Alcohol policy

Guests under 21 years of age in US ports and territorial waters and under 19 years of age in Canadian ports and territorial waters are not permitted to purchase or consume alcohol on board. Please be aware that proof of age by means of government issued photographic identification may be requested. Under age guests are also not permitted in the Yacht Club after 11.00pm.

Environmental notice for the Alaska

Guests are politely reminded of the need to respect the environment when going ashore in Alaska. Please dispose of all garbage responsibly and bring anything back to the ship that you cannot dispose of properly ashore. Please also take every precaution to avoid any matter from falling over the ship's side and if you do see something, please report it to a crew member.

Guest tender briefing

During this call guests will use the ship's tenders. To use the tender you must have independent mobility. Guests must be able to negotiate the steps, the gap and height difference. As part of our safety procedures we offer our guests the opportunity to attend a short briefing describing all aspects and limitations of tendering operations to be considered before deciding to go ashore.

Noise restrictions in Alaska
In order to respect local communities and to preserve the tranquility of Alaskan ports, ships are not permitted to make open deck announcements or provide any live entertainment or music on open decks whilst alongside, during sail-in and sailaway.

Scenic viewing

In order to enable you to enjoy the scenic viewing, we will be opening the forward area of decks 5 and 6 from 2.00pm until 5.00pm. Please note that this area is normally restricted to crew only and that you will be sharing this space with the crew in their personal time.
With this in mind, please be mindful of raised thresholds in this area and that any commentary being made inside the ship will not be heard on the open decks, Decks 5 and 6 forward areas can be accessed from Stairway A and then using the port and starboard guest corridor to lead you forward. No disposable items are to be taken outside whilst cruising Tracy Arm Fjord. Should you see anything fall over the ship's side, please report it to a crew member.

Wildlife hotspot is at the west side of Frederick Sound and Entrance to the Tracy Arm Fjord will be at 11.45pm and 2.00pm and 4.30pm.
A Note from the Naturalist
Intriguing, blue icebergs can often be seen floating along the eastern shoreline of Frederick Sound, or on the lake in front of Mendenhall Glacier. The beautiful blue glacial ice, the bergs also provide a welcome resting spot for harbour seals and a perfect perch for the region's bald eagles. The largest icebergs usually persist for around four weeks, before melting into the waters of the Bay.
Did you know?
More than half the world's glaciers can be found in Alaska. Over 90% of Alaska's glaciers are currently retreating.

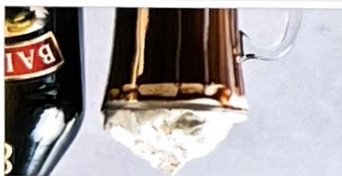
From the Navigator

Venture into the genuine wilderness as you sail to the towering mountain peaks at the entrance to Tracy Arm Fjord, located in the southeastern strip of Alaska bordering British Columbia. Accessible only by boat or seaplane, getting to Tracy Arm Fjord itself is part of the adventure. Cruise ships will not stop directly at the fjord, but you can enjoy the surroundings while on board from the open deck. One of the most dramatic locations in the USA, Tracy Arm Fjord is an impressive tourist attraction south-west of the Alaskan city of Juneau. This impressive fjord is surrounded by cascading waterfalls and granite cliffs for as far as the eye can see. Deep within undisturbed nature, this attraction sits in an almost magical atmosphere. Appreciate scenic views of mountain peaks, emerald waters, tremendous glaciers, and Alaskan wildlife.
The Tracy Arm Fjord is part of the Tracy Arm-Fords Terror Wilderness region that covers over 30 miles of glacier walls and mountain landscape. Witnessing glacial calving in Tracy Arm can be a spectacular experience as huge chunks of ice plummet into the freezing sea below. Many of these chunks of ice are larger than several buses combined, so the effect can be simply jaw-dropping. Wildlife is also common in the Tracy Arm Fords region and guests can often catch a glimpse of some of the most mesmerising marine and land mammals on the planet. Brown and black bears, mountain goats, wolves, black-tailed deer, and Dall sheep regularly roam close to the Tracy Arm Fjord as do harbour seals, orcas, humpback whales, and sea lions.
