area. Please hand your tender ticket to the member of staff on duty, and you will be directed to the tender.
- Have your Voyage card ready for the Security Staff to scan before boarding the tender.

An announcement will be made from the Bridge saying "Open Tenders", this means that tender tickets are no longer required. A continuous tender service will operate between the ship and the shore. The last tender will leave the shore at 4.30pm, tender tickets are not required for the return trip.

## Environmental notice for Alaska

Guests are politely reminded of the need to respect the environment when going ashore in Alaska. Please dispose of all garbage responsibly and bring anything back to the ship that you cannot dispose of properly ashore. Please also take every precaution to avoid any matter from falling over the ship's side and if you do see something, please report it to a crew member.

## Noise restrictions in Alaska

In order to respect local communities and to preserve the tranquility of Alaskan ports, ships are not permitted to make open deck announcements or provide any live entertainment or music on open decks whilst alongside, during sail-in and sailaway.

## United States department of Agriculture notice

## Port Highlights

Beneath an ice field that never melts, on a waterway that never freezes, Juneau is the unusual and disarmingly beautiful capital of Alaska. The Mendenhall Glacier is the not-to-be-missed attraction. Despite its status as Alaska's capital, Juneau's urban area spans just 14 square miles but its appeal far exceeds its city limits. Frequently cited as Alaska's most scenic city, Juneau is nature's playground, and what a playground it is. Waters abound with Humpbacks and orcas, forested trails leading to snow-ensconced mountains, and the ever-present majestic eagles circling overhead. The town that kick-started Alaska's gold rush is rich with treasures of all varieties, from native Tlingit history and excellent seafood to an abundance of outdoor pursuits. It is little wonder that most of Juneau's residents arrived for a short stay and decided never to leave. Spending time in Juneau is an experience to savour. The city is home to some of Alaska's finest museums and galleries, showcasing native art and objects of historical significance. Downtown Juneau is the city's oldest district, with many buildings dating from the dawn of Alaska's gold rush. It is a wonderful area to explore, with helpful signposts to guide your way. By far, one of the most popular excursions from Juneau is to Mendenhall Glacier. At half a mile wide, the glacier is one of the most accessible in Alaska and a visit here is high on many Juneau visitor's wish lists. The aptly named Photo Point Trail offers a great vantage point from which to take photos while a longer trek brings you to Nugget Falls. Admiralty Island, home to the world's largest concentration of brown bears, is also easily reached from Juneau. The island offers several places from which to observe the bears safely, and is just a short seaplane journey from Juneau.

Guests under 21 years of age in US ports and territorial waters and under 19 years of age in Canadian ports and territorial waters are not permitted to purchase or consume alcohol on board. Please be aware that proof of age by means of government issued photographic identification may be requested. Under age guests are also not permitted in the Yacht Club after 11.00pm.

## Visiting Alaska

### A Note from the Naturalist

Juneau, Alaska's state capital, sits nestled between Mount Roberts and Mount Juneau. The waters to the north of Juneau are a summertime home for humpback whales, making this one of the best ports of call for whale-watching along Alaska's Inside Passage. Steller sea lions, harbour seals and Dall's porpoises also frequent these waters, and are typically sighted on wildlife tours.

### Did you know?

Humpback whales feed on krill and small schooling fish. Recent estimates suggest that each whale consumes around 3,000 lbs of food a day.

## Important information about going ashore by tender



On Thursday, 15 August 2024, Queen Elizabeth will be anchored away from the quayside in Juneau, and we will be taking you ashore using tenders. Please read the following information very carefully for your own safety, comfort and convenience.

## What is a tender and why do we use them?

In some ports it is necessary to anchor offshore rather than alongside. When this is the case, we use a tender to take you ashore. A tender is a small vessel with a capacity of around 100 people. The tenders are usually our own, manned by our crew, but sometimes they are chartered through a trusted external provider.

## Embarking and disembarking the tender safely

When using tenders your safety is our utmost priority, so please read the following carefully in order to assess whether you are able to use the tender safely.

In order to board the tender, you will be directed to a small platform on Deck B. You will then be required to alight from the ship's platform and onto the tender. You will be required to use steps, both up and down (where there may be a 6" to 8" height difference) and also to navigate the gap between the platform and tender (which due to the movement of the tender may be up to 1.5ft).



Please wear appropriate flat footwear that is securely attached to your feet when embarking and disembarking the tender.

Depending on weather, tide and sea conditions, there may be some movement, which could change throughout the course of the day, so please take extra care when stepping on and off the tender. There will be crew members there to guide and steady you as you embark and disembark.

Naturally, the same precautions apply when you disembark the tender in the port.

## Mobility assessment

To use the tender you must have independent mobility. By that, we mean that you must be able to negotiate the steps, the gap and height difference. There will be crew members there to guide and steady you as you embark, but they cannot support, carry or lift guests on board the tender for safety reasons and there will be no exceptions to this.

If you have registered with us for mobility assistance, one of our officers will be in touch with you shortly to discuss your ability to embark and disembark the tender safely.

Our officers will make a final assessment of all guests' mobility at the point of embarkation, and at this point, you may be denied permission to board the tender, which will be at the officer's discretion. The officer's decision will be final, with the full support of the Captain.

If you have impaired mobility, or use a mobility aid such as a stick, then we ask you to carefully consider your ability to embark the tender safely before you make your way down to the platform. Please take into consideration the use of steps, the gap and height difference between the platform and the tender, and the potential movement of the tender when making your decision.

## Wheelchair and mobility scooter users

If you use a wheelchair or a mobility scooter, you will be permitted to board the tender providing you have enough independent mobility to be able to get out of your wheelchair/mobility scooter and embark on foot. There will be crew members there to guide and steady you as you embark, but they cannot

support, carry or lift guests on board the tender for safety reasons and there will be no exceptions to this.

You, or your travelling companion, are responsible for assembling and disassembling your wheelchair/mobility scooter. The crew will endeavour to assist you where practical and safe to do so and providing that no individual part of the wheelchair or mobility scooter weighs more than 20kg.

## Safety while on board the tender

Once you have embarked the tender, please follow the instructions given by crew members and find a seat as soon as possible. Do not get in or out of the tenders until told to do so.

## Shore excursions

Priority will be given to you if you are on a shore excursion. Please see the mustering details in the Daily Programme for more details.

## How do the tenders run?

Tenders are run on a continuous loop, please see the Daily Programme for times and frequency. As mentioned above, we will embark shore excursion guests first, then all other guests.




Naturally, most guests will want to disembark as early as possible, so we do expect a very busy period in the morning. Therefore, we will stagger disembarkation and ask you to collect a ticket at a particular venue and then wait for your group to be called before making your way down to the tender platform. Public announcements will be made throughout the morning, so please listen carefully.

Once the busy period is over we will make an announcement and you will be free to use the tender without a ticket.

The tender is free of charge all day.

Should you have any questions about the tenders, including concerns about safety and mobility, please ask at the Purser's Desk.


All guests must be able to negotiate a distance of 45cm or 18 inches unaided in order to embark the tender service.


