In-Country Activities

- Community workshops, healing circles, and youth forums.
- Promotion of culturally grounded mental health literacy and emotional safety.
- Mobilization of local partnerships with schools, clinics, and media outlets.
- Documentation of stories of resilience and amplify youth voices.
- Support emergency response and psychosocial first aid in crisis zones.

International (Diaspora & Global)

- Represent the movement at global forums, summits, and advocacy campaigns.
- Co-create bilingual training (English + country languages) modules and digital content.
- Mentorship for cross-border cohorts and foster intercultural solidarity.
- Advocacy for policy change and funding for MHPSS in vulnerable regions.
- Build bridges between diaspora communities and local initiatives.

Core Roles & Responsibilities

Ambassadors:

- Host healing circles and youth forums
- Share stories of resilience via social media
- Engage schools, clinics, and local partners
- Participate in monthly empowerment labs

Leaders:

- Mentor Ambassadors and review training outputs
- Represent the Movement in national and global forums
- Co-create advocacy materials and policy briefs
- Support emergency response and community outreach

Honorary Champions of Resilience and Empowerment

- Lend visibility, and endorsement to Global Network campaigns and training
- Fund ambassadors and leaders' initiative.

- Trauma-informed leadership curriculum and training (bilingual: English—country language)
